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

Dear Sir,

When Mr. Vladetta Milichevitch, former Jugoslav Minister of the Interior, left Rome in 1941, he left his Packard car, 1940 model, in the private garage of Mr. Algretti, Via Tagliamento 41, Rome who agreed - and copy of this agreement is enclosed - to look after the car during Mr. Milichevitch's absence.

This car is the private property of Mr. Milichevitch, but had a diplomatic number (Roma 0159/Targa di circolazione) as he was at that time Special Attaché to the Jugoslav Embassy in Rome. He has an agreement with the Packard Agency, dated 14.11.1941, signed by Mr. Wagnarelli, and he also holds an official letter from the Swiss Legation - who were looking after the interests of Jugoslavia in Italy - stating that they would look after the car.

In 1943 our Group of Companies bought this car from M. Milichevitch and paid him an advance sum, the remainder to be paid when the car was delivered either to our representative in Rome, or Paris.

We believed that Mr. Milichevitch would be in a position to fulfil his agreement at an early date after the liberation of Italy, but up to now he has been unable to obtain possession of the car. A few months ago he informed us that he had learnt that the car had been taken, without his consent, from the private garage by Mr. Mihe Kreka, Jugoslav representative to the "Mediterranean Commission". Mr. Milichevitch made representations

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
to the Jugoslav Government in London, and the Jugoslav Prime Minister eventually made an order that Mr. Kreka should return the car to Mr. Algretti's garage. However, by that time Mr. Kreka had left Rome, and we now understand the car is being used by Mr. Slaven Smolska, a Jugoslavian official on the Mediterranean Commission.

We may add that when Mr. Kreka took the car from the private garage it was in first class condition, as the enclosed photograph will show, having completed only 500 miles. Mr. Milichevitch informs us that the car is by no means now in the same condition as it has been in constant and daily use.

Under these circumstances, the Alliance Press Group of Companies are seeking your aid to obtain possession of this car for Mr. Milichevitch and ultimately for ourselves, - for which we feel justified in pressing for compensation for wear and tear - and in the meantime to forbid its use and its conveyance out of Italy.

Any assistance or courtesy it is within your powers to extend to us will be very greatly appreciated by this Publishing House.
