1. The original letter from Mr. G. M. Johnson's Letter of credit

Crew received 6 months each. Boat confiscated. Other Captains and crew will receive similar sentences on conviction. Prosecution will ask for boats to be confiscated in each case. Information here suggests that it is believed HQ strictly to ask Captain and crews of captured boats are treated leniently. Grateful you do everything possible to mislead this new earlist.

SUBJECT: Illegal Emigration to TRIPOLITANIA

TO : The Ministry of Interior,
Italian Government,
ROMA.

1. During the past few months reports have reached this HQ from the British Administration, TRIPOLITANIA, of large numbers of illegal immigrants, from SYRACUSE, Sicily, landing in TRIPOLITANIA.

2. Since 1st January 1946 over 700 persons have landed in TRIPOLITANIA.

3. This Commission has invariably passed all the information received to your ministry, including the names of the vessels, (when known), the names and addresses of the Captains and/or Owners of the vessels and particulars of other persons believed to be concerned in the illegal traffic, together with a request that strict supervision be exercised over personnel in ships leaving SYRACUSE and the vicinity.

4. So far no tangible result has been achieved and illegal immigrants are continuing to reach TRIPOLITANIA. Some immigrants have stated they embarked at SYRACUSE with the knowledge and assisted by the local authorities. This information was passed to you via this Commission's letter AC/14057/Pa dated 26 July 1946.

5. In view of the foregoing I am directed by the Supreme Allied Commander to request that strong action be taken to stop this illegal emigration and that proceedings are instituted against persons found to be responsible or implicated in any case in which emigration is carried out or attempted contrary to Italian laws and regulations.

6. It would also be appreciated if this Commission could be informed of the measures adopted and the results obtained as urgently as possible.




