SUBJECT: Italian Population Figures.

TO : A/DOCS, Economic Section.

1. The Office of the Chief of Staff is in receipt of a tabulation of latest census figures for parts of Italy sent out under your covering letter dated 30 Dec 44 to Distribution List A, Groups 1, 2 and 3.

2. The tabulation of census figures is progressing well so that it is directed that you prepare a new more complete tabulation for general issue as above including:

- a) latest population of the larger provincial cities (or provincial capitals).
- b) latest population figures throughout Italy by provinces with Regional totals.
- c) Column of figures showing the corresponding 1936 figures.

3. In this way, on one complete tabulation, all studies, trends, appreciations, statistical analyses, etc. can be worked out on a common basis.

SUBJECT: Italian Population Figures

TO: Distribution List A, Groups 1, 2, and 3.

1. The tabulation of results of the Census of liberated Italy has now progressed sufficiently to enable revised estimates of the resident population to be prepared.
2. Comparison of the figures resulting from the present census with the corresponding figures in the 1936 Census provides an index which has been applied to the 1936 population figures for the 56 provinces of Italy not included in the present census.
3. Attached is a tabulation of population of Italy by provinces. The population of the provincial capital, which is included in the total for the province, is shown separately.
4. It is requested that in all future staff Studies, appreciations, etc., involving calculations based on population, these figures be used throughout, so that all elements, in this respect, will be working on a common basis.
