Reference G-1(B) mimeographed letter, Subject: Post-War Administrative Appointments, file G-1B/3/A, dated 18 October 44, this letter was issued in response to a large number of individual requests received from British officers of the Commission who sought information in regard to post-war administrative appointments. G-1(B), in conference with the Executive Officer (B), secured from AFHQ pertinent information on the subject, and the above letter was issued in order to simplify the processing of such requests. It does not apply in any way to American officers.

Inasmuch as the British administrative set-up within the Allied Commission does not have any separate means of communicating British administrative instructions to its personnel -- such as the American regimental organization has in its letters, bulletins, etc., which are issued directly from Hq, 2675th Regt, to the American military personnel -- this means was resorted to.

In regard to post-war administrative appointments for American officers, G-1(A) has received no instructions on the subject from higher authority; accordingly, it has asked G-5, AFHQ, for information.

Many enquiries have been received from Officers of this Formation regarding Post-War Administrative Appointments in European Countries and it is presumed that they refer to appointments in the Civilian Tripartite High Commissions which will eventually replace the Military Governments controlling Germany and Austria.

Although no definite plans have yet been formulated regarding the recruitment of personnel for these Civilian High Commissions applications for such appointments should be forwarded to this Headquarters in order that they may be registered.

Applications will be made on C.A. forms which will be submitted in triplicate.

Recommendations of the senior British Officer of the Region, A.M.C. Army, Branch, Section and etc are required but they will be made in the forwarding letter and NOT on the C.A. form.

A supply of C.A. forms is forwarded herewith.

Conditions of service for Post-War Administrative Appointments in other Countries, for instance, the Colonial Service, will be issued in the course of the next two or three months under an A.C.I. and applications for these appointments cannot be accepted at present.
