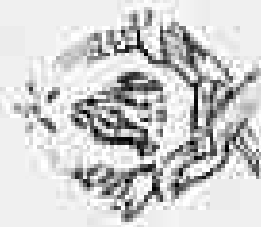

1. The requirements of AFHQ letter A.G.371.2 GBI-O of 22 March 1946 subject Travel Control - Abolition of Allied Force Permit System is causing undue hardships on the members of the Yugoslav and Greek Delegations to the Advisory Council for Italy.

2. In the a/m letter the military AF permits were abolished and visas were thereafter required for entry into Italy. As the Yugoslav and Greeks have no diplomatic relationship with the Italian Government the obtaining of an Italian visa is an impossibility. Thus the Greeks and Yugoslav diplomats who must leave Italy to confer with their governments have no valid means by which they can re-enter Italy since Italian visas are not available and military travel orders only exempt American and British Service Personnel from the requirements of a visa.

3. May this office have your comments on the above and if possible, a solution.

1. Reference the attached AFHQ letter AG 371.2 GBI-O of 22 March 1946.

2. The effect of the above letter on travel into Italy for members of the Greek and Yugoslav Delegations to A.C.I. has caused a great deal of annoyance to various of its military members.

3. Last week Lt.Col.Assimakopoulos, Military Adviser to the Greek Delegation to A.C.I., requested travel orders for air travel Rome-Athens and return. This office kindly informed the Greek Delegation of these following facts:

a) That the re-entry into Italy of Lt.Col.Assimakopoulos would require that he have in his possession an Italian visa (since AF permits for entry-Italy have been abolished by para.2 of AFHQ letter AG 371.2 GBI-O).

b) That the Allied Commission could not issue him a travel order for re-entry Italy as requested by him due to the fact that para.3 of the same AFHQ letter exempts only American and British Service Personnel from the requirements of an Italian visa when in possession of valid travel orders.

4. Since the date of my above explanation the Greek Delegation has tried various means to pressure this office into conceding that they as allies should enjoy the equal privileges of exemption from a visa requirement under para.3 of the a/m AFHQ letter and therefore should be issued a military travel order at once.

5. Furthermore, issuance of military travel orders for intra-theater travel is highly restricted by MTOUSA Circular-number 38 of 16 March 1946.

6. The Greek Delegation admits the possibility of easily obtaining Italian entry visas thru the Swiss Legation at Rome without contacting

7) The minor reason for desiring military travel orders is to circumvent the requirement for payment of air passage.

8) May this office please have the Brigadier's assurance that its interpretation (as per para.3) is correct, and in accordance with his views and policy.

1. This Delegation are in possession of your letter No 731/80/EC of 20 April 1946 in which you refer them to para 3 of AFHQ letter A.G. 3 GBI-0 of 22 March 1946 which reads as follows: "American and British Service Personnel in possession of valid travel orders are exempted of the requirements of a visa."

2. It should be pointed out however, that issue of travel orders and air-passage from Rome to Athens and return is asked for Col. Assimakopoulos not in his capacity of a Greek military but in his quality of technical military adviser to the Greek Delegate to the Advisory Council for Italy.

3. You are undoubtedly aware that the Advisory Council is an inter-allied body forming part of the machinery of the control for the application of the armistice terms in Italy.

4. It should follow consequently that members of this Council and their advisers should not need an Italian visa in order to reenter Italy for the continuation of their functions on the Advisory Council for Italy.

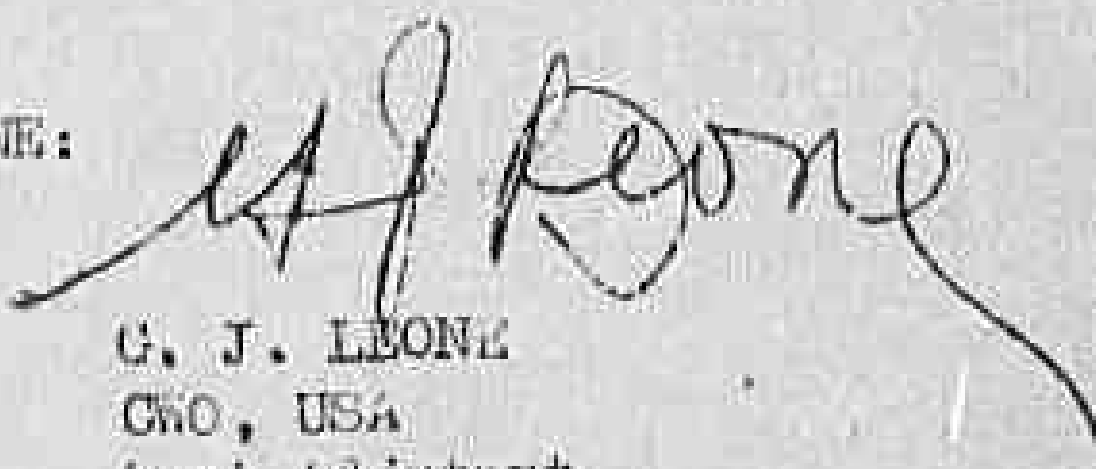

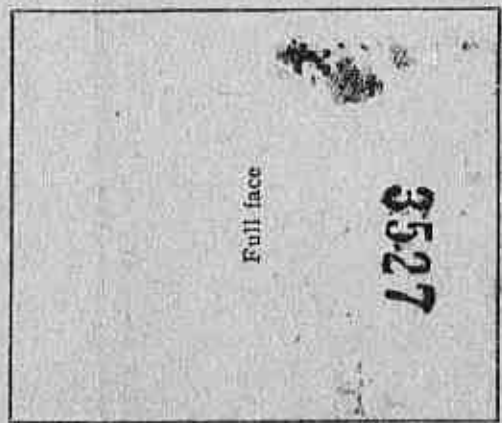
