1. The original plan of operating two separately organized regions under one Regional Engineer did not prove desirable. Consequently when Toscana region was turned back to the Italian Government, Liguria was assigned a Regional Engineer and staff of its own.

2. Owing to the release from active duty of certain American and British Officers in the northern regions and the necessity of assigning a British officer from one of the higher A & S groups as liaison officer to District 1, did result in more than normal turnover.

However, as Liguria is the smallest of any of the northern regions has little war damage as compared to the others, it could best afford changes in staff. Several electrical officers were transferred from their normal duties to public works duties to augment the staff because of the early turnover planned for the northern regions.

An officer in addition to the quota established for that region has been designated for Liguria for any special duties that may arise.

1. Reference 7024/23, 24 July, Subject: Personnel - AMG Venezia Giulia to the Vice Presidents of the several sections of AC. (Copy attached.)

2. Reference memorandum states a basic policy of strengthening AMG XIII Corps at the time the Northern Regions are turned back to the Italian government. No comment is made as to the obvious desirability of such a policy.

3. Reference memorandum, however, seems to place in the hands of the Establishment Section the final authority and jurisdiction over assignments of personnel performing the functions of the various technical sections, and provides that Vice Presidents will not make changes or new appointments without reference to the Establishment Section and the Executive Commissioner.

4. Recently, as I have pointed out to you and to the Executive Commissioner, the Executive Commissioner and his deputy have on occasions during their inspections in the Northern Regions made agreements concerning the assignment of Economic Section personnel without reference to the Economic Section.

5. There arises, therefore, a question of primary responsibility for the assignment of personnel in connection with Economic Section activities. It seems to me that some clarification is needed as to whether the Directors of the Sub-Commissions shall be deprived of the assignment of their personnel to carry out to the best advantage the technical duties for which they are held responsible. My suggestion is that the policy should be established at your level, the TD/NE to be filled should be specified by the Establishment Section and that the detailed assignments of the technical officers should be made by the

several sections in consultation and cooperation with the Directors of the Sub-Commissions. The final establishment, of course, would be subject to any criticism, comment, screening, and adjustment which might be recommended by the Establishment Section or higher levels.

6. So much for the assignments in connection with major changes in TE/WE. It is submitted, however, that whether for major changes or occasional changes in the assignment of personnel, there should be a change in emphasis and that the policy established in reference memorandum from the Executive Commissioner, "Vice Presidents will not make changes or new appointments without reference to Establishment Section and the Executive Commissioner" should read, "The Establishment Section and the Executive Commissioner will not make changes or new appointments without reference to the Vice Presidents of Sections."

Extract from HQ AMG Liguria Region reference LIG/HQ/16, 9 July 45, subject "Report of Liguria Region AMG for month of June 1945," to CG, IV Corps, classified "Secret."

Part II, paragraph F (page 3):

F. PUBLIC WORKS AND UTILITIES

"Public works in this region have suffered because of insufficient staff and frequent changes, to the extent that it presents a dark picture. In the beginning Liguria and Piemonte Regions were joined under one Regional Engineer, whose duties kept him, practically full time, in Piemonte. Liguria was left in charge of an officer who was shortly returned to the United States. After a considerable delay another officer was sent, who soon was recalled to Rome. The new Engineer, with a staff of four officers, is now present for duty--two months after operations should have commenced.

"Provinces of Apuania and Lucca were a part of the Gothic Line for a long period, and have sustained damage comparable to that at Cassino. Bridges are out, entire villages almost totally destroyed and the whole area disorganized. Public works activity is being given a high priority.

"The clearance of the harbor of Genoa has met with many difficulties which, after a minesweeper was destroyed with some loss of life, have resulted in the closing of the port for an indefinite time. The work of clearing Savona harbor was completed at the end of June, and will now provide an inlet for necessary food, coal and supplies to this Region.

"Negotiations have been proceeding with the French, looking toward a settlement of the electric power situation in Imperia."

I have delayed answering your wire 1368 of 7 July re Liaison Officer until I had had a talk with Col. Fiske.

We discussed the matter this morning and we are both of the opinion that a liaison officer attached either to my HQ or to Fiske's is essential.

As you probably know, my HQ are at MONZA 12 miles from MILAN. There is a danger of loss of contact between us unless I am kept fully informed of developments on the Military Government side, and similarly if Fiske is not kept informed of what the military are doing.

Fiske recommends Lt Col Hamilton now at LUCCA for the post. I know Hamilton and I think he would be most suitable. Fiske is writing to you asking if Hamilton can be appointed and I hope you can see your way to do this.

Dear Brigadier,

Your letter of 9 June reference 7007/288/EC has in the absence of General Spofford had my attention.

A decision as to the release of Colonel Gevers must await the return from London of General Flory, expected within a week, and a discussion to follow between General Flory and General Lewis, US Commander in the Vienna Area. I have stated to USGCC that this Headquarters takes the view that unless the above mentioned Generals consider the retention of Colonel Gevers indispensable, his transfer to Allied Commission for the employment indicated in your letter should be facilitated.

It is only fair to point out however, that the Commission can only absorb Colonel Gevers against an existing vacancy. There have been no vacancies in the 2675 Regiment for some time; in fact it has been over-strength for a considerable period. Therefore even assuming agreement by USGCC to the transfer it will be necessary to take this matter up at a high level with G1 this HQ seeking their consent in the special circumstances. The chances of securing such consent I would say are no better than even.

The Prefect of Florence told me of the good work done in the interest of the Province by Lt. Col. HENSLEY, Provincial Commissioner, with the post of liaison officer between the Italian and Allied Authorities.

Lt. Col. HENSLEY's knowledge and comprehension of local problems as well as the very great sympathy of the civilian population for him are a guarantee that the hard work for reconstruction which was started there might greatly benefit by the action and help of this superior officer if he happened to remain in this town, even after it was handed over to the Italian administration.

"Will you kindly ask the Allied Commission to examine whether it is possible to meet the wishes expressed by the authorities and by the population of this Province, allowing the said officer to keep the post he has at present.

8. Emergency CA Selection does not mean that all deficiencies and replacements of CA officers required can be provided. The present over-all shortage of officers will not permit this. It is the intention that the majority of Emergency Selected officers will be drawn from those officers who have volunteered under AOI 173/45, but who have not yet been interviewed by CASB. Such officers will be interviewed by Allocation Boards as directed by this Headquarters. There may, however, be

MEMORANDUM:

TO: Brigadier M. S. Lush, Executive Commissioner, Hq AC.

1. Col. Hannaford has been working since the opening of Regional Headquarters in getting the special Courts of Assize started as well as sections of Courts of Cassation. He has been invaluable to this region in the personal handling of magistrates, and the problems which have arisen. His services have been most appreciated.
2. I am aware that the departure of Lt. Col. Thackrach for England has left the Legal Sub-Commission short-handed on the Italian side, and that for this reason Col. Behrens has had to recall Col. Hannaford.
3. However, many grave problems remain, not only of a Regional, but of a North Italy nature. Threatened strikes of the consiglieri of the courts, for example, because of unbelievably low wages, have been averted only because of the influence an Allied Officer has.
4. I would appreciate greatly if Col. Hannaford could return to Lombardia even for only a three week period.
