Rear Polcorps have drawn attention to article in voce adriatica for 23 Nov and requested urgent intervention to prevent repetition. Article included resolution passed by Ancona town council protesting against accommodation of Poles in town and refusing to accept responsibility for any acts of violence by civil population. Polcorps state reasons for Poles remaining in Italy namely marriage to Italians is not generally known. Consider clarification in press of this point might help to ease situation.

AFTER THAT DATE A COURT MARTIAL STAFFED MOSTLY BY MARRIED TO ITALIAN WIVES IS HOPED TO BE ESTABLISHED TO DEAL WITH POLISH FAMILIES CENTRE IN ITALY ONLY. 1. The reliable information on this subject is very scanty.

It is understood that originally the children in question were taken from Poland by the Germans as orphans to Austria for re-education in the Nazi system. There are indications to show that some children may have been moved to Italy as early as October 1945.

2. The question was originally raised in Italy in May at a joint meeting between A.C. and U.S.A. Although no names could be obtained, enquiries were at once ordered in the Berletta-Frand Polish Dependents Camp; although it was felt this would be almost an impossible task as P.W. GROUPS Units were continually sending their children to the Boarding Schools at the Camp when they became of the correct age.

There were over 1,500 children at Berletta-Frand at this time - mostly in Boarding Schools.

3. Towards the end of July 1946 a list of names of children who had left Camps in Austria was received from U.S.A. (Rome). These lists were sent to Berletta-Frand Camps.

A reply was despatched from these Camps on 16 August received in Rome on the 30th to the effect that :-

It was thus easily possible for POLISH to cover up the introduction of these 30 additional children.

1. It is regretted that this signal is not understood, unless there are grounds at A.F.H.Q. to believe that POLKOWS have sent some of the alleged missing Polish children from Austria into this Camp.

2. Nearly every week for the last 6 weeks some 300 people have left this Camp for Britain. POLKOWS have sent weekly almost a similar number into the Camp - women and children, who have been living with Units, which have been alerted for Britain. These women and children have to be sorted into those fit to travel by train, troopship or hospital ship and those not acceptable for Britain.

3. On the 24th of August the total Allied Staff of the Camp consisted of one British Officer and one Sergeant and although they do their best, it is humanly impossible for them personally to check every person who comes into the Camp.

4. Meanwhile on the assumption that such a signal would not have been sent without grounds for suspicion, the small Allied Staff at Barletta-Trani has been ordered to do their best to check this increase through Polish Channels.

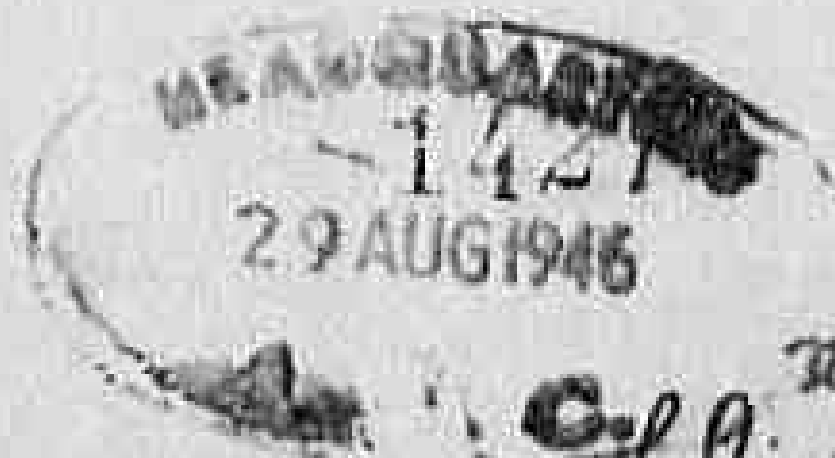

My dear Mr. Prime Minister,

It has been brought to the notice of the Supreme Allied Commander that Polish Military and para-military personnel of 2 Polish Corps wishing to return to Italy from the Middle East and from Allied Occupied Europe are being denied entry because of the Italian Government's refusal to issue visas. I understand that representations on this subject have also been made to the Ministry for Foreign Affairs by the British Embassy.

These persons are required to enter Italy in the performance of their normal military duties. Many of them are required now to join their units in Italy in order to accompany them to the United Kingdom. Their delay in rejoining their units in Italy is likely therefore to prolong the stay of Polish personnel in this country.

The Supreme Allied Commander has therefore directed me in the absence of the Chief Commissioner to explain to you that the current move of 2 Polish Corps from Italy makes the free movement of Polish military and para-military personnel between Middle East, Allied Occupied Europe, and Italy a military necessity, on the same terms as presently apply to British and American military personnel.

In view of this military necessity the Supreme Allied Commander is issuing orders forthwith for the resumption of movement of Polish military and para-military personnel in Italy and the Allied travel control section have been informed that such personnel are authorised by the Supreme Allied Commander to enter Italy on production of military movement orders.

I am to assure you that this travel will be under the control of the Allied military authorities and that such personnel will either return to their proper stations outside Italy on completion of their missions or will leave Italy with 2 Polish Corps in the normal manner. Their stay in Italy therefore will be purely transitory as November 1st, 1946 is the target date by which the essential moves of 2 Polish Corps will be completed.

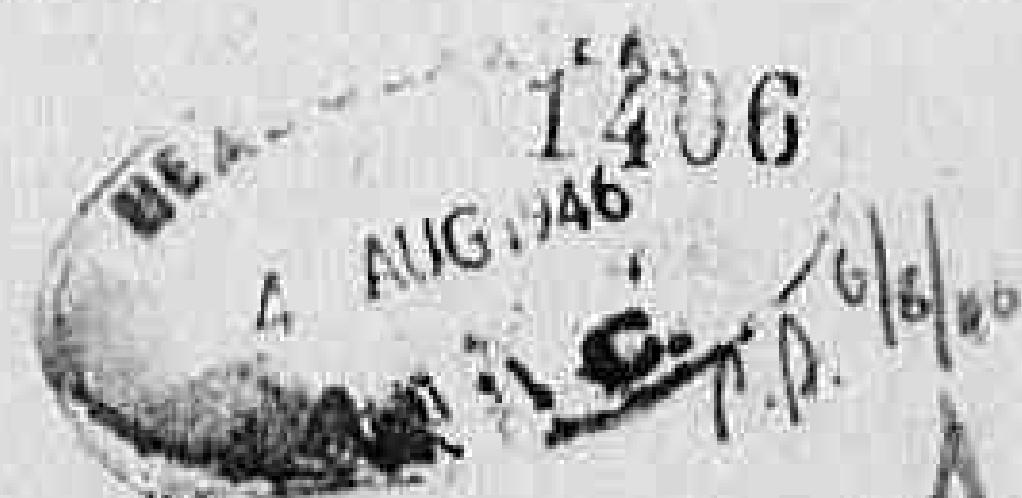

1. Forwarded herewith short report regarding the above two persons who are Poles and were in BARLETTA-TRANI refugee centre.
2. Investigations carried out by Polcorps Intelligence revealed a number of probable War Criminals and collaborators totalling to date some 19 persons. Among these were BILEWICZ Paweł and wife Fryderyka.
3. In order that the safety of these persons be assured, it was arranged to transfer them to the custody of an A.2. Camp. When the party was due to leave on Saturday 13 July, the two BILEWICZ's produced documents issued within the last month by the Polish Embassy and claimed its protection.
4. H.Q. D.P. & R.S.C. was informed of the situation and the Polish Embassy was contacted and asked if they wished to interview these persons and they replied they wished to do so.
5. On Monday 15 July the BILEWICZ's were brought to ROME and taken to the Polish Embassy by an officer of this Sub Commission. After questioning the BILEWICZ's and with the fact of alleged collaboration in mind, the Polish Embassy asked that they remain in protective custody.
6. On evening Monday 15 July the BILEWICZ family under escort were sent to 209 P.O.W. Camp AFRAGOLA to join the remainder of the suspected persons in protective custody.
