certain commodities is sufficient to justify certain cancellations
in our requisitions for the period July - December 1946.

Para 2. Survey took into consideration:

A. Supplies now in the pipeline, and,

B. Supplies procured and set up for shipment which it will
not be possible to cancel at this stage.

Para 3. Reasons for this favourable situation are:

A. Late arrivals of shipments which compelled population
to do without certain commodities during larger part of period for
which they were required.

B. Improvement of position in regard to indigenous supplies.

C. Reluctance of local populace unattractive to it IE milk

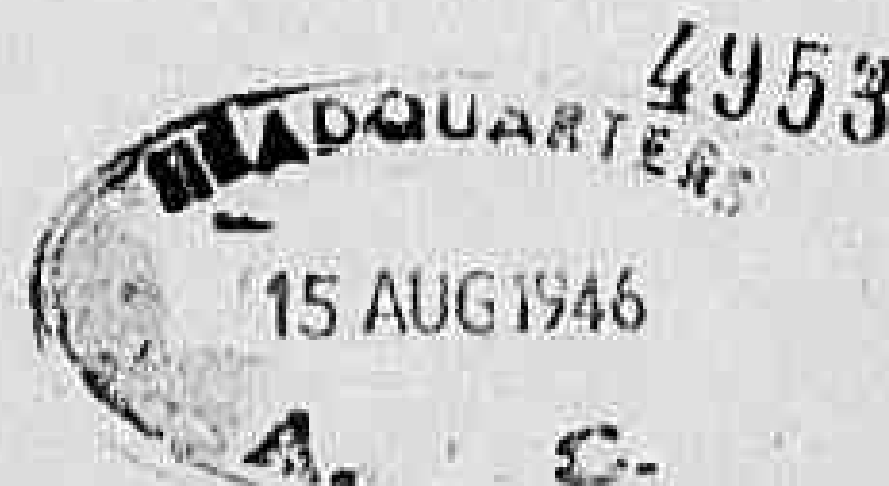

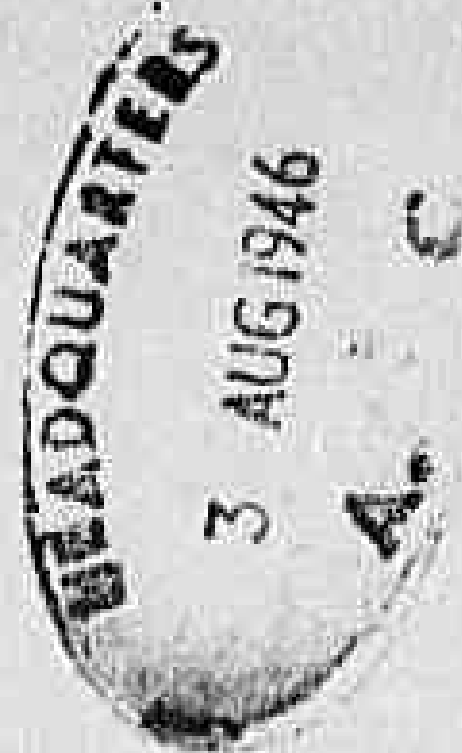
