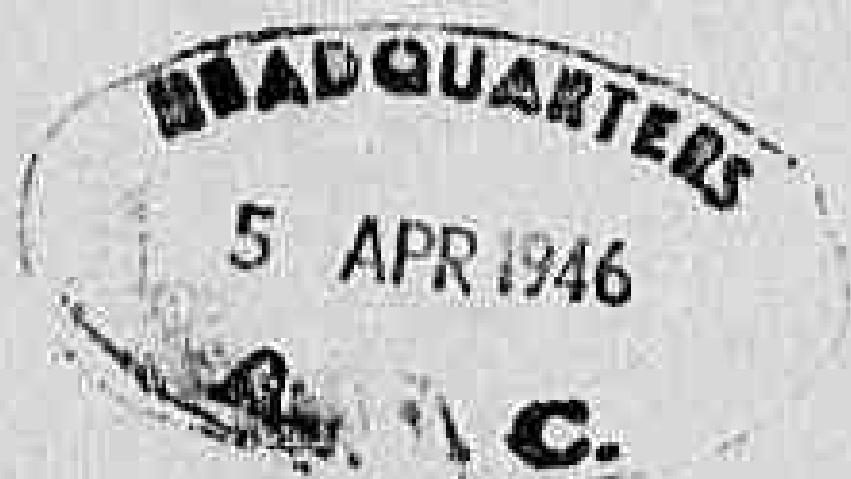

1. With MOC airgram 149 despatched today, AC is transmitting to CLAC for presentation to proper authorities Italian Government requests for allocation of RCL items to be procured by Italian Government with its own funds or through private trade.

2. It is important that the program be considered immediately because a large backlog of pending business is being held in abeyance by Italian Government authorities for lack of allocations to cover it.

3. Should the CFB and combined Committees be unable to consider the entire program as presented and to make recommendations for the amounts requested therein, interim allocations are urged so not to paralise the resumption of trade. Great efforts are being made in Italy to revive private trading and exchange of goods between Italy and other European countries as a preliminary step towards full resumption of world wide trade activities which alone will in the long run permit Italy recovery.

4. The most important allocations needed are those covering hides, tin, rubber, industrial sugar, molasses, food for Armed Forces. Also certain quotas of salted and canned fish as they are or will be included in commercial agreements with Norway, Denmark and other countries.

5. No answer has yet been received on requests presented with MOCS 429, 456, 479, 492, 493, 496, 498, 507, 515, 521, 523, 527 for which Italian Government is pressing for recommendations. Please expedite reply to these.

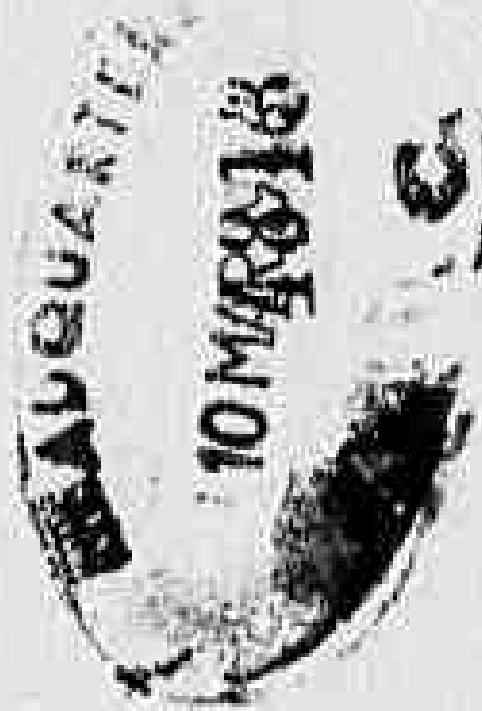

Following is revised text of COM 399:

Para 1. Answer to paragraph 3 MOC 501 is affirmative since COM 370 authorizes exports to eastern Hemisphere, except Egypt, pending receipt of Italian export program.

Para 2. In response to paragraph 5 of MOC 505 Committee has reviewed its recommendation number 3 transmitted in COM 370 and regrets Italian position. In view of sizeable contracts approved and negotiations pending with Dutch, French and UNRRA, committee believes good estimate of exports availability by countries, be developed for 1st half of 1946. Furthermore informed cotton institute in Milan developing export program for submission to Italian Government. Urgent that representative from Italian industry be sent here by Italian Government to wit with committee and discuss this program with committee members.

In view of these difficulties committee has informally developed tentative framework for export program which assumes Italians are willing to do their share in relieving world shortage and so be subject to approximately same restrictions in direction of exports as member countries. Member countries particularly United States and United Kingdom have disregarded pre-war trade pattern and held down domestic consumption

to provide deficit areas. For example, United States chipping almost 5 times as much as pre-war to far East which is not a desirable market and United Kingdom shipments to western Hemisphere less than 1% of pre-war.

Para 3. The following advice covering both cotton yarn and cloth while not a combined committee decision should be applied as far as possible in shipping program for 1st half of 1946:

(A) Proposed supplies to countries in the far East, including China should represent at least 50% of the total export program of these textiles. Committee realizes financial problems involved and will do all possible to facilitate negotiations with supply missions for these areas where need is greatest.

(B) Proposed supplies to areas which are now relatively well supplied should be held to a minimum in conformity with the policy of the member countries of the committee. Therefore, proposed exports of these textiles from Italy to the United States, Brazil, Canada, Mexico and Argentina should not exceed 3%, and all exports to the western hemisphere should not exceed 7% of Italy's total export availability.

(C) In view of the relatively high level of supplies in Egypt, proposed Italian exports to this country should not exceed 2% of total exports of these textiles.

(D) Committee will make no recommendation on remaining 41% until the Italian export program is reviewed.

Para 4. Cotton broad woven goods export program should be given in square yards or meters, showing destinations by country and 1st and 2nd quarters separately. Combed and carded yarn



as far as possible in shipping program for 1st half of 1946:

(A) Proposed supplies to countries in the far East, including China should represent at least 50% of the total export program of these textiles. Committee realizes financial problems involved and will do all possible to facilitate negotiations with supply missions for those areas where need is greatest.

(B) Proposed supplies to areas which are now relatively well supplied should be held to a minimum in conformity with the policy of the member countries of the committee. Report total production and export availability produced on Jacquard and dobby looms.

Para 5. Cotton yarn production and export availability for 1st 6 months should be shown in metric tons with weaving and knitting yarns separately, giving country destinations whenever possi-

ble, and at least continents.

Para 6. ID to the combined textile committee covering all export contracts placed by month of delivery as well as actual exports of cotton broad woven goods and cotton yarn. They should include contracts and exports already made. Both reports should indicate country of destination. These reports are an essential part of the committees program for coordinating exports of cotton broad woven goods and cotton yarn in order to insure an equitable distribution as is possible.

Para 7. Re paragraph 6 MCC 505 your authorizations do exceed committees expectations, particularly for Palestine. However, you will have to authorize under COM 370 until committee has reviewed Italian Program for 1st half of 1946. In view of proposals in paragraph 2, please encourage and facilitate all transactions with UNRAA and with Dutch and French for far East.
