My dear Mr. Keany :

Thank you for your letter of 15 May regarding the non-distribution, by the Italian Government, of certain commodities which were imported into Italy under the military and FEA program.

Since the meeting of 3 May, there has been action in several areas which promises favourable results. A new program to accomplish the distribution of medical supplies and to provide financing has been set up within the Italian Government. Your Headquarters has been informed by Col. Frizelle on this program. To further stimulate the movement of clothing, prices have been readjusted downward. With respect to tractors, meetings have been held in the Allied Commission with the representatives of certain Ministries. Italian Government has authoritatively established prices for the tractors and has promised to come forward with a complete distribution scheme, including a closer definition of ministerial responsibility.

Having already addressed to the Prime Minister on this subject, and having received a reply from him, and because of the activity in the several fields, I do not favour either a separate AC or a joint AC/UNRRA letter at the moment. However, if it becomes apparent that there will be no effective distribution, and if you still so desire, I shall be glad to consider the matter further.

It was not practicable to call a meeting on 18 May, as suggested by you. In view of the understandings had
