1. Lt Colonel Albert, our Liaison Officer in Sardinia, reports that various Allied officers, principally from ALCOM, show up in Sardinia and ask for transportation for periods of several days.
2. The Allied transport at our disposal in Sardinia is now three vehicles. All of this transport is occupied most of the time on assigned duties, and is not available to visiting officers.
3. It is therefore necessary that officers planning trips outside Cagliari make arrangements for transportation prior to going to Sardinia, if necessary shipping a vehicle from the mainland for this purpose. Neither Italian Army or Italian civilian vehicles are available for visiting officers.
4. Accommodations for officers in Sardinia is available only at Cagliari where Colonel Albert can handle a limited number of US officers only if he has prior notification, and British officers can be accommodated by the RAF at Elmas, where the British officers must make their own arrangements. Officers traveling around the Island outside Cagliari must provide their own rations.
5. I request that you bring this to the attention of all ALCOM officers in order to avoid a waste of time and disappointments.

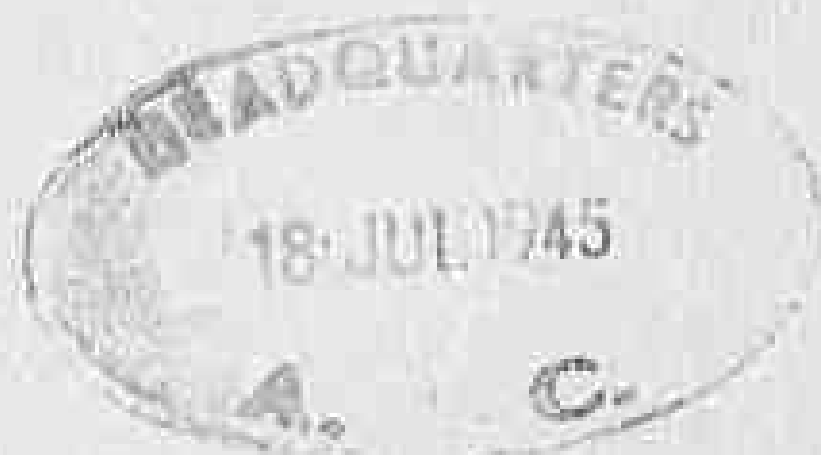

My dear Brigadier Lush,

Signals received here, which are not entirely clear, indicate that my request for permission to visit HQ XX Corps, copy of which you saw on your visit to this HQ on Sunday last, was forwarded by the Executive Officer, HQ AC, to AFHQ. Today a further signal was received denying permission for departure today, and requesting information as to the reasons for the visit, stating that the matter would then be presented again for consideration. Inasmuch as my original request was addressed for your personal attention and knowing that you were familiar with the circumstances, I did not state the reasons for my visit. In view of signal received today I am now reciting such reasons and shall be very grateful for your assistance in obtaining prompt and favourable consideration.

In view of the fact that I was not permitted to leave today, and that conferences are scheduled for Rome on 27th and 28th June, it will be impossible for me to make this visit until about July 1st or later, and my absence will, of course, depend upon conditions existing in the Region at that time. May I, therefore add a further request that permission, when granted, be reasonably wide in time limitations. HQ 5 Army and HQ IV Corps are prepared to issue necessary orders at this end at my request.

I shall bring Selby with me to the Rome conference as you directed. I should also like to bring Major Francis B. Reid (B), our Regional Industry Officer, to participate in the second days' discussions. He is extremely able and alert, and has a thorough grasp of the industrial and collateral situation in this Region, and I believe his presence would be helpful. I also plan to bring, as you directed, two or three of the leading Italian civilian economists whose contributions, I believe, will be helpful. In addition, the fact that their views are presented and considered will have an excellent psychological effect in this area. I trust it will be possible to arrange air transportation

Subject: Accommodation in Sardinia

1. Upon the departure of the Regional Commissioner and his Staff from Sardinia, the question of accommodation for officers visiting Sardinia becomes important.

a. The MMIA detachment in Sardinia has very limited accommodation. It is possible to accommodate only one transient US officer at a time at the MMIA mess in Cagliari, and this is a mess operated on US rations. It is understood that there is limited accommodations for British officers at the RAF Base at Elmas. All of the rations and supplies for the MMIA detachment in Sardinia must be secured from Naples 30 days in advance, and a large number of officers visiting Sardinia without advance notice will cause difficulties in supplying rations.

b. The transportation available to the MMIA detachment is also limited; and when officers from the mainland visit Sardinia, it will not be possible to make transport available to them in all cases.

c. It is understood that there is no civilian accommodation and messing facilities available in Sardinia for visiting officers.

2. It is suggested that before Allied Commission officers are allowed to travel to Sardinia that Colonel Albert be informed of the nature of the proposed visit, the time and length of the visit, and the transportation required in order to ascertain if satisfactory arrangements can be made. The request for this information should be transmitted to Colonel Albert through MMIA in order that proper coordination may be effected.
