SUBJECT: Strike Of Coal Miners Sardinia.

TO : Economic Section, HQ. A.C.

1. Colonel Walker of the Coal Section, AFHQ on the afternoon of 6 March 1945 telephoned the Mining Division, Industry Sub-Commission, inquiring about the details of a strike which he understood was going on in Sardinia. Colonel Walker's information was based upon the fact that a coal boat had left Sardinia partially loaded because of a miners strike.

2. The Mining Division endeavored to ascertain whether there actually was a strike, and any particulars concerning it by telephoning to Sardinia; but could not get connected until late in the evening. This connection was so poor one could not hear directly and questions and answers were relayed through the switchboard operator.

3. The information received was that a general strike started Saturday, March 3. Many of the workers had, however, returned to the mines by March 6 and the balance of the strikers were expected to return Wednesday, 7 March. The details concerning the strike were not clearly received but evidently the strike was of political origin. The estimated production lost due to this strike is approximately 6,000 metric tons of coal.
