Dear Admiral,

I wish to inform you of the situation that has been evolving for some time at the Tenuta agricola-forestale of San Rossore, Province of Pisa. This demesne, formerly in endowment to the Crown, has actually been assigned to this Administration for management.

I am told that the officer in charge of the prisoners' camp of San Rossore, Lt.Col. James E. Gabriel, intends to evacuate from the estate all families resident there, in order to break off that zone's black market activities that are effectuated by persons that are entirely alien to the estate.

Lt.Col. Gabriel appreciates the great losses that might derive from such a measure for the Administration of the estate as well as for the numerous families that would remain without a possibility of dwelling or any other support, and therefore has agreed for the time being not to carry out his intention and to accept the offer of the estate's personnel to help in the surveillance. But he declared to send away all civilians on January 1st in case the strong measures of surveillance would not succeed in eliminating the trouble.

Unfortunately I do not understand which responsibilities can fall on the estate's personnel who have never been involved in black market operations. Moreover this Administration is able to intervene directly and most energetically in the case of eventual responsibilities or offences. I cannot even understand the opportunity of Lt.Col. Gabriel's measures which would have only the character of an unjustified reprisal that even spoils the desired surveillance.

In concordance with agreements that have been made with local authorities, the Cacciatori Guard on service at San Rossore cooperate with the Carabinieri by way of active vigilance and periodical raids.

I have given precise instructions that all residents of San Rossore will cooperate in guarding the estate and- in accordance with the prisoners' camp authorities- that the admission to the estate be allowed only for reasons of labor. Therefore I have reason to believe that this cooperation will be very efficient.

The evacuation of all civilians from San Rossore is intended by Lt. Col. Gabriel is worrying me because of the great losses that will originate in its consequence to this Administration. Actually the estate San Rossore is the only estate of this Administration which keeps its balance by means of agriculture and lumbering.

Moreover I am very anxious about the destiny of a great number of families that would not find any possibility of housing or something to live on, in case they should be evacuated from San Rossore. It is therefore that I request your kind intervention.

This Administration will be very glad to continue its cooperation to intensify the surveillance of the estate which might be of great use because it is performed by persons that know the locality well.

Illustre Ammiraglio,

Mi trovo nella necessità di rappresentare alla Signoria Vostra Illustrissima la situazione che da qualche tempo si va creando nella Tenuta agricola-forestale di San Rossore, presso Pisa, Tenuta demaniale già di dotazione della Corona, eppertanto affidata in gestione a questa Amministrazione.

Mi viene, infatti, segnalato che il Comandante del Campo Prigionieri in San Rossore, Ten. Col. James E. Gabriel, preoccupato - e giustamente - di stroncare il mercato nero, soprattutto di benzina, manifestatosi in detta zona, ad opera di persone estranee alla Tenuta, avrebbe manifestato il proposito di ordinare l'allontanamento dalla Tenuta di tutte le famiglie ivi residenti. Reso edotto del gravissimo danno che da un provvedimento del genere deriverebbe sia per la gestione della Tenuta sia per la sorte di tante famiglie che rimarrebbero prive della loro abitazione e di ogni mezzo di sussistenza, il Col. Gabriel ha acconsentito a soprassedere per il momento all'attuazione del suo proposito, accettando la collaborazione offertagli dal personale della Tenuta nell'opera di vigilanza. Se nonchè il predetto Comandante avrebbe dichiarato che egli dovrebbe, in ogni modo, attuare il suo proposito di allontanamento dei civili residenti in San Rossore per il 1° gennaio 1947, qualora con le restrizioni e con la sorveglianza ora adottati non si riuscisse ad eliminare gli inconvenienti lamentati.

Mentre non vedo quale responsabilità possa farci ricadere sul personale della Tenuta, che non mi risulta sia stato mai implicato nella faccenda del mercato nero e per il quale, in ogni caso, questa Amministrazione è in grado di intervenire direttamente e nel modo più energico qualora venissero segnalati risultati di responsabilità o colpe di qualsiasi genere, non riesco a rendermi conto del provvedimento che il Col. Gabriel si riserverebbe di adottare nei confronti di detto personale, prov-

vedimento che avrebbe solo carattere di rappresaglia ingiustificata, anzi dannosa per la stessa sorveglianza della Tenuta.

Attualmente, infatti, in seguito agli accordi presi con le autorità del posto, i Cacciatori Guardia in servizio a San Rossore prestano già la loro opera di collaborazione con i Carabinieri, effettuando attiva opera di vigilanza ed eseguendo periodici rastrellamenti.

Io, dal mio canto, mi sono fatto premura di impartire disposizioni precise perché tutto indistintamente il personale residente a San Rossore dia la sua collaborazione per la sorveglianza della Tenuta e perché venga disciplinato, d'intesa col Comando del Campo, l'accesso alla Tenuta delle persone che vi si debbono recare per ragioni di lavoro, ed ho motivo di ritenere che tale collaborazione risulterà sommamente utile per i fini che si vogliono raggiungere.

Senonché il minacciato allontanamento di tutti i civili da San Rossore da parte del Comando del Campo Prigionieri si tiene alquanto preoccupato, in considerazione dei gravissimi danni che ne deriverebbero a questa Amministrazione. Infatti la Tenuta di S. Rossore è l'unica azienda attiva di questa Amministrazione, la quale regge il suo bilancio con gli introiti derivanti dalle lavorazioni boschive ed agricole di detta Tenuta. Oltre a ciò mi preoccupa assai la sorte che verrebbe a toccare ad un gran numero di famiglie le quali, nel caso che venissero allontanate da San Rossore, non troverebbero né dove alloggiare né come sostentarsi.

E' in tale considerazione che mi permetto segnalare quanto sopra alla S.V. Ill.ma, con preghiera di voler benevolmente esaminare la possibilità di disporre che venga in ogni caso evitato il minacciato allontanamento delle famiglie residenti in San Rossore.

Questa Amministrazione, dal suo canto, sarà ben lieta di continuare a dare la sua opera di collaborazione perché la sorveglianza della Tenuta venga intensificata; collaborazione che, per essere fatta da personale pratico della Tenuta, mi pare possa riuscire di grande utilità.

Levio alla S.V. Ill.ma i miei più vivi ringraziamenti per quanto si compiacerà di disporre in ordine alla situazione prospettata, e mi è grata l'occasione per porgere i miei più rispettosi ossequi.

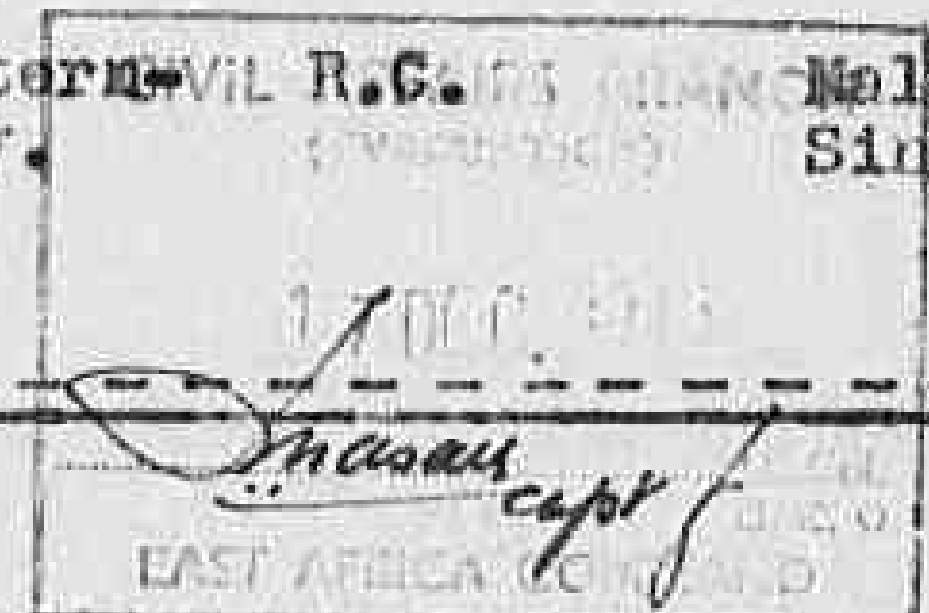

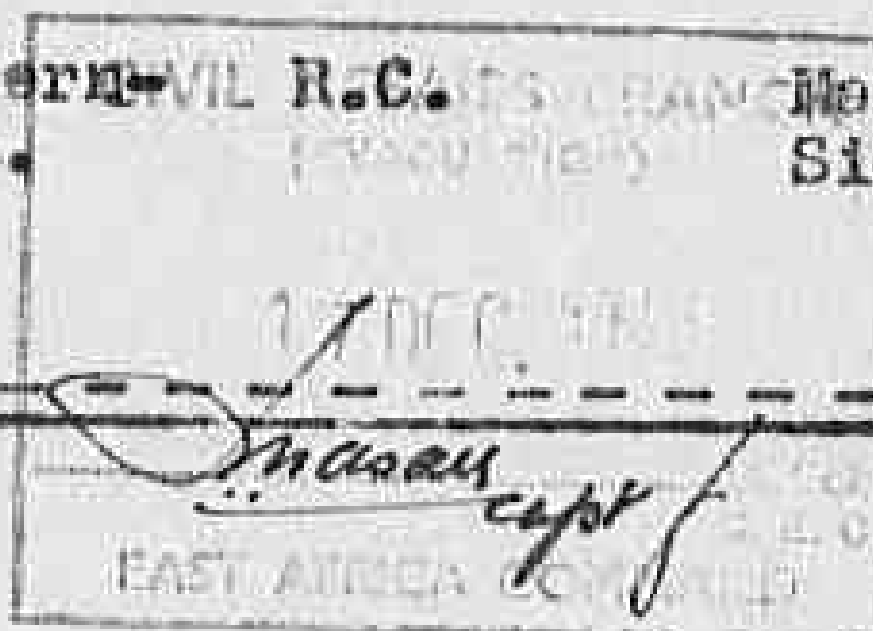

Dear Madam,

Your letter dated 15th Nov. 1946, addressed to Admiral Stone has been forwarded to me.

I note that you have regained your Australian nationality, but I must point out that you are in effect a dual national, that you are regarded by the Italians as Italian, and that while you are living in Italy, you take your second nationality which is Italian. From that point of view it is extremely difficult for us to help you in any way, as dual nationals are not entitled to the protection of His Majesty's Consular Officers, while resident in the country of their second nationality.

In any case, even British subjects while resident in Italy, come under the same regulations about requisitioning, as do Italian citizens and while we can ask the Commissariato degli Alloggi not to requisition British property, if they can help it, we have no power whatsoever to force them to accede to our wishes.

In these circumstances, I regret that we cannot help you and that you must come to some arrangement with the Italian authorities, as an ordinary Italian citizen.
