SUBJECT : Release of Personnel.

TO : Executive Commissioner, H.Q., Allied Commission.

1. Hearing that this Region is to be discontinued in the near future, several Sub-Commissions have asked the concurrence of this Headquarters in relieving officer personnel prior to the discontinuance of the Region.

2. Captain F. W. Stringer, (B) Agriculture Division; and Captain Alfred L. Dorf, (A) Labor Division, can be released if required elsewhere. This Region has been cut down in strength to such an extent that no other officer can be relieved without serious detriment to the Region. This Region's responsibilities and work continue until the day when we turn over the control to Italian Government officials. There is considerable work connected with the closing up, in particular the activities of the divisions, which the Sub-Commissions have not appreciated.

3. It will, therefore, be appreciated if no more requests for the concurrence in the release of commission personnel in this Region are made unless such release becomes effective after the control of Toscana passes to the Italian Government.

SUBJECT: Officer Strength

TO: G-1 (A)
G-1 (B)

1. The authorized officer strength of this Sub-Commission is 20. In addition authorization for an increase of 2 officers was requested on 15th January, 1945. No reply has been received. As the increase was to cover supervision of Italian Radio in accordance with A.F.H.Q. directive and this duty was not considered when ceiling of 20 was established it is to be presumed that increase of ceiling would be authorized if and when the Man-Power Commission considered the request.

2. Repeated requests to G-1 (A) and G-1 (B) have resulted merely in keeping this Sub-Commission at a strength of about 75% of authorized strength. On several occasions requests to G-1 (A) for officers by name who were reported available for assignment have been returned with the notation that assignment cannot be requested as the 2675th Regiment is overstrength in officer personnel. As this Sub-Commission is understrength this can only mean that some other organization is over strength thus creating a situation which unjustly prejudices the operations of this Sub-Commission.

3. The present strength of this Sub-Commission is 16 officers against an authorized ceiling of 22 (or 20 if request for increase of Radio officers is ignored). Two British officers Lt. Col. Cumming and Major Hills will be released shortly. There will in all probability be a request made to this Sub-Commission for assignment of a Postal and Telecomms officer to Venezia Giulia. Unless this Sub-Commission is at full strength it will not only be impossible to assign any officer to Venezia Giulia but the work in other Regions will seriously suffer.

5 Telecomms Officers (2 to replace Lt. Col. Cumming and Major Hills)

1 Radio Officer

Telecomms Officers

Technical education as electrical engineer (college degree desirable but not essential). 4 - 5 years experience in commercial telephone company in U.S.A. or telephone department of G.P.O.

Postal Officers

Good general education and experience of administrative work.

Preferably with Post Office experience. Officers of the R.E.F.C. or American Army Postal service who have had some working contacts with the Italian Post Office would be most suitable.

Radio Officers

Technical education as electrical engineer (college degree desirable but not essential) 4-5 years experience in practical radio work either in commercial company or Army Signals.

6. The work of the Communications Sub-Commission is now at its peak - The liberation of the North has created the biggest problem of Communication ever met by this Sub-Commission added to which international communications both postal and telecommunications are opening up to a degree never previously experienced.

7. Lack of officer personnel at this time endangers the painstaking and successful work previously accomplished. With a full complement of suitably qualified officers it is felt that this Sub-Commission can complete its mission within a very few months so that probably by October 31st, 1945 its task will be reduced to one of liaison which can be carried out with a staff of 2 or 3 officers.

8. Now is the moment when every effort should be put forward to push to a satisfactory conclusion the re-establishment of Communications which play such an important role in the economic life of any country.

9. It is hoped that some way will be found to provide the necessary officer personnel without which the mission of this Sub-Commission cannot be satisfactorily accomplished.

I sent you a telegram today about Colonel Carl G. Gevers and this is in amplification of the telegram.

The position is that Carl came across to see me yesterday evening from Verona and has been across again this morning. He is not a bit happy in the Austria set-up and is desperately anxious to get back with us. He thinks that General Lewis and General Florie would in fact be prepared to let him go as they have several Senior Officers for whom they would have to find occupations.

I should be exceedingly glad to have Carl back with me and he would be very useful. In saying this I want to make it absolutely clear that I have received magnificent support from Tom Page and that I have complete and friendly confidence in him. I know however that he himself feels that he has not sufficient time to do really and effectively the two tasks of Regional Public Health Officer and Deputy Commissioner. The matter is rather urgent because if something is not done very quickly to release Carl he will be swept into Austria and then it will be very difficult to get him out.

My dear Colonel,

I again find it necessary to bother you to prevent a mistake I'm sure you don't intend to occur, but which might be difficult to remedy.

Paragraph (ii) of the Executive Commissioner's much-discussed letter, "Ceilings--Officers" G-1B/31/3/A says, in part, that:

"The number of permanently assigned officers to Umbria-Marche, Toscana and Emilia Regions is small compared with other AMG Regions. The majority of the 320 officers earmarked for Austria will, however, be attached to these regions until the occupation of Austria begins...."

Both you and the Executive Commissioner have stated that the number of Austria-earmarked officers so assigned temporarily to Emilia will very greatly exceed the 24 indicated on the chart attached to the letter of 7 March. You know how much I shall necessarily rely on this extra help, and how hopeless I should regard the possibility of doing a creditable job without it. I've already told you this too often, and it is not the subject of this letter.

The point which I fear has been overlooked is that those Austria-earmarked officers will be useless to me without adequate transport. This is elementary and I am sure you will agree.

Yet I have learned that the efforts of at least one of your British G-4's are even now being directed toward cutting down the proposed T/E (motor equipment) painstakingly prepared and submitted by us, and which is based on present officer personnel numbering about 140, to a reduced figure, based on the "ceiling" of 115 referred to in the cited letter.

I anticipate that, pursuant to your commitments and those of the Executive Commissioner, up to 50 officers above the 115 "ceiling"

figure--perhaps more--will be attached to the Region. Unless provision is made in the proposed T/A for transport for them, they will be quite useless, and Emilia will once more be subjected to an unconscionable handicap.

I am sure, in this case, that the patent inconsistency involved in offering us additional officers, but making no provision for their mobility is entirely due to oversight, and that your G-4 officers must be acting without knowledge of your and the Executive Commissioner's informal commitments to me.

The matter can, therefore, be entirely adjusted by merely instructing the G-4 people who are setting up our Tables of Equipment to use not less than 150-165 officers as the basis for the transport allotment. I request that you do this.

I believe that there is not, as is sometimes true in the case of officers earmarked for forward regions, any possibility of Austria-earmarked officers "bringing transport with them," as suggested by the British G-4 officer with whom I have discussed this matter. I understand that the Austria teams, as such, will receive no motor equipment until they are about to enter Austria--certainly, I am sure, none which may be used in Italy. Of course, if I should be wrong about this, and Austria-earmarked officers would come ready-equipped with cars, there would be no point in my request.

I regret being once more required to harass you. I know that the matters on your plate this week are many, and my intense desire to produce a satisfactory operation in Emilia has forced me to contribute more than my share. This particular one, I think, may be quite easy to dispose of, as I am sure that it is entirely the result of lack of knowledge or understanding on the part of your G-4 people.

My dear Colonel,

You have stated that Establishment Section will, in the next several weeks, prepare a table showing by name, the distribution of specialist officers to Regions, and will thereafter submit draft copies of such table "to all interested regional commissioners for them to shoot at", this table to be the subject of further clearance at a meeting to which I shall be invited.

I am therefore taking the liberty, in this letter, of pointing out some of the respects in which I feel that the proposed numerical allotment of specialists set forth in the addendum to your letter 3-1B/31/3/A, "Ceilings-Officers", 7 March 1945, are most illogical and inadequate as regards this Region. I hope that you will refer to it in the course of your discussions with the sub-commissions and that modifications which will produce a more equitable and workable allocation, will result.

I shall refrain from discussing over-all numbers (also inadequate), resting the security of Emilia in that regard on informal assurances from you and the Executive Commissioner that additional bodies, as such, up to a reasonable, workable ceiling, will be forthcoming from (1) officers earmarked for Austria but not taken into account in preparing the chart (2) additional officers to be "barrel-scraped" out of Headquarters, and (3) other sources. This letter relates solely to numbers allotted to specific special classifications--specialists, who cannot be pulled out of a hat or picked up casually in just any group of assorted officers. With even more emphasis, it relates to heads of special divisions.

Preliminarily, I call attention to the following pertinent basic facts upon which judgment of the needs

of Emilia must presumably be to some extent predicated, and which I feel must have been overlooked in the preparation of the table above referred to:

1. Emilia Region is still, as such, totally non-operational to exactly the same extent as Liguria, Piemonte, Lombardia and Venezia. By grace of the Eighth Army, a certain amount of emergency work has been done in one-and-a-half provinces, but the regional job proper is still ahead.

2. The devastation in the portions of Emilia already liberated exceeds anything experienced north of Cassino, and there is every indication that the remainder of the Region has been, or will be, hit equally hard.

3. Emilia has eight provinces--the same number as Piemonte; twice as many as Liguria. Except for Torino and Genova, respectively, the Emilian provinces are not inferior in importance or population to those of these Regions. In fact the provinces of Liguria other than Genova are not comparable with Forli, Bologna, Modena, Parma, Piacenza, etc., in strategic and industrial significance.

4. Bologna is the transportation, communications, and commercial "hub", for all of northern Italy, and is an important industrial area.

5. There will evidently be more troops stationed in Emilia for a long period of time than in any other comparable area in northern Italy.

6. There is some indication that up to one million German military and civilian personnel will be concentrated, unconfined in Emilia.

Bearing these facts in mind, I submit that the following typical comparative figures from your chart speak for themselves as to the inadequacy of the provision made for this region:

Thus, in this group of important Economic Section divisions, we find that (excluding officers earmarked for Austria) personnel provision per province is, for Liguria, 400 percent, and for Piemonte, 250 percent, of that for Emilia.

The fact that the most glaring inequities and imparities (though there are others I shall not here belabor) all relate to Economic Section classifications, leads me to wonder whether the advice and counsel of the Economic Section have been asked and considered in connection with these allocations. I have not, and do not wish to, press this inquiry, but I have learned by chance that the Transportation Sub-Commission did recommend an allotment of twelve (12) officers to Emilia, and that Commerce Sub-Commission planned to provide a minimum of two (2) commerce officers.

I cannot believe that those to whose hands the economic aspects of A.G.'s mission are entrusted really regard Emilia as of so little importance industrially and commercially, as your proposed personnel chart would imply. If they do, I should be glad upon another occasion

to attempt, with the aid of Lt. Cashman's "Handbook of Basic Information", to show them their error. For the present, knowing that the allocations are completely out of line with the recommendations of at least two of the Directors of Economic sub-commissions, I prefer to believe that the true answer lies either in a failure to consult the sub-commission at all or in giving insufficient weight to their recommendations.

The only other possible explanation, would be that Emilia Region Officers are regarded as so much more efficiently trained, indoctrinated, organized and directed, than those of other regions, that one of them can do the work of two to four ordinary people. Flattering as I might find this hypothesis, it is rejected as unfair to the individual officers of Liguria and Piemonte.

As far as names are concerned, I assume that the basic rule will be that those officers now assigned to Emilia and who have participated in our operations and planning for up to eight months now, will in any event be retained. Except in a few cases where the training and qualifications of officers assigned are ill-adapted to Emilia's special needs, I shall find it necessary to resist any measures to move officers indoctrinated in our methods to Regions farther forward, replacing them with new officers whose integration into the regional team must start from scratch. This is particularly true of the heads of special divisions. Even as things stand now, heads of (and sole members of) two of our specialist divisions are "assigned" to northern Regions and heads of two very important others (Public Safety and Transportation) "earmarked" for Austria.

I submit this letter in hope that the product of your further labors with the sub-commission during the next two weeks may offer a less vulnerable target to be "shot at" at the promised round-table of regional commissioners to be held in a fortnight.

I am confident that it will receive sympathetic consideration and favorable action.

I am leaving Rome tomorrow morning for my West Headquarters (Florence). I have committed myself to Col. McPhee to talk to
