1. Forwarded herewith is a poem in Latin entitled "Liberae Filiae Americae", dedicated to Franklin Delano Roosevelt. The poem was written by Ignazio Tomae, professor of Greek and Latin in the classical Lyceum at Trapani, Sicily; a man who has been the winner of classical prizes in national competition and is hailed both as a scholar and as an advocate of democratic principles. The prose translation is by Dott. Gerolamo Lade, a local professor of English and translator who served an enlistment in the United States Army in 1926-28. The accompanying letter is from Paolo G'Antoni, the Prefect of Trapani Province installed by A.C.C. last August, and who has since been a loyal and efficient collaborator with the Allies in reconstructing the governmental and economic life of this war devasted area.

2. An extra copy is enclosed, to be forwarded to the classical department of the President's alma mater, Harvard College, if he so desires.

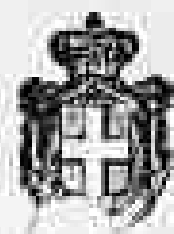

Your Excellency:

1. Your liaison officer has asked the Interior Sub-Commission if arrangements can be made to enable correspondence from your department to be sent to officials in occupied Italy through Allied Control Commission postal channels.

2. The Allied Control Commission agrees to this request subject to the following arrangements:

(i) Each letter from you or your Department will be placed in an open envelope bearing the name and address of the addressee.  
(ii) The letter and open envelope in (i) will be placed in a second open envelope. This latter envelope will bear the title of the senior representative of Allied Control Commission in whose area the Italian addressee is resident. For example, a letter intended for the Prefect of Benevento will be enclosed in an open envelope addressed accordingly and placed in a second envelope addressed, "Regional Commissioner, Region III." In case of doubt, the Ministry of Interior will make a request on the envelope for the proper name and address to be written thereon by Interior Sub-Commission.

3. Letters for dispatch under these arrangements will be brought to the office of the Interior Sub-Commission, Room 114, Palazzo di Giustizia.

4. Such letters will be transmitted daily by the courier service with outgoing Allied Control Commission mail for delivery to the Message Center at Main Headquarters, Naples.

5. Where the Interior Sub-Commission or any other representative of Allied Control Commission are of the opinion that the contents of any letter delivered under these arrangements are contrary to the views and policy of the Allied Control Commission, such letter will be referred back to the Minister of Interior for reconsideration.

Among these programs were advances to persons who lost household goods through military action, relief payments to persons who formerly received money from relatives in foreign countries, and relief payments to refugees from other parts of Italy.

2. According to our information, the requests for funds to continue the programs have been made to the Prefettura by the E.C.A. but the funds have not been received, nor has there been an explanation of the delay.

LETTERS THROUGH THE AMERICAN CONSULATE AT Palermo

Reference to a previous circular on the above subject it seems that a misunderstanding has arisen and therefore I wish to emphasize the following points:

1. The American Consulate at Palermo ~~cannot~~ transmit any letters at all, to relatives in the United States, for any person residing here other than U.S.A. citizens.
2. Short messages may be sent on behalf of long exile American citizens by the American Consulate at Palermo, through the Department of State, to relatives in America. Such citizens must present proof of their citizenship, preferably in the form of an American passport.

Provincial Commissioners are requested to inform all Prefects and Mayors in their area of the above and to direct them to publish it in the local newspaper. They should also be informed that the letters which have been written to the American Consulate at Palermo under erroneous interpretation cannot be answered because of their great volume, and insufficient personnel.

Dear Maria de la O and Constanza. Thanks to the British Embassy in Madrid, I send you this letter that will bring you news from me. At the same time I will probably know about you.

Your last news that came to us was a telegram from the father of Ricuccio, from Torre del Greco, the 5th of September, last. The news said that you were at Montella (Avellino). After that day, we know nothing. We are very worried, but we hope, by the news we receive here, we think that nothing bad has happened to you. If God wills it, so let it be.

We are in very good health, and so are Pepe and the baby, and so is the rest of the family. But we are always thinking about you, and above all, the boys, of whom we speak, every day. We passed, as usual, Christmas and New Years in Cheste, and we all came back 15 days ago. We hope that all of you are now in your house at Torre del Greco, with all the family.

We would greatly like to have news of you, even if they are bad news, at least to know of you, Ricuccio, Edoardo, the boys and all the family, if they are all right, and what they are going to do. Making use of the kind help of the British Embassy in Madrid, Mr. Bryan Wallace, this same letter will introduce you to the British authorities at Torre del Greco or Naples, and letting them know by which way you receive this, and replying in the same manner addressing your letter to Mr. Bryan Wallace, British Embassy, Madrid.

Please let me know as soon as you get this letter telling me what happened to all of you during this last month, in order to have a peace of mind that nothing has happened as we implore to God, every day.

Best regards to the family and to all, especially embracing and fervent kisses to the boys, and to Edoardo and Ricuccio and to you, our fathers and brothers.

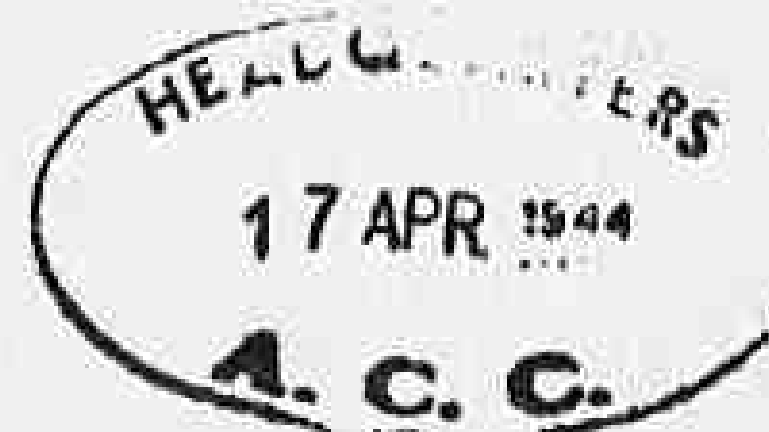
