Reference our telephone conversation of this morning.

1. The original application for permission travel by air to London or Paris for the A/M Monsignors was forwarded to this office on October 10 by the British Minister to the Holy See.
2. This office applied to AFHQ for authority to issue the necessary travel orders.
3. Signal F 41380 of Oct. 20 signed CG Matousa to HQ Main gave this HQ authority to issue travel orders to London provided Diplomatic Visas and Military travel Authorization (MTA) were in order.
4. Signal F 42518 of Oct. 22 signed CG Matousa to HQ ADC authorized 100 pounds excess baggage each.
5. I was at AFHQ on Oct. 23 and C-2 (GI) decided that MTA's were only necessary in the case of Representatives of the Italian Govt NOT the Vatican.
6. As their Diplomatic Visas were in order, this HQ therefore issued the necessary travel orders, and have applied to Allied Air Booking Centre for tickets.
7. I think that all necessary action has therefore already been taken by this HQ, and, unless you have any points to raise, we will carry on and issue the tickets.
8. I would be most grateful to know how, as late as Oct. 22, the matter came into the hands of RACG.

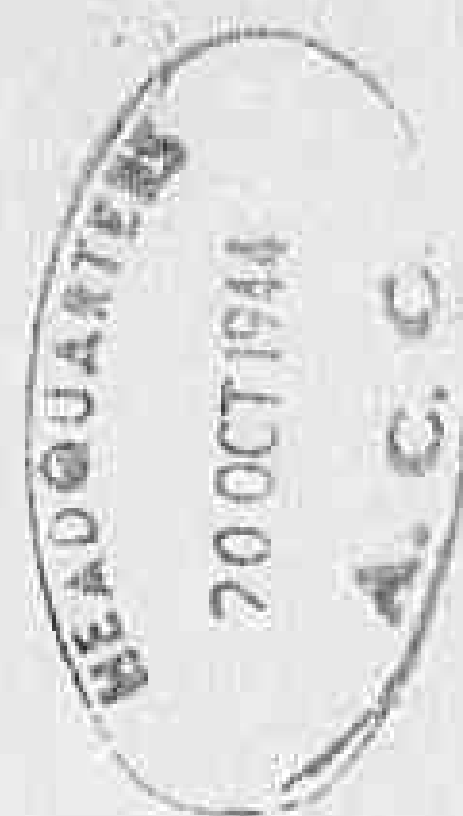

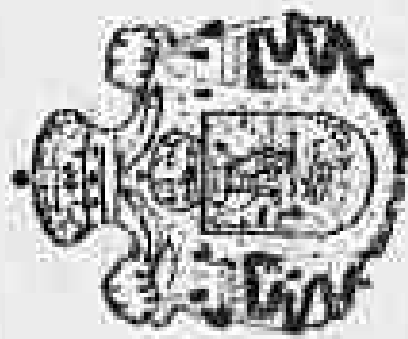

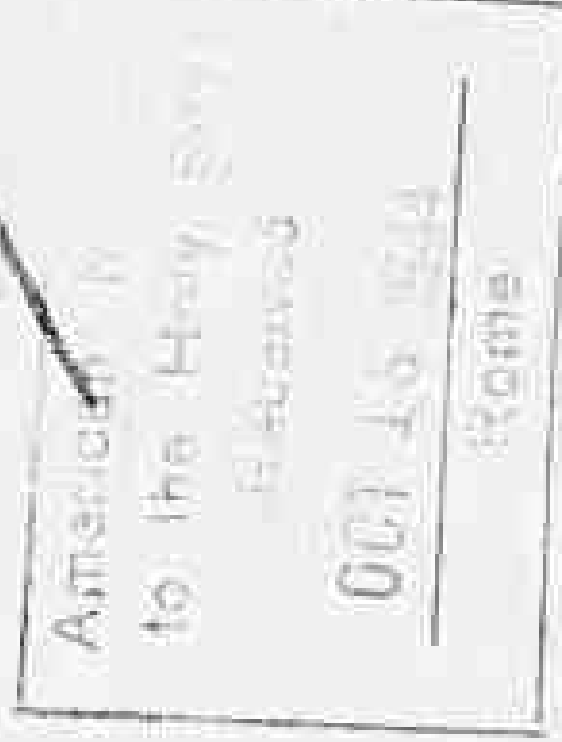

Dear Colonel Brown,

With reference to my letter 62/10/44 of October 10th about the forthcoming journey to London or Paris of the Nuncio to Belgium, I write to tell you that we have now been informed, regrettably late in the day, that Monsignor Micara wishes to be accompanied on this journey by the Counsellor of the Nunciature, Monsignor Arrigoni. He points out that he will be unable to cope unaided with the work awaiting him, which is no doubt quite true, so, as I am pointing out to the Foreign Office, the request can be regarded as a reasonable one. I am asking the Foreign Office to request SHAEF to arrange travel facilities from London or Paris, as the case may be, for Monsignor Arrigoni as well as for Monsignor Micara, and shall be grateful if you can perform a like service here in respect of the journey to England or France. Monsignor Arrigoni would much prefer to travel with his Counsellor, but if a passage for the former is already booked, I think that it would be sufficient if Monsignor Arrigoni could be sent in another plane within a few hours or days of that conveying his chief.

Dear Colonel Brown,

With reference to Montgomery's telephone call to Lord Ranfurly this afternoon, I am writing to confirm that we have heard from the Foreign Office by means of a telegram which has been repeated to the Resident Minister, Caserta, that the Belgian Government have agreed to the return to Brussels of the Apostolic Nuncio, His Excellency, Monsignor Micara (who is at present at the Vatican) and that SHAFI have agreed to arrange travel facilities for him from either London or Paris to Brussels.

The Foreign Office ask me to report whether arrangements can be made at this end for the prelate's journey to London or Paris and to let them know, if so, where and when his arrival may be expected.

I shall be very grateful therefore if you can kindly make arrangements for the journey to take place as soon as possible. I think it is immaterial whether Monsignor Micara goes to Paris or London. The Vatican has made it clear that they would like him to travel by air, and I understand that the Pope attaches particular importance to his returning at the earliest possible date as important problems affecting the life of the Catholic Church in Belgium await solution.
