SUBJECT: Italian Personnel.

Referring to the proposal advanced by you, through C.A., this Administration has decided as follows:

1. The permanent staff officials and clerks on contract, who on the 1st July were already on leave without pay, are authorized to repatriate.
2. The extraordinary personnel on leave without pay, who, invited to repatriate, ask to remain in the Colony, shall be discharged from the date of their refusal and be granted the discharge bonus as soon as possible.
3. The daily paid clerks employed with B.M.A. shall be considered as 'Local engaged personnel' ceasing to be dependents of the Italian Administration from the date of their employment with B.M.A.
4. The permanent staff and clerks on contract, invited to repatriate to Italy and unwilling to do so, are put on temporary payroll for reasons of ill-health or urgent family motives.

The repatriation of all high permanent staff officials and clerks still on duty, shall be allowed after a request has been made for each individual case. This should be accompanied by a declaration from your office showing serious health or family motives and also authorization of BMA.

This Ministry could substitute, from time to time, if BMA wishes, other names on request.

In order to avoid any argument, it would be better, to make known in detail to all the personnel the decisions of this Ministry and see that in every individual case the personnel office of BMA obtains the necessary papers showing that the employee has full knowledge of the Ministerial's decisions as well as the consequences deriving from his own actions.



To the Ministry of Italian Africa.

I am to draw your attention upon the necessity of regularizing the position of the personnel of the Italian Government, on leave without pay in Tripolitania.

On 1st June 1946, there are here 450 employees on leave without pay, of whom 340 are in the "personal straordinario" class, that is they were temporarily engaged for exceptional jobs which have now ceased.

The present position of the personnel on leave without pay is irregular and cannot go on for ever.

Now therefore I suggest:

1. Permanent staff officials and clerks should be ordered back to Italy forthwith.
2. "Straordinario" personnel should be discharged and a date fixed for the discharge so that the bonus due thereon could be given.
3. The daily paid clerks should be shifted into the employ of B.M.A. as "Local engaged personnel" and ceased from their quality of Civil Servants of the Italian Government.
4. Those who wish to repatriate, no matter to which class they belong, should be allowed to do so, provided a suitable replacement could be found. Many are suffering from a too-length separation from their families.
5. Should some of these who are to be ordered back to Italy be unwilling to move now, then the normal treatment should be made to them for such cases.

I would be grateful if your directions will be sent here, through ALCOM.
