The attached report is designed to show why the figure representing available for non-producers has undergone recent change, please see paragraphs 5 and 6.

Essentially the change is brought about by:

- (a) Decreases in retentions because some farmers produced less than legal retentions;
- (b) Revised legal retentions are now lower than calculated in July;
- (c) Seed requirements are much higher than the July forecast.

In summary those changes in retentions are:

SUBJECT: Wheat Amassing Report

TO : Colonel Charles W. Walton
Chief, Supply Group

1. Reference your Inter-Office Memorandum ES/10.02 of 7 January 1946.

2. The estimated availability of wheat for non-producers is the result of total production less legal retentions, both of which vary from year to year.

3. Legal retentions of wheat are allowed to the producer for family consumption and for farm labor. The numbers of both these categories vary, as is readily understandable, from year to year. The legal retentions for seed are based on the acreage that the farmer intends to plant the following year. In this case too, the retentions vary from year to year.

4. The retentions used for the Weekly Wheat Amassing Reports from 20 August 1945 to 17 December 1945, inclusive, were based on known 1942/43 retentions for consumption, plus an estimate of the amounts involved as a result of allowances granted since then. Also taken into consideration were the increase in population and the retentions for estimated acreage to be planted. The 1942/43 retentions were used because they represented the most accurate and reliable figures on hand. The retentions thus calculated amounted to 3,027,958 metric tons.

5. The total legal retentions recorded up to 15 December 1945 amounted to 2,663,209 metric tons. This latter figure, though it is not final, since there still remain retentions on a few small-sized farms to be checked, can be considered as representing the approximate quantity of legal retentions for 1944/45, and is the one that is being used for our reports since 17 December 1945. The estimated availability for non-producers is now calculated at 1,557,000 metric tons.

6. As regards production, when the Report of 20 August 1945 was drawn up, the production figures used were estimates. These have been checked and changed as the season progressed and are still in the process of being refined. However, for the practical purposes of the moment, the figure that is indicated in the report, i.e., 4,226,000 metric tons can be taken as the production figure of wheat for 1944/45.

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7. The above is the best production figure available to date, and no more complete one will be available before at least the end of March, owing to the lack of personnel and transport in the statistical agencies, the firm determination of a large section of the producers to disclose as little information as possible regarding their production and retentions and the general lack of effective backing of the peripheral statistics-collecting agencies by the civic authorities.

8. Thus, it is seen that, even if the production figure were to remain unchanged, the estimated availability for non-producers will change, since the retention figure will be a variable one, until it becomes final as a result of the completion of censuses now in progress.

9. The theoretical figure of the estimated quantity available for non-producers can never be taken as amassable. This theoretical figure could be made available for non-producers, if the amassing laws were applied thoroughly and effectively. However, this is not the case.

10. For example, it has been proven by studies made prior to World War II, that the central and southern farm family consumes on the average, one kilo of bread per capita per day, which means approximately 320 kilos of wheat per capita per year, while the amount allowed by law is 200 kilos. The farm family, although it may lower its consumption of wheat, will never reduce to the level prescribed by the present law. This is especially so in central and southern Italy, owing to the dietary habits, the lack of other cereals such as rice and corn and the small amount of proteins available.

11. Over and above these subtractions, the farmer retains some wheat for payment in kind to the farm laborers whom he expects to employ. The exact number of farm laborers that will be employed is not known beforehand, as this depends, among other things, on weather conditions, and therefore the farmer is always liberal in retaining wheat for this purpose. Moreover, this year wheat has been retained for livestock feeding because of the scarcity of other concentrates.

12. To summarize it will be seen that both the production and legal retention figures have yet to be refined to the ultimate possible. A considerable quantity of wheat is retained by the farmer above his legal retentions for consumption by his own family, by casual labor and for feed. This quantity plus that which is retained for sale on the black market constitutes the difference between production less legal retentions and the quantity amassable. It can be deduced from this that the quantity of wheat which finds its way to the black market is considerably less than that which is generally supposed, but there is no method of determining the exact figure. All the above data indicate that in reality the figure of availability of wheat to non-producers approaches more closely to the figure of wheat amassable than to the theoretical figure of wheat available to non-producers, which is calculated by the subtraction of estimated legal

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retentions from estimated production.

13. The quantity estimated to be amassable from the 1944/45 crop is 1,053,090 metric tons. The import program of cereals for Italy is based upon this figure.
