Political: There were a number of reports of Communist activities in particular from SINNA where a number of Communist groups are being formed in the communes. Population at BARI was somewhat upset by the ROME trial otherwise situation was normal.

Food & Supplies: No important change. BARI reports that the grain harvest is in full swing. In Region V there is a shortage of sacks for grain. In SICILY the last remaining warehouse will be turned over to the Italian authorities in mid October.

Crime: Position satisfactory. A certain amount of unrest developed on the night of the 23rd in the Regina Coeli prison in ROME. Situation is now under control. A Carabinieri was shot dead by a British soldier at SALERNO. Assailant was arrested. GROSSETO reports occasional outbreaks of violence and looting. In SICILY armed bands are showing a tendency to increase.

HEALTH: Generally satisfactory. Increasing T.B. in GROSSETO. Typhoid epidemic is decreasing in BENEVENTO.

Political: Anti-monarchical feelings reported strong in Region VIII (GROSSETO Province).

In NAPLES Unione Femminile Italiana has been formed with the purpose of furthering the welfare and political rights of women. This is the first organization of its kind in Italy.

Food and Supplies:

In SICILY the sugar supply has now been distributed. Food and supplies generally in ROME are still causing anxiety. Coal is urgently required for paper mills and caustic soda for soap factory in FOGGIA. A shortage of naptha exists in GROSSETO Province and limits the threshing of wheat.

Crimes:

No important change. In SICILY police activity in connection with grain collection continues and there is some increase of serious crime.

Health:

Smallpox epidemic in NAPLES area decreasing. Typhoid is now reported epidemic in BENEVENTO City and there is also a sharp seasonal increase in SICILY together with typhus. In ROME the health standard is low due to malnutrition.
