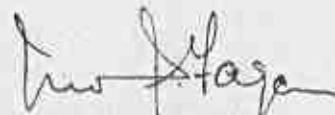

5. It is understood that the only Jugo-Slav Military Mission now in existence in Italy and recognised by the Allied Forces is that in Venezia Giulia, and issues of petrol to these personnel, in ROME should only be made after consultation with Allied Commission. Confirmation is requested.
6. It is understood the Jugo-Slav Delegation to A.C.I. formerly drew petrol from military Stocks through the super garage, but that now this mission is to draw from civil sources. Confirmation is requested.
7. It would appear that there are no Jugo-Slav military or civil organisations, other than those mentioned in para 5 above, in Italy who are entitled to draw petrol from military petrol points or resources. Your confirmation is requested.
8. Action will be taken to ensure all petrol points in the ROME AREA are warned that Jugo-Slavs may not be issued with POL

from army resources as soon as confirmation of paras, 4,5,6, and 7 is received.

9. It is presumed that the vouchers together with covering letter will be dispatched to AFHQ through the Allied Commission.

JUGOSLAV DELEGATION
TO THE ADVISORY COUNCIL FOR ITALY
Br. 34

The Yugoslav Representative to the Advisory Council for Italy presents his compliments to the Chief Commissioner, Allied Commission, and has the honour to state:

We have received in two copies the enclosed vouchers for petrol drawn in November and December 1945 from Allied institutions by an unexisting authority the "Royal Yugoslav Military Mission", with request to pay the due sum. With reference to it we kindly entreat you to inform the competent Allied Authorities about the following:

A) As it is well known to the A.F.H.Q. to the Allied Commission and to all Allied Authorities in Italy the "Royal Yugoslav Military Mission" has been dissolved by 31 March 1945. Under this fictitious name actually are hidden Chetniks, cobelligerents of Hitler and Mussolini during the war of the Nazist Germany against the United Nations.

B) Neither the Yugoslav Delegation A.C.I. nor the Yugoslav Government will recognize bills for petrol issued to the a/m unexisting Mission.

The enclosed vouchers show that some Allied Authorities in Italy do still supply Chetniks with petrol and that Chetniks are travelling around in Italy on Allied petrol. This is astonishing even more, since Allied Authorities have discontinued supplying with petrol from their sources this Delegation, representing the legal Government of Jugoslavia, one of the Allies of Great Britain and U.S.A. in the war against Hitler's Germany.

Enclosed we forward to you the original vouchers that we received and an evidence list made in basis of the same vouchers and showing what institutions he issued petrol and when, quantity numbers of motor cars and names of persons who signed the vouchers.
