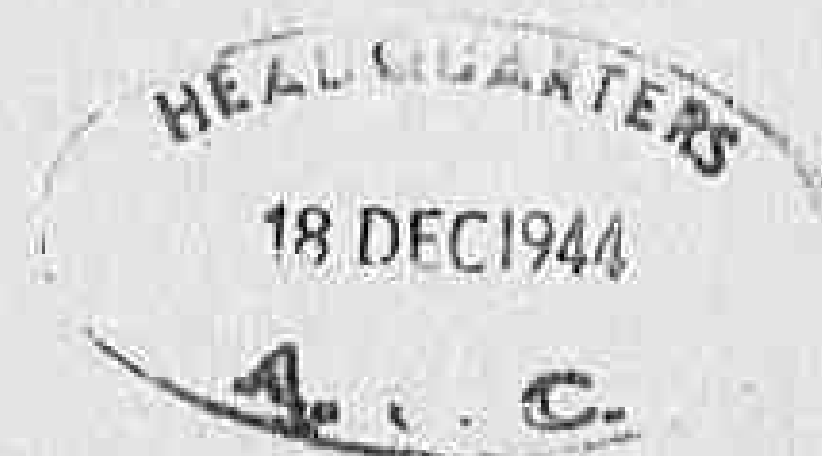

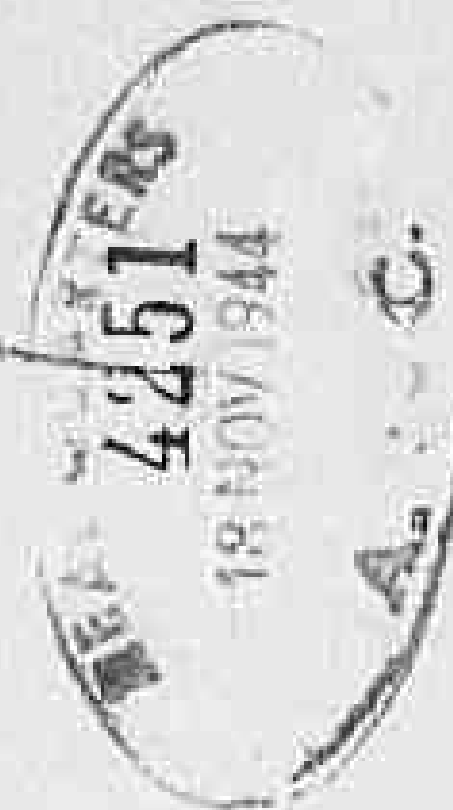

CHIEF OF STAFF.

Col. Lewin Harris telephoned to say that Lt. Col. Pitts would be arriving in Rome tomorrow. Col. Pitts is going to be civil affairs officer at the War Office dealing with the Mediterranean theatre. He is a big business man in civil life but has not much experience in civil affairs. However, he has been touring the Middle East and is now coming to find out what he can about the A.C.C. before returning to London. Col. Lewin Harris asks us to give him every assistance.

2. Col. Lewin Harris also told me that two British and two American civilians would arrive, probably tomorrow, but he would signal ETA. 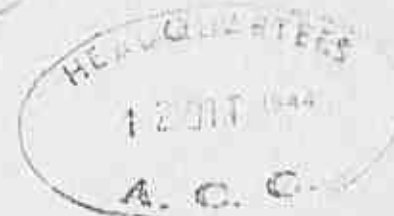

1. This note is to introduce Mr. Vanni B. Montana, Publicity and Research Director of the Italian-American Labor Council and Member of the Board of Directors of the American Committee for Italian Democracy. Mr. Montana was here with Messrs. Antonini and Baldanzi, the American Labor Group. He has remained in Italy to continue his research and is now proceeding to Sicily for a survey of labor conditions in which the American Government is interested.

2. I fully realize the difficulties of transport but I would be very pleased if it would be possible to assist Mr. Montana with some vehicle and, in some instances, railway transportation in order to cover the island. Mr. Montana will review with you his itinerary and obtain your full concurrence with it.

3. I have discussed this whole plan with Mr. Montana and he clearly understands that his research will in no way be reflected in any public utterances.
