Reference 799/72/EC, 20 Sept 45.

1. The Italian Government now has full responsibility for processing applications for entry into Italy for all persons other than:

a. Travellers, of all categories, from GERMANY and AUSTRIA.

b. American and British Service Personnel.

2. Exit from Italy and travel within Italy, except the 13 Corps disputed area, is no longer a concern of this Headquarters and you will therefore rescind the above referenced directive.

3. It will be appreciated, however, if where possible, this Headquarters is informed of the movements of all Russians and Jugoslavs purely for the purpose of information.

4. Applications for entry and travel within the Trieste AMG Zone must still be cleared with G-2, this Headquarters, before travel orders are issued to Personnel wishing to enter the 13 Corps Area.
