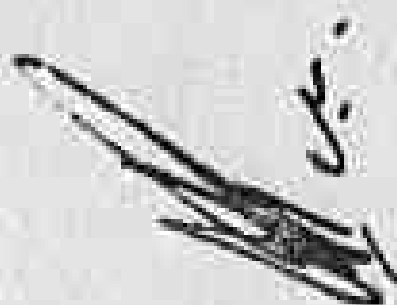

TRAINING AND ORIENTATION PROGRAM

1. General

A. References.

1. Training Memorandum No.1, Headquarters MTOUSA, 26 January 1945.
2. Training Memorandum No.3, Headquarters Rome Area, MTOUSA, 30 August 1945.
3. Letter, File No.333 (G-3), Headquarters Rome Area, MTOUSA, Inspections, 11 January 1946.

B. The goal of this program will be to maintain and foster the efficiency, morale, and military value of service units by emphasizing for all personnel the basic Military concepts of Soldiering.

2. Objectives

A. Training.

1. The maintenance of a high Standard of individual and unit discipline, alertness, physical condition, soldierly appearance and morale.
2. The exercise of economy, conservation, and due care in the preservation of supplies and equipment.
3. The ability to clean, care for, and use effectively, all weapons with which armed.
4. All measures prescribed for the protection of troops against preventable hazards to health and fitness.
5. The maintenance of a sufficiently high state of interior guard training, to insure the safety of unit personnel, and government property with which the unit is charged.
6. The reading and explaining of the Articles of War at least once during each six months.
7. A minimum of one inspection each week to insure proper state of police and sanitary conditions.

B. Orientation.

1. To keep all soldiers abreast of world events.

2. To conduct supervised group discussion in which the individual soldier's understanding of national issues may be increased to the point of a feeling of personal responsibility.

3. To acquaint troops being returned to the United States, whether for continued duty or for discharge, with their obligations to their country as soldier or as civilians.

3. Schedule.

A. All enlisted personnel assigned or attached to Headquarters, 2675th Regiment A.C. (Ovhd), will be divided into groups I, II and III as indicated below. (Note: Roster of individuals by groups is shown on attached sheet). These groups are set up to obtain proper size classes and to allow only a minimum of personnel to be absent from duty at any one time.

Group I

Tuesday's 10.30 - 11.30 hours - Orientation
" 11.30 - 12.00 " - Training

Group II

Tuesday's 14.00 - 15.00 hours - Orientation
" 15.00 - 15.30 " - Training

Group III

Wednesday's 10.30 - 11.30 hours - Orientation
" 11.30 - 12.00 " - Training

Group I, II and III

Saturday's 08.30 - 09.00 hours - Preparation for Inspection
" 09.00 - 10.00 " - Inspection

B. Subjects used for "Orientation" will be those proscribed by Rome Area, MTOUSA, in the weekly I & E conference.

4. Permission to be excused from any scheduled period must be obtained from the Regimental Commander and forwarded to the soldiers respective Unit commander, 24 hours previous to soldiers scheduled participation in this program.

5. Sub-Commission or Section heads will coordinate any re-arrangement of personnel within groups with the soldiers Unit Commander, such re-arrangement will only be made to avoid jeopardizing the operation of the section. Any increase or decrease of personnel within a section will be coordinated in a like manner.

JAN 16 1945

ATOUS. Directive on U.S. Army Training. Est Sec drew attention to this matter and stated days and times for U.S. Enlisted Men to attend parades. Sections were in agreement with the arrangements, which were for parades on Monday to Thursday inclusive, between the hours of 0800 and 0900 and 1330 and 1430 and two Retreats at 1700 - 1800 hours on Friday and Saturday. A similar scheme would be coming out for British Other Ranks and G.S. directed Lt. Col. Shipp to take up the matter with G-1(D).

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
