I again visited No. 8 Command Pay Office in relation to this matter and found that the previous officers who had any knowledge of this case had left.

Eventually the correspondence was found and from it, it appeared that HQ, to whom the matter had been referred, had lost the correspondence in their move.

I pointed out that this matter has been outstanding since April 46 and that we were being pushed for payment by the British Embassy.

I requested that a cable be sent to GHQ asking for immediate authority to settle this question and stated that if no satisfaction was received, the matter would be referred to AFHQ.

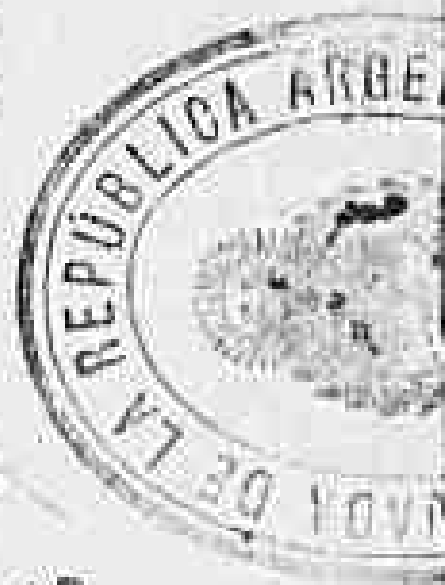

The Embassy of the Argentine Republic to the Quirinal, thanks the Allied Commission in Italy for the information transmitted by 28 January letter and points out that what is stated in paragraph 7, that follows, cannot be accepted:-

" In all the circumstances, therefore, it does appear that the request by the Argentine Embassy does not disclose all the facts of the case, and is not made in the best of faith. The car does not appear to be really required by its owner."

The Argentine Embassy cannot admit that the Militar Commandant of Trieste should allow itself to doubt its good faith when it intervenes for this, as for any other, question concerning the Argentine interests or of its dependents.

In view of the above and as a proof of the renewed insistence of the Consul General Mr. Frischi Puccio, we transmit the continuation of the cable which we received from Lisbon on the 26th January:

" Argentine Ambassador - Rome. Reference note 155. I shall be grateful to your Excellency in case the sequester should be lifted to entrust by means of Consulate General - firm A. Parisi of Genoa with a branch in Trieste to see to the transport of car on first steamer going to Lisbon after letting me know the cost. "Regards Frischi Puccio".

Since in paragraph 8 of the letter of the Allied Commission Trieste has stated the desire to leave the car under requisition before taking a final decision for the shipment of the vehicle to Lisbon, the Embassy would like to know if the Allied Commission is ready to pay the value of the vehicle and, if so, ~~taxist~~ the amount of the same in order to inform the proprietor who has to decide whether to sell it or insist for the restitution.

The Argentine Embassy takes the opportunity to express to the Allied Commission in Italy the sentiments of its highest consideration.
