Subject: Industrial Production Report

To: Brigadier General Edgar Erskine Hume
S. C. A. O., AMG, Fifth Army

1. A survey of products being manufactured in Fifth Army Area and adjoining Provinces has been undertaken by this Section, for the benefit of the various military procurement agencies. The tabulation of current production is submitted herewith, and includes materials being produced both for military and civilian account.

2. The occupation by the Fifth Army of the same area for over four months has placed an unusual strain on the local resources of this area, with the result that the stocks of manufactured goods useful to the Army is virtually exhausted. Therefore while A.M.G. is continuing its efforts to locate and block Local Resources for the use of Army units, the necessity for manufacturing additional goods in Army Area has increased to a marked degree in recent weeks.

3. This Section has therefore, in addition to its handling of Local Resources, undertaken to survey the more pressing problem of industrial production. The following report consolidates the record of accomplishment in this direction to date, and provides a convenient reference of production available at the present time to military and essential civilian consumers. It should be pointed out that the work of rehabilitation, supplying of fuel, raw materials, and power, has in most cases required the combined efforts of

various military, AMG, and civilian groups, and the results are due to the high degree of cooperation achieved among all interested parties.

4. Future expansion of the present rate of production will depend almost entirely on the amount of electric power made available in the Army Area. There are numerous plants now ready to commence operation which lack only electric power to start. In fact a number of factories which recently were producing essential goods have been forced to abandon production, following the re-allocation of their electric power to other plants for the production of higher priority materials. In the meantime the rehabilitation of additional factories is being carried on, so that their output will become available promptly when power can be supplied.

5. Information regarding additional products or sources will be included in future montly reports, as well as any additions or corrections to this report, which will be welcomed. Inquiries regarding the placement of orders with firms listed should be made through the military or AMG agency indicated as controlling the output of the plant in question.

6. It is desided to express hearty appreciation to the numerous offices which assisted this Section for their cooperation in the preparation of this report.
