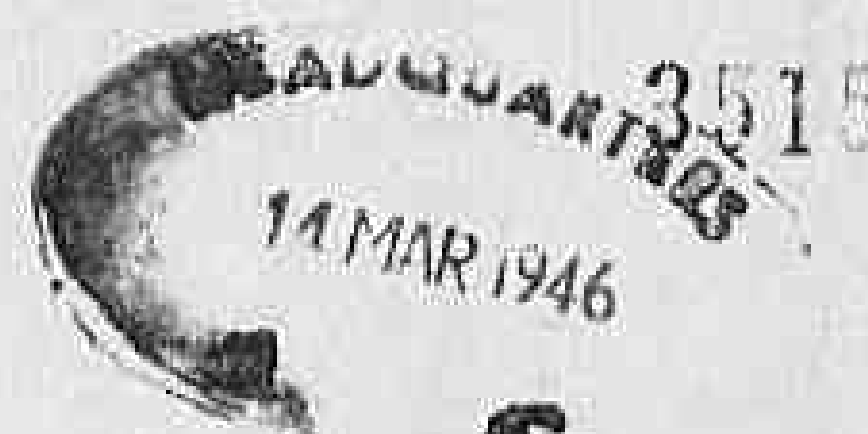

Dear Captain Tunnard,

I am sending you herewith a copy of a Note from the Vatican asking for visas and facilities for Monsignor Brini, an official of the Secretariat of State, who has been appointed Secretary of the Apostolic Delegation in Turkey at Constantinople.

2. Monsignor Brini's Diplomatic passport is in order, and he has been granted by our Embassy a Diplomatic visa for Egypt and Palestine in transit to Turkey, and by the French Embassy, a Diplomatic visa for transit through Syria and the Lebanon; he also has a Turkish Diplomatic visa.

3. We shall be grateful if you can now obtain for Monsignor Brini the facilities asked for by the Vatican to enable him to fly to Cairo and Constantinople, taking with him 200 kilos of luggage which will include the Vatican Diplomatic Bag for Turkey.

4. If air transport from Cairo to Constantinople is impracticable, Monsignor Brini would do that part of the journey by train.

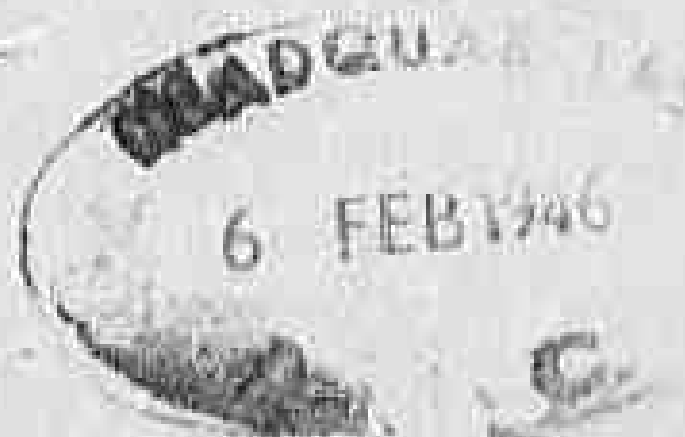

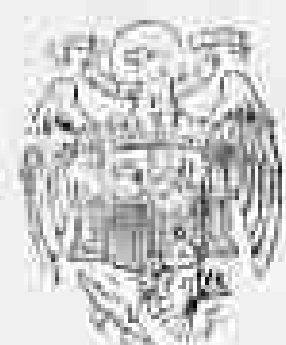
