1. Herewith details of Order of Battle and Staff Tables for personnel, weapons and vehicles as requested for both the Interior Army and the CC.RR.

2. I must point out that the figures are an approximation only and cannot be considered accurate in detail, for the following reasons.

(a) Considerable discussion as to the organization and equipment of the Inf Divs, Independent Regts and Internal Security Divs is in progress with the Ministry of War, as regards detail, though the general framework has been agreed. This discussion includes the policy of placing all inf units of all three types of formation upon the same HQ, as well as amendments considered necessary in view of past battle experience and of future requirements. It will involve the detailed re-writing of the HQ of nearly every unit in the formations mentioned.

(b) The Ministry of War are not yet firm as to their detailed requirements for personnel, weapons or vehicles in the HQ of administrative units or of training establishments. The responsibility for this detail lies with the Ministry of War, and it is impossible to reconcile possibly divergent views in a few days. Until agreement has been reached HQ cannot be written.

(c) This HQ awaits the arrival of the officers for the CC.RR. Section charged with the detailed examination of the present organization of the CC.RR. and with agreeing with the Ministry of War any reorganization considered necessary. This reorganization is likely to be extensive.

(d) Even when the views of the Ministry of War have crystallized in detail and agreement with them has been reached on this detail, considerable time must be allowed for the Ministry of War to re-write the HQs of an army, even of small size, and to have their figures checked by this HQ.

2. I must point out that the figures are an approximation only and cannot be considered accurate in detail, for the following reasons.

(c) This HQ awaits the arrival of the officers for the O.O.B.R. Section charged with the detailed examination of the present organization of the O.O.B.R. and with agreeing with the Ministry of War any reorganization considered necessary. This reorganization is likely to be extensive.

(d) Even when the views of the Ministry of War have crystallized in detail and agreement with them has been reached on this detail, considerable time must be allowed for the Ministry of War to re-write the VC of an army, even of small size, and to have their figures checked by this HQ.

3. Figures submitted to you are accordingly arrived at as follows:

(a) INF DIVS AND INDEPENDENT REGTS

General agreement with Ministry of War upon the new org of these formations mutually desired by the Ministry and by this HQ.

Detailed requirements have NOT been received from the Ministry. Calculations have therefore been made by G(M) of this HQ from existing I.M.N VC reconciled with appropriate BRITISH standard VC, in the case of additions to the old organization.

(b) INTERNAL SECURITY DIVS

On the assumption that the inf element of these Divs will be interchangeable with that of the inf divs and independent regts.

(c) THE ESTS and ADM UNITS

On figures supplied by the ILLINJIS during the past week, in most cases varying from those previously shown by them. These figures have been only generally agreed and roughly checked by this HQ.

(d) CC.RR.

ILLINJIS org, and ILLINJIS figures unchecked and unaltered by this HQ, who are not necessarily in agreement with them. It is, however, anticipated that the figures arrived at after eventual reorganization of the CC.RR. by the CC.RR. Sec of this HQ, when these officers are posted, will be substantially lower than those at present submitted.

CEILINGS

(a) Ceilings for Command and Administrative units conform exactly to those laid down in your AG 031.711 G(ED)-8 of 2 Nov 45.

(b) Request has been made in my G/3/1 of 1 Dec 45 to transfer 2,500 bodies from the Local Reserve block to the Training and Reinforcement block, making the former 37,500 instead of 40,000 and the latter 12,500 instead of 10,000.

(c) (i) In order to provide a sound tactical organization for the Inf Divs, Independent Regts and Internal Security Divs, it has been found provisionally necessary to exceed, on paper according to personnel Tables of WGA, the ceiling of 50,000 (Mobile Reserve) plus 37,500 (new figure for Local Reserves) total 87,500, by some 1,250.

(ii) In agreement with this HQ, the Ministry of War propose in fact to offset this paper excess by physical non-implementation of certain sub-units (one MG pl per bn of Inf in all formations and one tp of 40m in each ILLJIS is suggested) giving a saving of some 4,000.

(iii) This will in fact keep the number of men present with the Local and Mobile Reserve blocks well within the ceiling prescribed by you. Your approval of this policy is requested.

5. The Ministry of War have requested verbally that, in spite of the fact that no such units exist in the Interim Army, they should be allowed to maintain a small nucleus of officers and men trained for Med rty. Hy and by bridging. If you are in agreement with this policy, small quantities of suitable equipment would be required to be held by the respective schools. This equipment is NOT included in

(ii) In agreement with this HQ, the Ministry of War propose in fact to offset this paper excess by physical non-implementation of certain sub-units (one MGR pl per Bn of Inf in all formations and one tp of 40mm in each Ld Bty in suggested) giving a saving of some 4,000.

(iii) This will in fact keep the number of men present with the Local and Mobile Reserve blocks well within the ceiling prescribed by you. Your approval of this policy is requested.

5. The Ministry of War have requested verbally that, in spite of the fact that no such units exist in the Italian Army, they should be allowed to maintain a small nucleus of officers and men trained for MGR, Bty, Bn and Bn bridging. If you are in agreement with this policy, small quantities of suitable equipment would be required to be held by the respective schools. This equipment is NOT included in the Staff Tables prepared.

6. The standardization of transport in the Italian Army and the ability of the Italian Government to obtain an adequate quantity of "M" vehicles of new IT-LLM manufacture is under consideration with the Italian Government and Allied Commission. An appreciation will be forwarded on this subject at an early date.

7. Full details as to equipment and vehicles at present held by the Italian Army are in course of preparation and will be forwarded as a separate annexure to due course.

8. The delay in completion is due to the time necessary for the War Ministry to collate the figures raised by them from subordinate formations, particularly with regard to the Combat Divs.

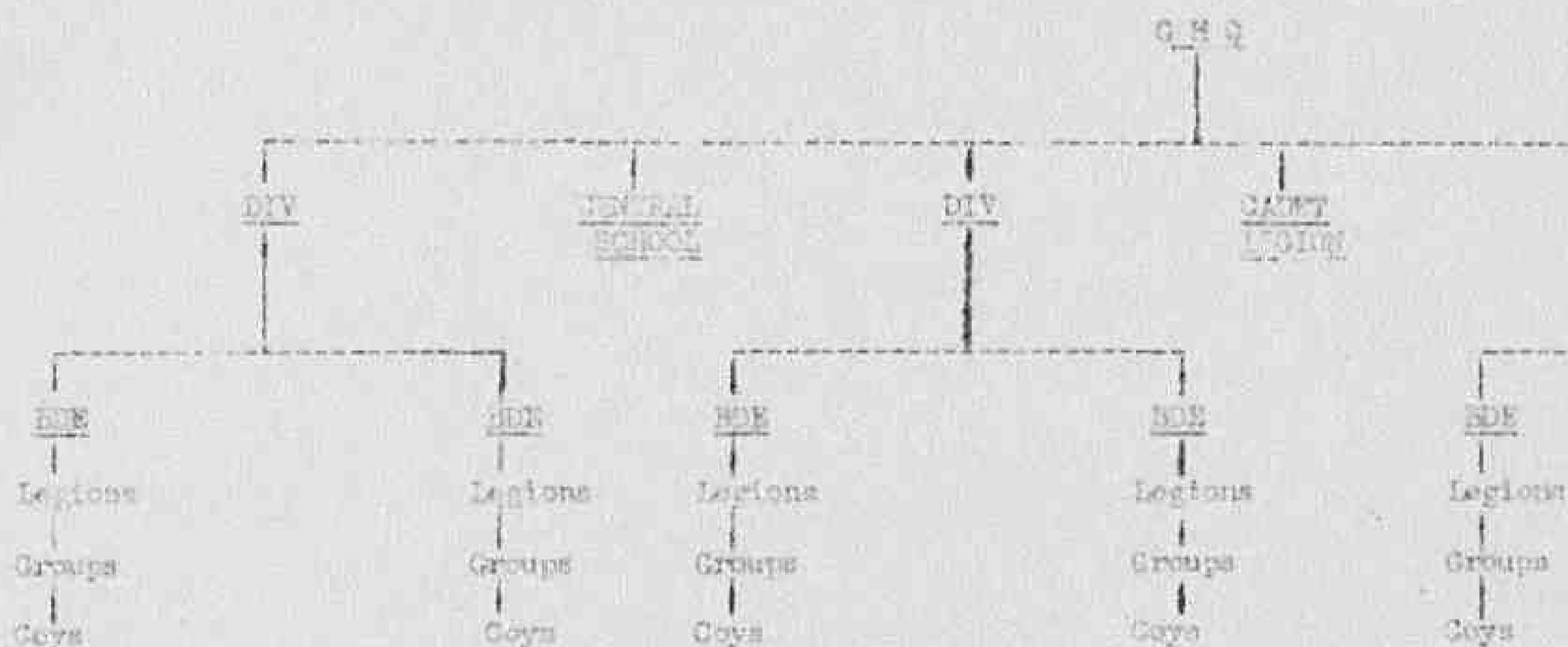

GENERAL LAYOUT - CARMINISPI

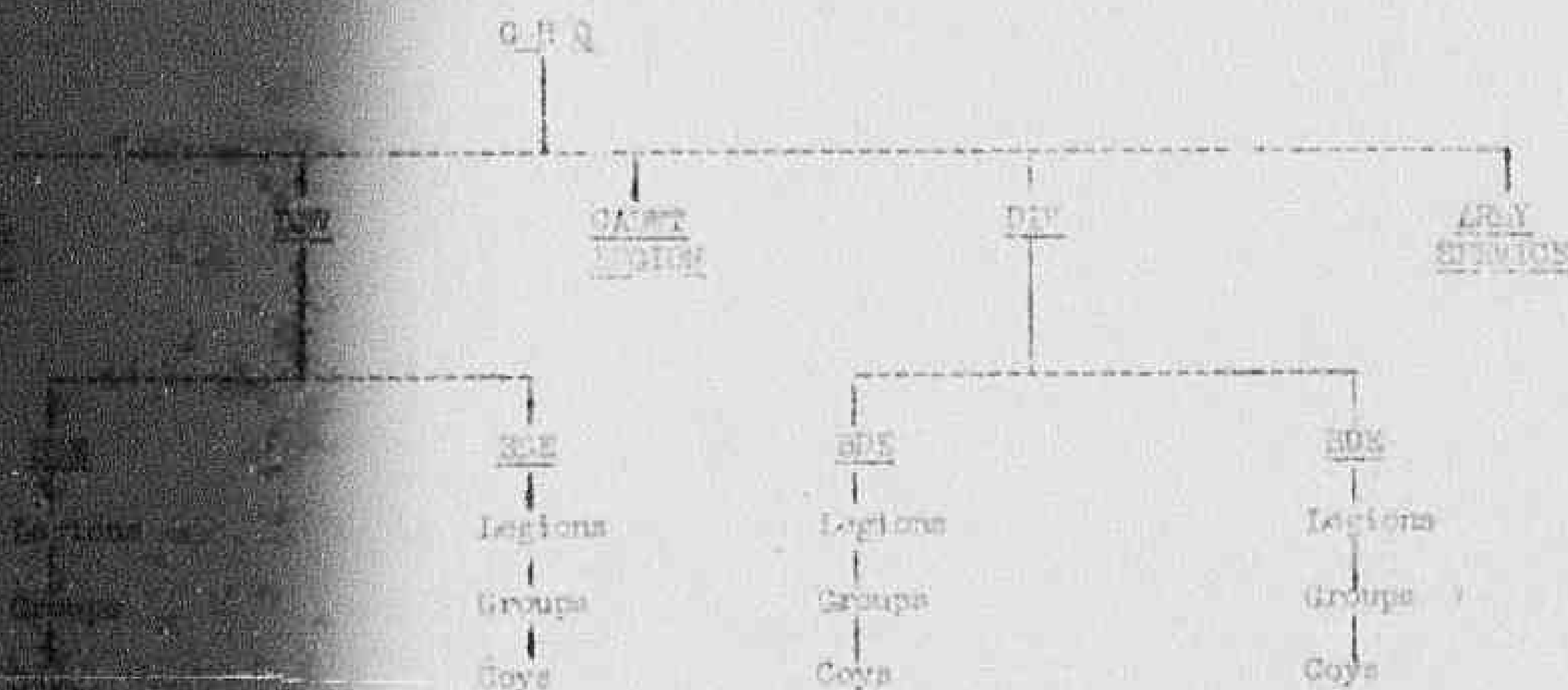

GENERAL LAYOUT - CARMINIERE

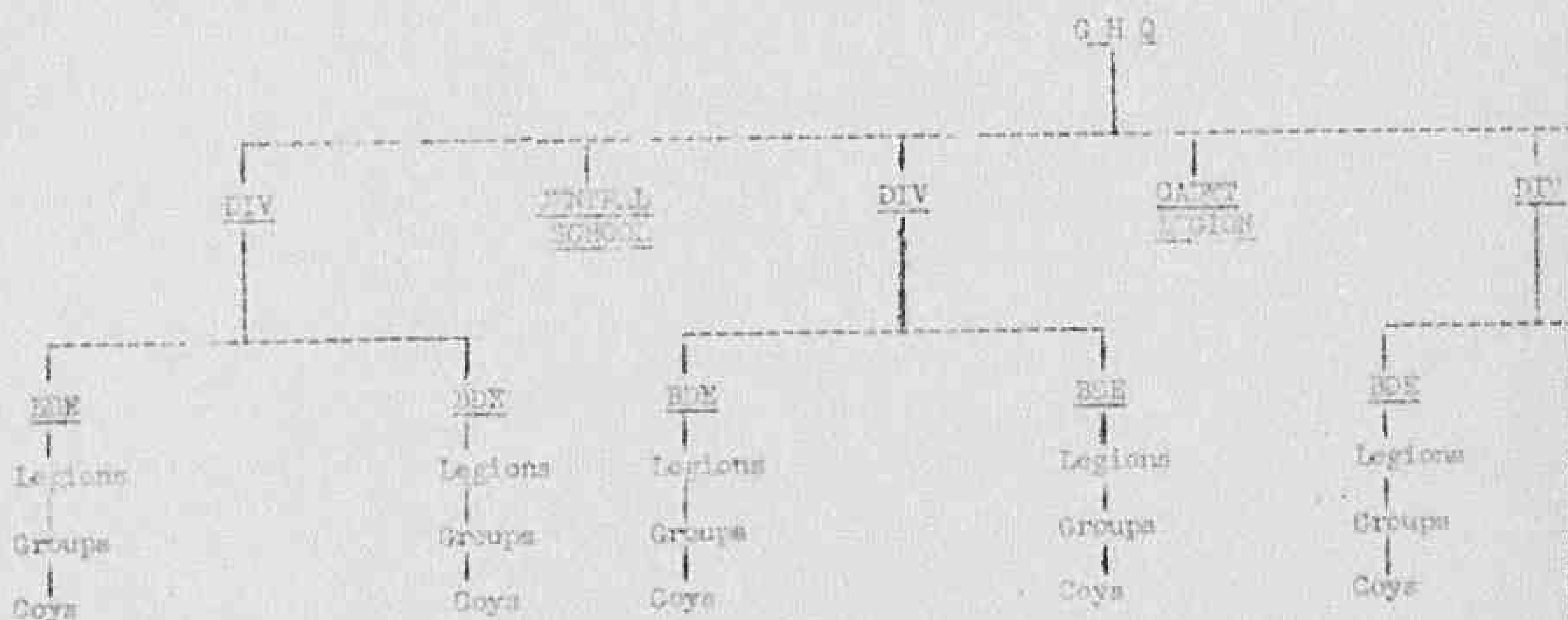

GENERAL LAYOUT - CARABINIERI



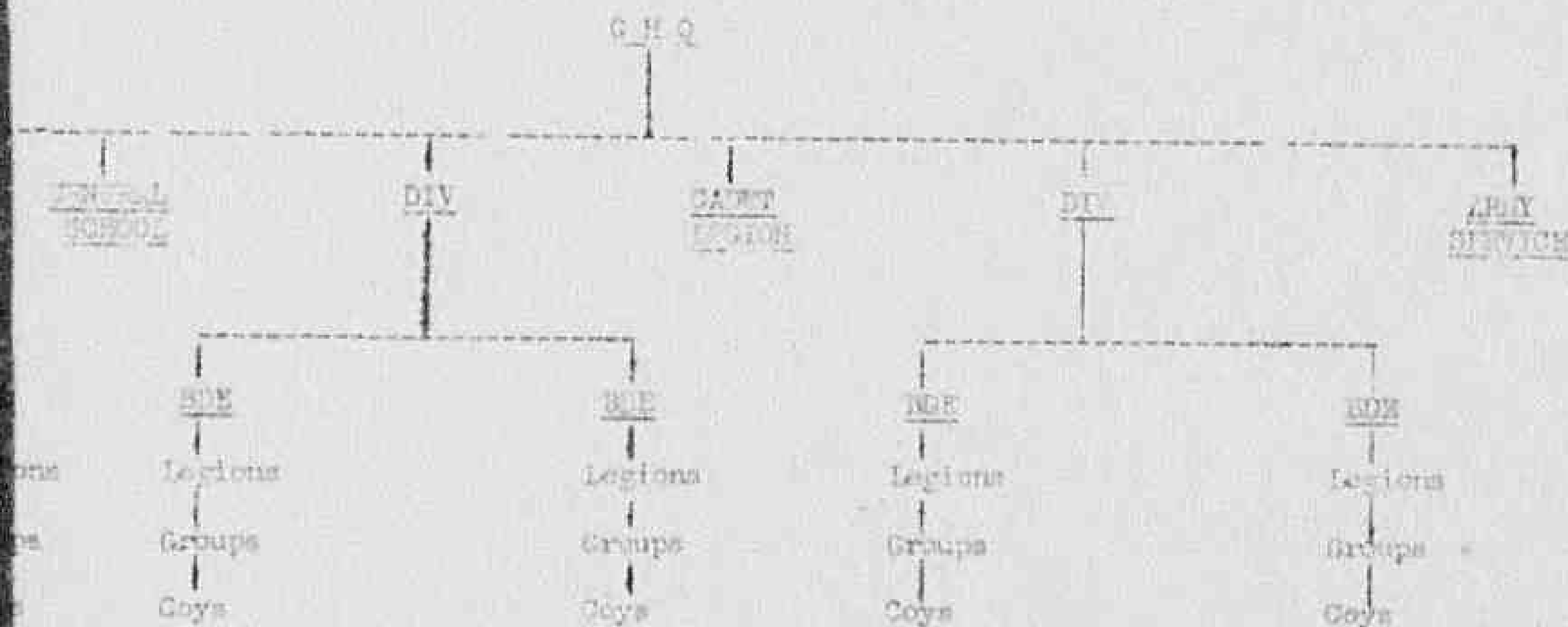

GENERAL LAYOUT - CARABINIERI

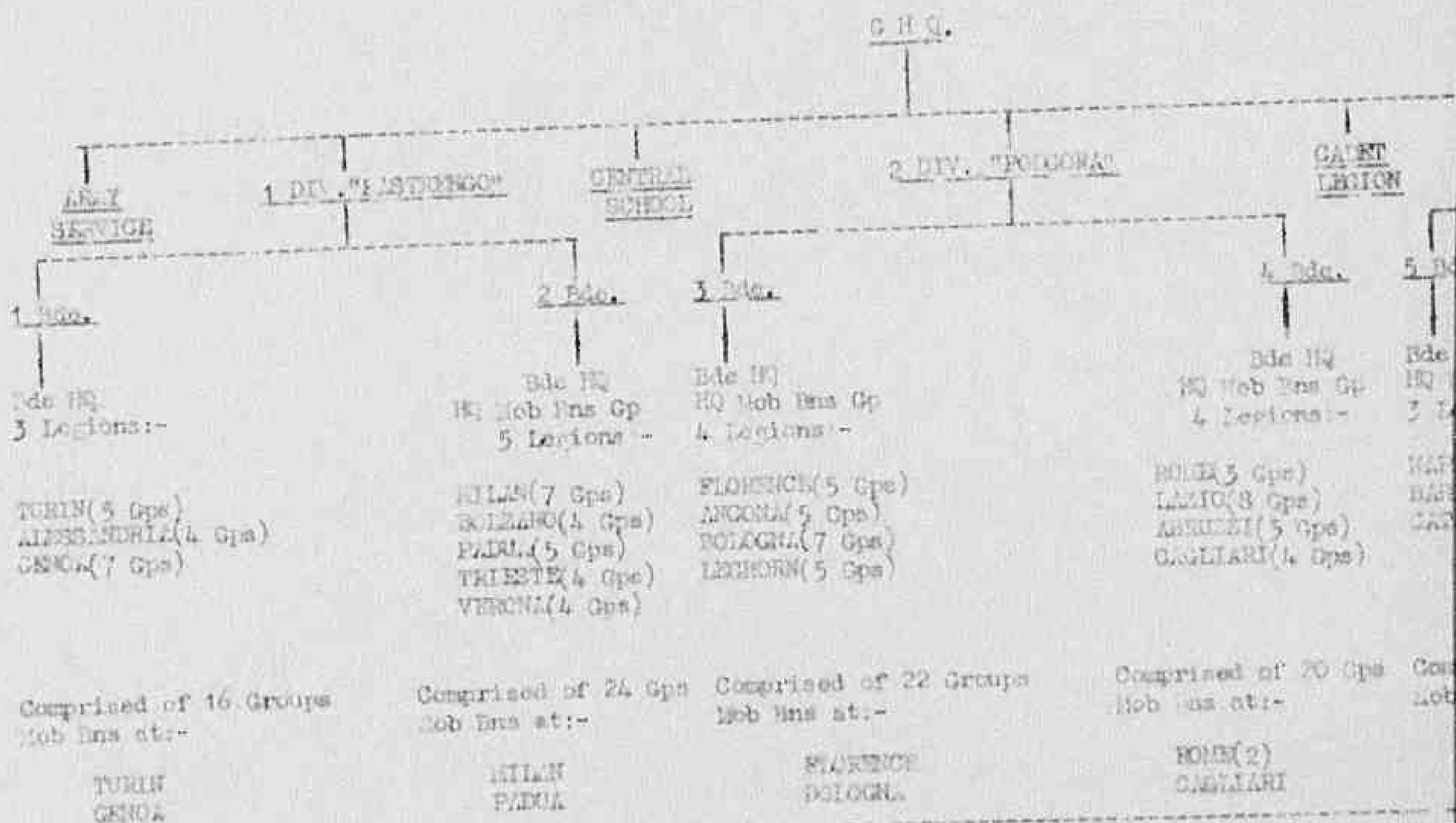

Subject is equipment of Italian Police Forces and Interim Army.

Para 1. In response to Alcom request for qty 3000 pistols and 44000 automatic muskets have recently released to you 3000 pistols and 10000 muskets for Carabinieri and have requested Alcom to justify further release of muskets and to coordinate their reply with you.

Para 2. Previously transport including arm cars has been demanded for carabinieri.

Para 3. In order to assess fairly these demands and to be able to estimate our possible commitments request you forward soonest proposed order of battle of units by types and quantities for Carabinieri and any other police forces for which weapons K T C are required together with complete weapon and vehicle staff tables and approximate bulk quantities of other major items of equipment and stores required. Also show existing holdings of all items demanded and items which can be made available from Italian Army resources.

Para 4. Complete orders of Battle of Units by types and quantities (including L of C Units) together with weapons and vehicle staff tables and existing holdings and availabilities is also required for Interim Army.

Para 5. Appreciate information required above may not be immediately available but must emphasize importance of information to this Headquarters at present time as plan for equipment including captured enemy weapons and ammunition can not be formulated until staff tables required by paras 3 and 4 above are available here.

Para 6. Grateful if preparation of reply to para 3 above be given high priority and information forwarded as soon as available and not held pending availability of reply to para 4.

Para 7. For Alcom, your signals 4958 of 08 Sept. 8020 of 03 Nov. and AFHQ letter G-5 :000.5 of ~~23222~~ 07 November also refer.
