SUBJECT : Organization Communications Sub-Commission.
TO : Executive Commissioner.

1. - Lt. Col. Millar, Major Hawker and I shall be leaving on release within a few days which will reduce this Sub-Commission to Capt. Maddock (Postal Officer) and Major Holland (Telecoms Officer). The latter is being transferred from Liaison Group at Milan to Hqs.

2. Major Holland will be in charge and should remain until arrival of U.S. replacement for me who, according to A.F.H.Q., is scheduled to leave the U.S. by ship on June 20 which should result in his arriving here about July 5. He is reported to be a Lt. Colonel in the Signal Corps. This would permit Major Holland to be released from AC about July 15.

3. It has been arranged with A.F.H.Q. Signals that all matters of technical and routine nature will be dealt with directly by Signals with the Italian Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications. This would leave only matters of policy to be dealt with by the Sub-Commission or its successor.

4. It is considered that there should be on the staff of the Allied Commission or successor organization one Officer technically qualified in Postal matters and one Officer technically qualified in Telecommunications matters. Maddock and my replacement would be the two Officers whom I would recommend.

SUBJECT: Personnel Phasing Communications S/C

TO : Executive Commissioner. ✓

1. With memo of July 23, 1945, there was sent you a chart showing proposed assignment of members of this Sub-Commission up to and including November 1, 1945.

2. Since preparation of that chart, the situation has considerably changed, especially as to availability of U.S. Officers. A new chart has therefore been prepared which reflect the availability of U.S. Officers and conforms with the figures submitted by Establishment Section covering AC personnel expected to be on duty as of December 1, 1945. A copy of this new chart is inclosed.

3. It will be noted that chart shows assignment of members of this Sub-Commission in 3 phases:

- a. Upon turn-over of Northern Regions to Italian Government
- b. As of November 15, 1945.
- c. As of December 1, 1945.

The assignment of officers as of November 15, 1945 will have to take place at that date regardless of whether Northern Regions have been turned over to Italian Government at that date.

All but one U.S. Officer have agreed to stay on at

forms with the figures expected to be on duty as of December 1, 1945. A copy of this new chart is inclosed.

3. It will be noted that chart shows assignment of members of this Sub-Commission in 3 phases:

- a. Upon turn-over of Northern Regions to Italian Government
- b. As of November 15, 1945.
- c. As of December 1, 1945.

The assignment of officers as of November 15, 1945 will have to take place at that date regard less of whether Northern Regions have been turned over to Italian Government at that date.

All but one U.S. Officer have agreed to stay on at least until December 1, 1945 but it is considered advisable to have the organization set up on November 15, 1945 substantially as it will be on December 1, 1945.

4. A separate memorandum has been sent to Establishment Section covering transport necessary for Officers remaining.

SUBJECT: Personnel Phasing - Communications Sub-Commission
TO: Executive Commissioner

1. Based on the supposition that by September 1st, 1945 all of Italy with the exception of Venezia Giulia and some enclaves such as Naples and Livorno, will have been returned to Italian Government control, the inclosed personnel phasing chart has been prepared.

2. According to this plan by November 1st, 1945 the Communications Sub-Commission will have been reduced to a Liaison Group of 2 British Officers and 2 OR/EM's in case an Allied Mission remains in Italy or in case of the establishment of 2 Missions to Italy, 2 British and 2 American Officers and 2 OR/EM's. In addition there would be 1 Officer in Venezia Giulia.

3. Your comments on the inclosed would be appreciated.
