SUBJECT: Visit to Milan

TO : A/VP. Economic Section.

Reference our telephone conversation.

1. I consider it essential to visit the Milan Office in connection with the closing down of the activities of the Branch in the North. In this respect it is necessary that I assure myself that the representatives of ARAR in Milan are fully in the picture regarding the handling of future releases made to them and to see that such releases are cleared quickly and signed acceptances sent to the CEM Branch at this Headquarters without delay.
2. The question of the handover of CAP/CEM vehicles used by the Branch and other agencies requires clarifying. This can only be done in Milan by conferring with the Representatives of ARAR and the Ispettorato Motorazione. The responsibility of a clean hand over is mine as Director of the Branch and it is only by discussing the question in Milan that this can be accomplished.
3. The question of CEM held and due for release by PBS, Lehorn requires discussion if a quick and satisfactory release has to be effected.

I have agreed with PBS to spend some time with them on this question on my return journey.
