THE FINANCE MINISTER

Rome, 7 November 1946.

To Admiral Ellery W. Stone
Chief Commissioner
Allied Commission
Rome,

Since it appears that shortly the competent Allied Command is going to derequisition the building owned by the State Monopolies' Administration, known as the "Raw Tobacco Warehouse of via E. Gianturco" in Naples, and that upon derequisition said building is going to be handed over to the A.R.A.R. (Azienda Rilievo Alienazione Residui), I take the liberty to ask you kindly to intervene personally with the abovementioned Allied Command urging the derequisition and the hand-over of the building to A.R.A.R. who has already promised to return it immediately to the Monopolies' Administration, as well as to cede to the latter a considerable quantity of the surplus material presently in said warehouse.

The return of the Raw Tobacco Warehouse of via Gianturco in Naples is urgently needed by the Monopoly to accommodate the Salt Depot of Naples for the supply of commestible and industrial salt to the whole Campania-Lucania region.

Trusting that you will kindly take an interest in this matter, I assure you that it will be highly appreciated, not only by the Monopolies' Administration itself which will gradually see its factories recovering their former efficiency, but also by the numerous personnel of said Administration who will thus be enabled to resume their normal useful activity.

SUBJECT: Requisitioning - G.I.I. Institute, Lido at Venice.

TO : A.F.R.C.

A representative of the Minister for Foreign Affairs called today and said that the Prime Minister was most anxious to issue an invitation through the British Embassy for a number of British children in need of rest and recuperation to come to Italy and stay at the G.I.I. Institute on the Lido at Venice.

The Prime Minister is unable to issue the invitation because he understands that the G.I.I. building has been or is about to be requisitioned by the Allied Military Authorities. I was asked therefore to represent to you that the Institute is especially constructed and fitted for the accommodation of children and to ask whether it could be de-requisitioned or rendered exempt from requisitioning in order that Signor de Gasperi may put his proposal into effect.

SUBJECT: Judicial Reformatory at Nisida.

The Ministry of Grace and Justice have indicated that in view of the unfortunate increase in juvenile crimes they have need of all their institutes in which to place the young delinquents, both those who are a danger or who are merely misled.

The Allied requisitioning of the Judicial Reformatory of Nisida has deprived for some time the Administration of one of its most important establishments for the confinement of minors. Part of the building was recently handed back but nevertheless the Institute cannot be reorganized because it has not got the necessary wings for the functioning of the principal services (dormitories, schools, kitchens, refectories and baths.)

In consideration of the above, we beg you to approach the Public Safety Sub-Commission A.C. with a view to them considering the possibility of derequisitioning as soon as possible the other premises still occupied by the Allied military.
