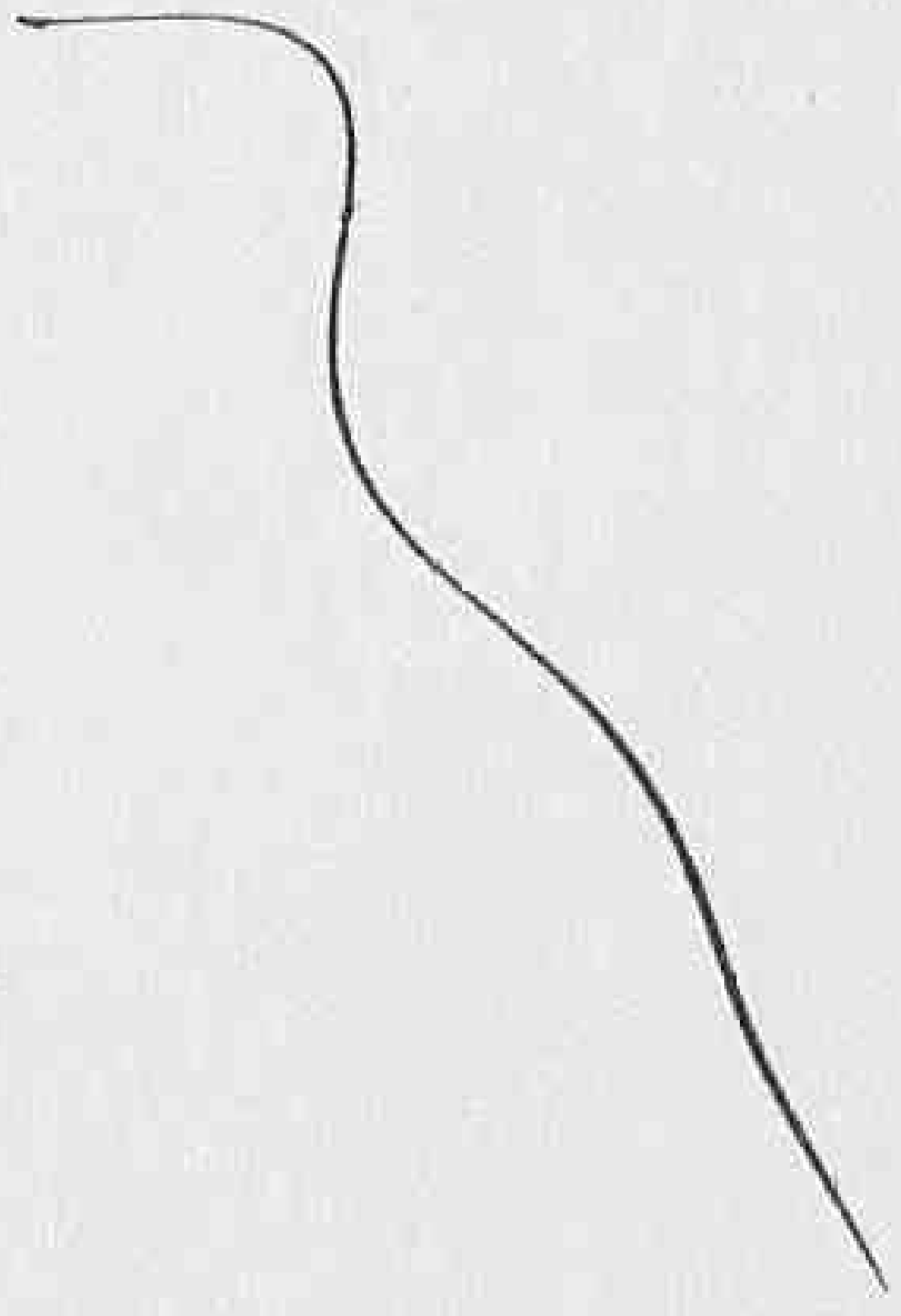

The Yugoslav Delegation A.C.I. has the honour to state as follows:-

- 1) In October 1944 the Military Mission of the Yugoslav Army in Rome hired a flat in Via Lima 41/9 from Signora Fregonaro for the use of some officers, as billets and office.
- 2) The use of electricity in the flat was regulated by a special authorization of the Allied Authorities. The resp. document is in possession of the a/n Azienda.
- 3) The Yugoslav Delegation A.C.I. took over the flat from the Military Mission at the time of the liquidation of the Mission. The Delegation billeted there its economic counsellor Mr. Antunac and the secretary Dr. Mihaljevic.
- 4) The Yugoslav Mission was regularly paying all electricity bills as received.
- 5) On January 22 one representative of the a/n Azienda stated that electric heaters were used in the flat and he cut off immediately all the wires, though the use of electric current for heating purposes has been granted by Allied authorities.
- 6) Dr. Mihaljevic was called to Signor Broner, official of the Azienda. There he was shown a bill for the heating of water in the bath room in amount of Lire 20,794.30 (See Encl. 1) In this sum every kwh was reckoned with to day's maximal punitive tax of Lire 5. a kwh Dr. Mihaljevic was told that the wires in his flat will not be reconnected before he has paid the a. sum.
- 7) Dr. Mihaljevic paid the amount immediately, (see encl. 1) in order to show his correctness and to get back electricity that he needs for his work.
- 8) From the bill enclosed under 2 it can be seen that heating of bath room used to be reckoned a forfait before. It is possible that the order issued by Allied Authorities did not include a particular clause for the bath room heating by omission, but it is possible too that the mechanic of the Azienda made the omission in connecting cables. In each case the consumed current should have the maximal punitive fee, since the omission was not caused by the Yugoslav authorities.
- 9) You are courteously entreated that a/n Azienda be bidden to make a revision of the enclosed bill and to proceed in a more correct way in future.

1. The supply of solid fuels to the British and American delegations can be met from Allied Military sources.
2. The Italian Government is responsible for supplying the other delegations.

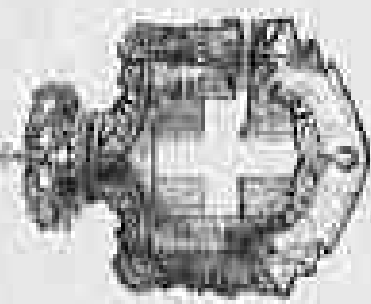

SUBJECT: Accounting for Issues to United States Department and Foreign
Diplomatic Representatives.

TO : All Concerned

1. Reference is made to the following publications which are concerned with issues of United States Army supplies to United States Department agencies and to diplomatic representatives of foreign governments:

a. Section II, AFHQ Administrative Memorandum Number 13, 1945.

b. Letter, this headquarters, AG 400/266 D-0, dated 12 February 1945, subject: "Supplies for the American Embassy".

c. Letter, this headquarters, office of the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-4, dated 5 April 1945, subject: "Supply of United States State Department Missions and Representatives within MTOUSA". (copy inclosed).

2. The purpose of this letter is to set forth the methods of accounting for issues from United States Army sources to United States State Department agencies and diplomatic representative of foreign governments. The provisions of this letter are not to be construed as granting authority for such issues.

3. Sales of essential clothing to United States citizens will be made for cash from Army Exchange stores as provided in paragraph 11, NATOUSA Circular Number 3, 1944.

4. Rations consumed in United States Army messes will be paid for in accordance with paragraph 3, Section IV, NATOUSA Circular Number 116, 1944.

5. Issues, other than temporary loans, POL and those items in paragraphs 3 and 4 above, made to United States State Department agencies will be accomplished on a reimbursement basis in accordance with AR 35-980. Payment will be tendered in the form of lire, United States State Department draft or a United States Treasury check drawn in favor of the Treasurer of the United States. Charges for bulk sales of rations will be in agreement with current price list plus a surcharge of ten (10) per cent as provided in AR 35-900. Due to the impracticability of accounting, no charge will be made for POL furnished for official purposes.

6. Issues, when authorized to diplomatic agencies of foreign governments,

will be on a sales basis. Such sales will be recorded on shipping ticket in quintuplicate quoting authority for the issue certifying that the receiving foreign government is obligated to reimburse the United States in dollars and signed by a competent official of the receiving government. In no case, should lire be accepted in payment for supplies issued to diplomatic agencies of foreign governments. Charges will be based on current list prices plus twenty-five (25) per cent to cover "landed costs". The original and 4 copies of the shipping ticket will be furnished this headquarters for forwarding to the Fiscal Director, Washington D.C. for collection. This procedure conforms with AR 35-950.
