Normally trains will be made up of 35 Box cars capacity 40 Refugees maximum per Box car total 1400 per train.

3.

Provision of Passenger Rolling Stock

- (a) Five sets of Passenger-Rolling Stock are now in service for movement of Refugees from Bologna, Southbound.
- (b) The loading capacity of these trains will be 1400 Refugees maximum.
- (c) Passenger Rolling Stock Trains will only work from originating point to Naples at which station all Refugees will be transferred to Box cars for onward movement.
- (d) Displaced Persons Representative in Bologna should contact AG Transportation Officer, Bologna, Tel. No. Vixburg 162, the day prior to departure to confirm type of Rolling Stock being provided.
- (e) Train Conducting Personnel of Passenger Rolling Stock Trains should be informed prior to departure that all Refugees will be required to change at Naples for onward movement.
