1. Reference is to your G-5: 0911711-1 (Italy) and exchanged signals.

2. The Minister of Transports has remained in favor of the continued operation of the Italian Railway Engineering Units, but it is quite obvious that he is not in a position to persuade the Minister of War to concur in this point of view.

3. It would appear to be useless to await any further discussions between the two Ministers, because in a matter of this kind the Minister of War must be responsible for making a decision, and we have therefore advised the Minister of Transports that there is now no alternative, but to accept the position.

4. We have, however, taken the opportunity to point out to the Minister of Transports that redeployment and release of Italian Military personnel is taking place, with the result that the original members of the Engineering Units have in many cases been released, and that the recruits are not in a position to render the same service and efficient work until a period of training has elapsed.

5. In addition to this, the disbanded members of the Units will obviously be seeking employment, and if the Italian State Railways continue their existing program of repair and rehabilitation, the many civilian contractors will undoubtedly be glad to employ the released military personnel who have had experience in railway repairs.

6. In the circumstances, this Sub-Commission is not prepared to continue support in favor of the maintenance of the Italian Railway

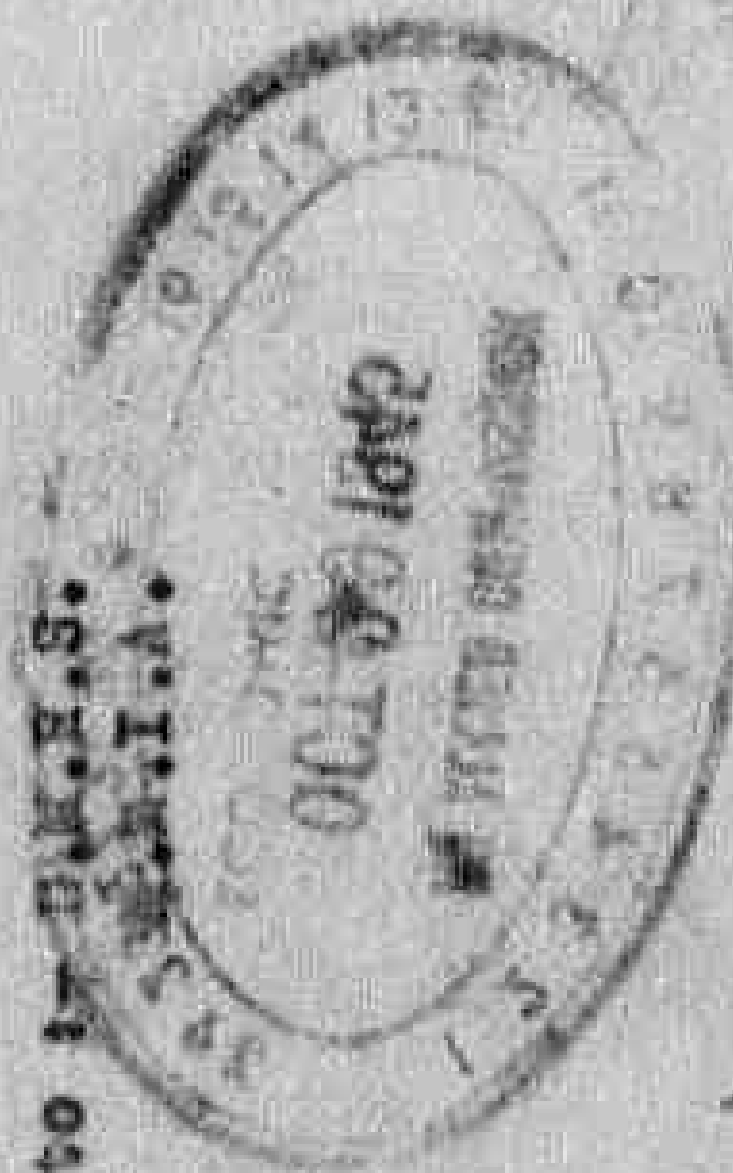

1. MMIA recommended the disbandment of all rly engr units vide letter SD/9 of 25 Jul (copy att) and signal SD 2947 of 6 Sep (copy att).
2. As AFHQ has firmly announced that these units are not required by the Allies, and as the correspondence goes back to Jul, it is earnestly hoped that you will render assistance to get this matter cleared up.
3. To support the statements made in paras 1 and 2 above, below is extract of letter 16711/Ord/1 of 10 Sep from Ministry of War to this HQ:-

" As we are convinced that the entire Italian Army must be employed only for military purposes, we have taken the necessary steps to inform the Ministry of Transport so that they may understand the necessity to accelerate to the maximum the handing over to civilian organisations the work which is now being carried out by the Railway Engr. Group."

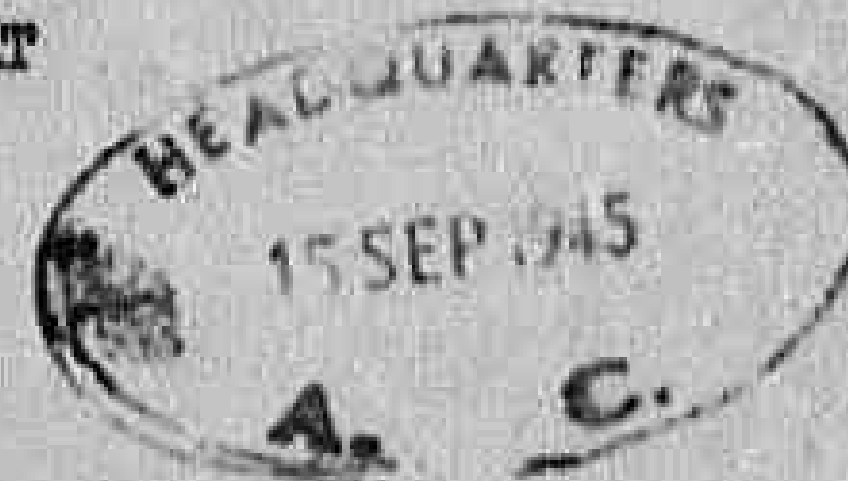

1. The Allied authorities have for some time had under consideration the question of the demobilisation of the older age groups of the Italian Army.

2. It has now been decided that in view of the reductions in the numbers of service troops now taking place and likely to continue, this demobilisation may be gradually effected, under the following conditions which apply to the whole Italian Army.

3. The Ministry of War will be responsible :-

- (a) That all Italian Units for which disbandment instructions have not been issued will be kept up to authorised working strength at all times.
- (b) That replacements for all demobilised personnel are delivered to the unit before such personnel are demobilised.
- (c) That replacements are fully trained to perform the duties called for by War Establishment and to the satisfaction of the employing Allied Commander.
- (d) That personnel in any particular age group will NOT be demobilised until approval for the demobilisation of that age group has been given by MILA.

4. Under the above conditions you are authorised already to demobilise the 1914 and 1915 and older classes, and are hereby authorised to effect the demobilisation of the 1916 class between 15 Sept and 15 October.

5. The future demobilisation of groups 1917 et. seq., will be considered by MILA on your advice and in the light of the speed with which units are to be disbanded, and the progress of demobilisation already authorised.

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- (c) That replacements are fully trained to perform the duties called for by War Establishment and to the satisfaction of the employing Allied Commander.
- (d) That personnel in any particular age group will NOT be demobilised until approval for the demobilisation of that age group has been given by MMIA.

4. Under the above conditions you are authorised already to demobilise the 1914 and 1915 and older classes, and are hereby authorised to effect the demobilisation of the 1916 class between 15 Sept and 15 October.

5. The future demobilisation of Groups 1917 et. seq., will, by considered by MMIA on your advice and in the light of the speed with which units are to be disbanded, and the progress of demobilisation already authorised.

6. Progress Reports on the demobilisation of such class will be sent to MMIA on the 7th and 21st of each month showing the number of men by age groups:-

In each Adm Div, Combat Group, etc as on the preceding 1st and 15th of the month.

7. You may give such publicity to these successions as you think advisable in the interest of discipline and morale.

Dear Admiral,

The Minister of War particularly drew my attention on the ever increasing dissatisfaction of the soldiers under arms, mainly caused by the excessive duration of the service done by the ancient classes, and by the great difference in the military duties which exists between the various regions. As a matter of fact, in Latium, Abruzzi, Puglia, Campania, Lucania, and Calabria, the classes from 1914 to 1924 (1st four months) were called under arms; the classes from 1918 to 1924 in Sicily; from 1916 to 1924 in Sardinia. In Puglia, Lucania, Molise and Sardinia, the 1924 classes (2nd and 3rd periods of four months) and the 1925 class have also been called under arms. On the contrary, no call or draft was made in other regions.

The spreading dissatisfaction greatly compromises the morale of the units, and encourages desertion.

Gradual demobilization is urgently expected by the soldiers and the country, and all unit commanders consider it is impossible to postpone it any longer.

I therefore think it is necessary to examine without delay whether it is possible to bring about without delay the gradual reduction of the contingent which is at present in service, according to the discharge program which is to be carried out during August and September and which M.M.I.A. has, it seems, already studied.

If the Allied Military Authorities agree about this matter, I shall be most grateful, my dear Admiral, if you kindly exercise your influence to have this immediately announced, to calm impatience and give confidence in the Superior Commands.

1. You are hereby authorised to demobilise the remainder of the 1914 class (about 9,000 men).
2. Personnel in BR-ITI units, US-ITI units, and ITI-ITI units under Allied Command will be demobilized under the supervision of the appropriate Administrative Division. The release of personnel will be phased to fit in with the requirements of the Allied employing formation, replacements for men demobilizable being furnished where necessary. Replacements will be found from units disbanded within the Adm Div, or by bulk allotments from outside.
3. Demobilizable personnel in other ITI-ITI units will be released immediately, being replaced where necessary by ITI-ITI personnel from units no longer required.
