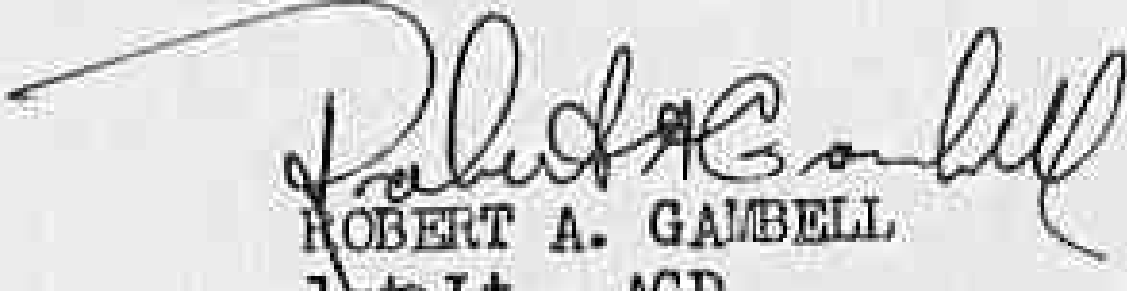

To: The Allied Force Headquarters - Caserta

I, the undersigned, Matteo Biancofiore, am the father of Michele Biancofiore, Cadet Officer attached to the 51st Bersaglieri Battalion, 2nd Company, American 5th Army, who died on December 8th 1943 in the battle of Montelungo Cassino. His citation is the following:

As Commander of an echelon of sharpshooters which was supposed to carry out an important action at dawn, as soon as the order to attack very strong enemy positions was received, he moved first and first was hit by a German bullet about the abdomen. Disregarding his own safety he went on in his action, only preoccupied of performing the task he had been entrusted with. Hit by a second machine-gun burst he went down. To his fellows who tried to rescue him, he told:

"Don't care about me; go on fighting for our Fatherland! Long live to Italy!"

Outstanding example of bravery and spirit of sacrifice, he was not much interested in losing his life and died while singing the "To Mother" song.

I am a poor father of 7 children and no pension has been granted to me so far.

I beg your Command to urge the Italian War-Ministry in conferring posthumously upon my son, Michele Biancofiore, the Golden Medal for the stamina he displayed while fighting against the Germans in the War of Liberation.

I, the undersigned, Misa Coen, British Subject,
beg to submit to you kind attention what follows:

As a British Subject I was put on the beginning
of this war in a concentration camp in Italy together with my
family. On the 5th day of January 1943 we were transferred
from Italy to a concentration camp in Germany. In this trans-
fer it was not possible for us to take our movables which we
left at Cammugnano (Bolegna) at Mr. Arnaldo Venturi's house.
This Mr. Venturi is an Italian Officer (Commissario), charged
for our camp.

The packages left at Cammugnano includes: 3 trucks
and 7 valices of clothings and other personal objects, two
mattresses, a sewing machine. The trousseau of my two daughters
and the wedding outfit of my son were contained in the valises,
besides other personal properties.

We are in urgent need of these objects and there-
fore I take the liberty to apply to your office to ask for
information about my case. Please take in due consideration
the fact that we are bare of clothings and all our objects we
left in Italy.

I seize the opportunity for informing you that
I am not receiving from the Government any subsidy.

Thanking you in advance for your interest in this
urgent case, I remain,

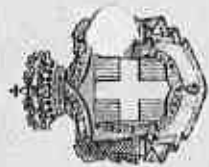
