1. In line with our conversation of yesterday I have further checked into the matter of the suggested plan which was to the effect that a portion of the Italian shipping be turned over by MEDBO to the Italian Government under Allied Commission supervision, whereby Lt. Commander Milieri and Lt. Commander Gunderson, plus other Coast Guard officers were to supervise the operation. It was suggested that the operation be under Italian naval control and Italian naval officers be placed on the various coasters and schooners.

2. In view of the new directive with respect to Allied Commission activity in Italian Government territory and the fact that MEDBO will continue to control Italian shipping, as they have in the past, I do not feel that any arrangements can be made which will justify the services of additional Coast Guard officers from an Allied Commission standpoint.

3. It is essential, however, that the excellent work now being done by Lt. Commander Milieri with the Fishing Industry be continued by him. It would appear that a greater contribution can be made at the moment with respect to Commander Milieri if our efforts on the Fishing Industry are increased. We propose to do this by requisitioning under Category "A", engines for fishing boats, necessary tools and giving assistance to the fish canning industry.

4. Attached is suggested draft cable to the Commandant of the Coast Guard in reply to his cable of February 10 and letter of 14 December 1944.

THE COMMANDANT OF THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD

My dear Commodore Stone:

First let me again refer to my visit to Rome and to thank you for helping to make it a pleasant one. Particularly do I remember my lunch with you in "Statuary Hall."

Recently I have had some conversations with Commander Joseph J. Lawler and with Lieutenant James E. Hicks. They both told me of the desire to have Lieutenant Commander Bruno C. F. Mulieri remain in Italy to organize the coastwise shipping industry. I gathered from them that it was a job that would take from three to four months and that Mulieri was desirous of undertaking it. They also brought up the subject of some assistance that he might need from the Coast Guard and suggested that Lieutenant Commander Burton A. Gunderson from Marseilles might be made available.

I have no objections to Mulieri undertaking this job if he would like to, and I feel that the knowledge and associations that he would gain there would be of some assistance later on in our proposed International Convention for Safety of Life at Sea, which will cover many subjects pertaining to merchant shipping and aids to navigation. If he would like to come home for awhile before undertaking this new job, that is also agreeable to me. With respect to giving him some assistance, that is not quite so easy. The type of officer that he would desire for this work is also the type that we urgently need on other duty. Gunderson has recently returned to New York from duty in the Mediterranean area. I haven't had a chance to talk to him as yet, but expect to in the near future. I would dislike to send him to Italy for a further period of duty unless it is agreeable to him, as he has already been overseas a considerable length of time.

I feel, however, that anything the Coast Guard is willing to do along this line should not be initiated by us. Therefore, I will do nothing further unless a formal request comes in from appropriate authority requesting the services of Mulieri, and possible later on of Gunderson, for assignment to this duty.

Thank you for your letter RIX/EC dated 1 Feb 45.

I am glad you agree with the appointment of Major Collins as R.P.S.O. to Dallas Region and I have instructed Public Safety Sub-Commission to take action accordingly.

I entirely appreciate your desire, which I share, to see Major Collins promoted. As you know, on the British side we are limited to a fixed ceiling of Lt. Col., but I will ask the Promotions Board at their next meeting to do their best for him. Unfortunately, as you know, there are at least two other Public Safety Officers with equal claims to promotion.

I am sorry to find myself profoundly disagreeing with your expressions as to my "unequivocal attitude in the matter and the even less considerate position taken by Col. Chapman" and of your "feeling that the abrupt, inconsiderate manner in which Col. Rye has been taken away" and regret that you should have chosen to use such language in your letter to me.

Not only did I tell you myself when you were visiting this Headquarters on the 18 Jan 45 of the necessity for removing Rye in view of Doherty's promotion and we then discussed the matter fully but in addition I wrote you a letter (AC/11004/1/PS dated 19 Jan 45) explaining the position and the necessity for the change, to which you replied on the 21 Jan 45. Orders were cut to effect the transfer on 21 January.

I confess I am entirely at a loss to understand how, in these circumstances, you can charge against Col. Chapman or myself abrupt or inconsiderate treatment.

That you would be upset at losing an excellent officer and do all you could to keep him is understandable but when a very senior officer leaves the Commission and a train of transfers to senior appointments is thereby set in motion, this Headquarters must take the best men and put them in the best places and express (as I did to you in the most courteous terms) our regret at having to do so.

Extract of Minutes of CH. I of Staff's Meeting held on 6 February 1945.

Personnel. COS said that as a general rule officers from Sicily would go to Venezia Giulia, officers from Southern Region to Venezia, officers from Lazio-Umbria Region (less Terni and Perugia Provinces) to Lombardia Region. Extra officers required for Piemonte would be drawn from Abruzzi-Marche Region, and extra officers for Liguria from Toscana Region. By the end of this week it was hoped to have a complete picture of personnel for North Italy. COS said he would circulate the draft directive for the withdrawal of Allied officers from Italian Government Italy to those attending the special VPs meeting being held this afternoon at 1700 hrs. He asked the PG240 and RC Southern Region to attend.

COS said that Est Sec must use more imagination regarding personnel and must follow through with an order, since it was not enough simply to cut an order and leave the matter at that. He instructed Est Sec to get out a list of all officers in the Commission showing by Regions the location of all VPs, and by Regions and Sub-Commissions the location of all other officers. Econ Sec was still concerned with the personnel question and wanted to have the complete Austria list and Est Sec reported that Col. Fiske would be back to-day or to-morrow with a complete list. COS reiterated that any officer earmarked for Austria must not be included in the numbers for Northern Regions. CA Sec requested that when an officer was recalled to USA, Est Sec should notify the Sub-Commission concerned. COS emphasized that the whole question of personnel for the North must be regularised and be completely tidied up at a very early date, and instructed Est Sec to take immediate action.

My dear Brigadier,

1. Being satisfied by reason of your unequivocal attitude in the matter and the even less considerate position taken by Col. Chapman, that I am, willy-nilly, to lose Col. Bye, I have discussed with him the question of his successor. He concurs in your view and that of Col. Chapman that Major Collins is the man. I have therefore informed Major Collins that he will succeed Col. Bye, and request that you take whatever action may be necessary to reflect on your records that Major Collins is now Regional Public Safety Officer, Emilia Region.

2. This is not to be construed as an indication of consent to Col. Bye's reassignment. On the contrary, I am strongly opposed to this change which has been entirely imposed upon me from a higher level as a fait accompli, without any request either for my consent or an expression of my views. On principle, I do not feel that this is the proper approach to a matter of this kind and wish the record to show that while I am reconciled to the apparently inevitable, I do not approve or agree.

3. Col. Bye's performance of duty and administration of the Public Safety Division of Emilia Region during his period of service under me, has left literally nothing to be desired. I has been for me a unique experience and a very great pleasure to deal with a staff officer with whom I have agreed invariably on questions of policy and administration referred to me by him. Not only in his professional and staff capacities but as a senior British officer of unusual astuteness and common sense, Col. Bye has been a tower of strength indeed, and Region Emilia will miss him very, very much. We congratulate AMG 8th

Army on its acquisition, and look forward to continued contact and collaboration with Col. Eye in his new assignment, where he will for the present continue to control in an even more immediate way the operations of more than one-half of Region Emilia's Public Safety officers.

4. One boon I do very strongly seek, and I make no secret of my feeling that the abrupt, inconsiderate manner in which Col. Eye has been taken away entitles this region and me personally to special consideration.

5. Major Collins will be placed in charge of a group of Public Safety officers many of whom hold the same army grade as he. He will not be senior to all of them in military rank and it is not clear that he in all cases ranks them as a civil servant. In addition, he will have to deal directly with and control, numerous Italian officers holding ranks up to and including that of full colonel.

6. In fairness to him, and in order to enable him to do an efficient job for Emilia Region, it is absolutely necessary that Major Collins be promoted at once to the grade of lieutenant colonel.

7. I had, through my senior British officer, already recommended Major Collins for promotion, prior to his appointment as Regional Public Safety Officer. I feel very strongly indeed that in view of the new and onerous responsibilities which the Sub-Commission is asking him to sustain, this recommendation is entitled to the fullest support, and preferred treatment.

8. This request is entirely my own. Major Collins has not mentioned the matter to me, and I have not discussed it either with him or with Col. Eye.

The attitude of the Fifth Army toward attached personnel has caused and is causing quite intolerable administrative difficulty. Perfectly proper orders issued by command of Admiral Stone to personnel assigned to regions but attached to Fifth Army have been disregarded and the personnel concerned told not to obey. There is strong tendency on the part of Fifth Army to break off completely from AC control. It is time, I think, that the issue be squarely met. I have discussed at length with General Hume who informs me that Corps and Army Commanders are now taking the initiative to bring about separation. The present situation is unhealthy; the question being raised should be fully examined and firm decision taken.

1. The Emilia Region copy of your signal 729, 20 January 1945, has been received.

2. It is apparently responsive to a request from Headquarters Allied Commission for certain AMG Fifth Army personnel for use in the south and reads in part as follows: "In place of Captains Lee, Bennett and Jefferson and Lt. Thomson, propose to send Major C.J. Carillio, Major L.G. Dewing, Lt. L.E. Moore and Capt. J.Y. Elliott. These last four are at present not actively engaged and their services can more easily be dispensed with for next two months. As these four are assigned Emilia Region suggest clearance with Regional Commissioner." (underlining ours)

3. The implications of this language necessitate a reminder and restatement of the relation of these officers and other Region Emilia personnel, to AMG Fifth Army, and the essential limitations of this relationship.

4. Shortly after the re-formation of Emilia Region, in accordance with Allied Commission policy and precedent, four Region Emilia provincial teams were sent forward on loan to AMG Fifth Army, to augment its strength and for its use as provincial teams until such time as tactical developments should permit their being sent forward to previously determined locations in the respective provinces of the Region, to which these officers were assigned. Due to a subsequent shift of Army boundaries, the number of provincial teams so loaned was later increased to five.

5. The clear and unambiguous understanding and directive with regard to such teams was that they should be used as teams and that if and when their services were no longer required by AMG Fifth Army they should be returned as teams to the Region for use elsewhere.

6. On numerous occasions in the ensuing months, AMG Fifth Army has proceeded in disregard of this basic understanding and directive in several respects, taking action and assuming administrative and disciplinary jurisdiction not justified by the terms of reference. Among other things, it has:

a. Operationally, disregarded the unity of provincial teams, and used officers when and where it saw fit, without regard to the maintenance of the integrity of teams;

b. Granted leaves to officers without reference to, or consultation with the Region, with the result that officers could not be reached by Region headquarters for administrative purposes;

c. Taken action toward the promotion of officers without consultation with the Region;

d. In its orders used the word "assigned" in allocating officers to places of duty, overlooking and ignoring the fact that it has no assignment jurisdiction over them; and,

e. Sub-loaned Emilia Regional officers to other Regions without reference to, or consultation with, this Region.

7. The matter referred to in point a was mentioned to the Regional Commissioner (as a fait accompli) and stated to be operationally necessary. On that basis it was agreed to, upon condition that officers be kept in sufficiently close contact with their respective Provincial Commissioners for the efficient and effective exercise of administrative and disciplinary jurisdiction. Other enumerated items of departure from the basic agreement have upon occasion been noted and protested, and AMG Fifth Army has agreed to desist from the protested practices. Still other points have been waived or overlooked. Emilia Region recognizes that at the present juncture its prime function is to assist the Allies and there has been no inclination to split hairs, or to make mountains out of molehills.

8. The fact remains that the officers of this Region have been, and continue to be loaned to AMG for its use while it needs them and for no other purpose. When officers are not needed they should be returned to their provincial commissioners who have been properly instructed to communicate that fact to regional headquarters so that effective use may be made of the affected officers elsewhere. They are not AMG Fifth Army's for the purpose of loan to other Regions, release to Allied Commission, or for any purpose other than its own operational use until needed by the Region.

9. Under these conditions the use in the quoted signal of the phrases "propose to send"; "at present not actively engaged"; "services can . . . be dispensed with for next two months" constitute a quite intolerable assumption of dominion and jurisdiction over

the officers in question. Region Emilia had no notice whatever that these officers were surplus to your requirements, and on the very day the quoted signal was transmitted the Regional Commissioner was at Headquarters A.C. seeking additional officers for urgent operational use in Emilia Region.

10. A request which has heretofore frequently been made orally and informally is now repeated in formal and written form. Whenever, in the course of your operations, any officers of this Region are no longer required by you will you please direct them at once to report to their respective provincial commissioners, notifying Regional Headquarters of such instructions and of the manner of performance of the officers affected, during their time of service with you.

11. Your failure to do this promptly, consistently, and in good faith, in accordance with the basic plan, will otherwise necessarily have to be made the subject of an application to Headquarters Allied Commission for modification of the existing scheme so as to insure to the Region the degree of control and organizational integrity necessary for effective administration.

1. The Director of the P.W. & U. Sub-Com has recommended the appointment to AMG 8 Army of a senior engineer officer representing the P.W. & U. Sub-Com on the same lines as the P.W. & U. Staff appointed to AMG 5 Army. Hitherto, as I told Colonel Jenny, 8th Army have taken the line that in the initial stages all the engineering work is done by the military engineers and the follow-up is tackled by the Regional and Provincial P.W. & U. Staff which follows very closely on the heels of the Army.

2. In view of Colonel Jenny's request, however, I think the case should be put to SCAO, 8th Army.

1. At our recent Regional Engineers' meeting the Regional Engineer of the Emilia Region advised us that by orders of A.M.G. Eighth Army he was attached to this A.M.G. and he is now actively engaged in supporting A.M.G. Eighth Army in his Region as, at the present, none of this territory has been turned over to the Regional Commissioner. Our Regional Engineers have to communicate with us frequently on technical matters and they also have to make Monthly Reports to us to be used in the preparation of our Monthly Reports. Our Regional Engineer stated that he was instructed by Group-Cpt. Benson that all of his communications had to go through him as head of A.M.G. Eighth Army.

2. We do not know by what authority our Regional Engineer was thus attached to A.M.G. Eighth Army. While we have no objection to our Regional Engineer giving every possible assistance to A.M.G. Eighth Army, we believe this practice to be improper and that A.M.G. Eighth Army should have its own engineering personnel. It has no engineers, although we have previously raised this question and offered to assist.

3. If Eighth Army moves forward and territory is turned over to the Regional Commissioner, it will naturally be necessary for our Regional Engineers to detach themselves from Eighth Army and to carry on their work under their Regional Commissioner.

4. Will you please have this matter looked into and advise me of the exact status of our Regional Engineer and his assistants, so that we may be governed accordingly.

1. I refer to your letter of December 30 regarding the proposed appointment of Mr. Rock Ferris as PRO to Fifth Army AMG.

2. I agree entirely that PR staff has been short, as it still is, and it has been impossible, owing to lack of qualified personnel, to cover the activities of Army AMG's and Regions as fully as we should have liked to do.

3. I would point out that Lieut. Atkinson was recalled only at the request of Major Bullock who informed me that he was unacceptable to Fifth Army AMG. He is still available.

4. I should personally welcome the addition of qualified staff, military or civilian, but in view of the General directive of General Macfarlane on the PR set-up of the AC and also of the proposals which I understand that Mr. Macmillan has in mind I am referring the matter to the Chief of Staff.

1. Unofficial information has been received that Mr. Pock Ferris of the Psychological Warfare Branch, an American civilian authorized to wear uniform, would be willing to come into AMG to do public relations work.

2. It is understood that this gentleman has particular qualifications fitting to be a public relations officer, being a newspaper editor at home. While we would prefer to have a commissioned officer do this work, there is no reason administratively why a civilian in Mr. Ferris' status could not do all that we desire.

3. Information is requested as to whether his services can be made available to us and if so, that he be so assigned.

4. The need for a qualified public relations officer for A.M.G. Fifth Army is very great. We have had but two in more than a year. The first, Captain Harwell, was relieved by order of General Macfarlane when he abolished public relations officers except in his own office. The second, Lieutenant Atkinson, was relieved after some difficulty by orders of the public relations officer of the Allied Commission.

5. During the recent visit of the Congressional Committee the only criticism made of A.M.G. was that we were not letting the American public and, I may also add, the British public, know about what we are doing. It is impossible for a public relations officer singlehandedly to cover the work of the Fifth and Eighth Armies, A.M.G. and no one knows this better than Major Bullock who is now engaged in that work.
