1. Following allegation has been made by the Warsaw Polish Government. Foreign Office Telegram 1094 (Warsaw to Foreign Office) of 3 July 46 refers.
2. There have been repeated cases of the abduction of Polish children under the ??? UNRRA in camps in Austria by envoys of 2 Polish Corps and their removal to the camp of the Corps in Italy. The intervention of UNRRA with the Allied Commission in the above matter is stated to have produced no results.
3. The Polish Government has requested that arrangements be made to render impossible any new abduction of Polish children from Austria to Italy and also to arrange the release of the children already abducted and their return to their last place of residence.
4. The European Regional Office of UNRRA in London say that it appears that some time this year the US Military Authorities in the US zone (?? authority unexpectedly) authorized the London Polish Red Cross to move 150-200 Polish children to Italy and provided necessary movement for each carrying out the plan. In view of the fact that civil aviation has not been mentioned in the air clauses of the peace treaty and also that approval was given by you in FAN 649 for the establishment of civil airlines in Italy I assume that there will be no restrictions presumably of internal civil aviation in this country.
2. In NAF 1105 I asked for authority for internal civil aviation including a limited amount of private flying. FAN 649 however only authorized internal civil airlines I therefore request authority to give approval for a limited amount of private flying for commercial purposes in addition to the British/Italian and American/Italian airlines already approved or under approval by the United States State department and the British foreign office. Do you approve the Italian air minister proposals which are strongly recommended by me and are as follows.
3. (A) Companies to operate air taxi services carrying freight on non regular schedule for all types of merchandise including perishable goods.
(B) Air taxi service using light aircraft to link up smaller towns and to act as feeders from the main internal civil air line terminals.
(C) A limited number of licenses for private aircraft used by their owners for commercial and business matters and permission to license a few aircraft which will be used in publicity flying.
4. The following are the details for the above.
(A) For the air taxi freight companies they intend to use ten aircraft with a capacity of between 2,000 - 4,000 kilograms the types will probably be S M 75, S M 82, C 12 or C 47.
