Dear Captain Oddi:

The Secretariat of State of His Holiness takes the liberty to request that you recommend to the kind consideration of the competent Allied Authorities the petition of His Excellency Giacinto Ambrosi, Bishop of Chioggia for the derequisition of the diocesan seminary.

The request states that as a result of the aerial bombardments on the city of Chioggia the episcopal seminary was requisitioned by the authorities. Now that the war is over, some of the quarters of the building have been returned to the Bishop but, for moral and educational reasons it is imperative that the entire seminary be vacated in order properly to carry on the formation of youth for the priesthood.



PROMEMORIE

On October 29th, 1945, the villa "Piorita",  
Salita Scudillo 19, Naples-Capodimonte, belonging to the Swiss  
citizen, Mrs. Laura Neuricoffe, was requisitioned  
by the British Forces. At present the villa is occupied by  
Palestinian nurses attached to the 92nd General British  
Hospital (Coy. B. Platoon 610 Op. M.S.).

Mrs. Neuricoffe, the 56 years old widow of  
Mr. Neuricoffe, who for 40 years was Swiss Honorary Consul in  
Naples, returned from Switzerland on December 1st, 1945 and  
tried since then to have her villa de-requisitioned. All  
efforts to that end have failed till now, the Town Major of  
Naples being of the opinion that for the present there was  
no possibility to quarter these nurses elsewhere.

The Legation of Switzerland would appreciate  
it if, in consideration of the age of Mrs. Neuricoffe and the  
eminent services her husband rendered to the Swiss Government  
during 40 years as well as the precarious way she is living  
at present in a small corner to the villa, the British Military  
authorities could see their way to de-requisition the afore-  
mentioned Swiss property.

On October 29th, 1943, the villa "Viorite", Salita Scudillo 19, Naples-Capodimonte, belonging to the Swiss citizen, Mrs. Laura Meuricoffe, was requisitioned by the British Forces. At present the villa is occupied by Palestinian nurses attached to the 92nd General British Hospital (CCY F-Platoon 610 C.P.A.T.S.).

Mrs. Meuricoffe, the 85 years old widow of Mr. Meuricoffe, who for 40 years was Swiss Honorary Consul in Naples, returned from Switzerland on December 1st, 1945 and tried since then to have her villa deregquisitioned. All efforts to that end have failed till now, the Town Major of Naples being of the opinion that for the present there was no possibility to quarter these nurses elsewhere.

The legation of Switzerland would appreciate it if, in consideration of the age of Mrs. Meuricoffe and the eminent services her husband rendered to the Swiss Government during 40 years as well as the precarious way she is living at present in a small annex to the villa, the British Military Authorities could see their way to deregquisition the aforementioned Swiss property.
