1. Reference attached signal F.76005, I discussed the possible posting of Col. Banks to this Commission when in London, but I have not actually met him.
2. Brigadier Dunn has the highest opinion of his technical abilities and states that he did very well in the Blitz field in England, and also has done well in Belgium recently. However, he admitted that Col. Banks has the reputation of being difficult and SHAEF wanted to get rid of him. I informed Brigadier Dunn that I was doubtful whether we should want him, and hence his cooperative signal almost inviting the answer no.
3. I recommend that we refuse Col. Banks for the following reasons:
 - (a) He is a full Colonel and I do not want to take in a full Colonel for a job on devastated areas. If we did desire to employ a full Colonel surely we should promote a deserving
