The Secretariat of State of His Holiness takes the liberty to transmit for the consideration of the competent Allied Authorities the enclosed petition of Mr. Ivan Zabic of Croatian nationality a former officer in the Yugoslav Army, for relief and assistance for himself and wife from the United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation Administration.

Mr. Zabic states that when he applied for relief, he was informed that his request for aid for himself and wife was not granted because his cooperation for the Allied Cause between 1941-1944 was not clearly enough proven and there being some doubt about why he was interned for 5 months after the end of the war.

Mr. Zabic then goes on to state his explanation as to the reason of his present condition and the plight of himself and wife.

The Secretariat of State of His Holiness in accordance with the humanitarian and charitable mission of the Holy See would point out to the U.N.R.R.A. Authorities that there is grave danger involved in providing assistance on a basis of political belief; and would ask that such a basis of granting or refusing aid and relief be not invoked in bringing succor to these war-torn nationals and war ravaged lands. Especially in countries with such complex structures as Jugoslavia where political beliefs are so notoriously divided, unstable and confused.

Dear Captain Oddi:

The Secretariat of State of His Holiness takes the liberty to request that you recommend to the competent Allied Authorities the petition of Puleri Lucrezia ved. Radicchi, Voc. Fano, Cisterna (Perugia) to give her aid in recompense for the loss of her son Italo who was killed while performing a service for the Allies.

The request states that on July 26, 1944 the Allied troops entered Cisterna and, stopping at the home of Puleri, ordered Italo and his companion Mascalchi Giovanni to provide them with straw. This they tried to do immediately by going to the barn of farmer Burato for it. While they were binding the straw, unaware that the Germans who had been there just a few days before and had planted booby traps in the barn, an explosion took place killing Italo instantly and wounding the other. The death of this boy caused a grave loss in the support of the family of eight children.
