The "Risorgimento Liberale" has been reliably informed from Trieste that the Allied Military Police, on searching some propaganda centres of the Italo-Slovene Antifascist Union last week, found and confiscated military call-ups and other documents proving operations on the part of these centres in favour of the partisan movement in Greece, against the Government. Stop. Relevant correspondence states that this information substantially confirms rumors recently circulated in Cairo claiming that volunteers for the Greek front are mobilized in the Venice area. Stop. It is a fact that for some time past military call-ups have been issued to Italian partisans and Communists. Stop. Some not knowing what the future holds in store for them have presented themselves, but many have preferred to remain in hiding having no intention of taking part in this provocative attack against the Greek people.
