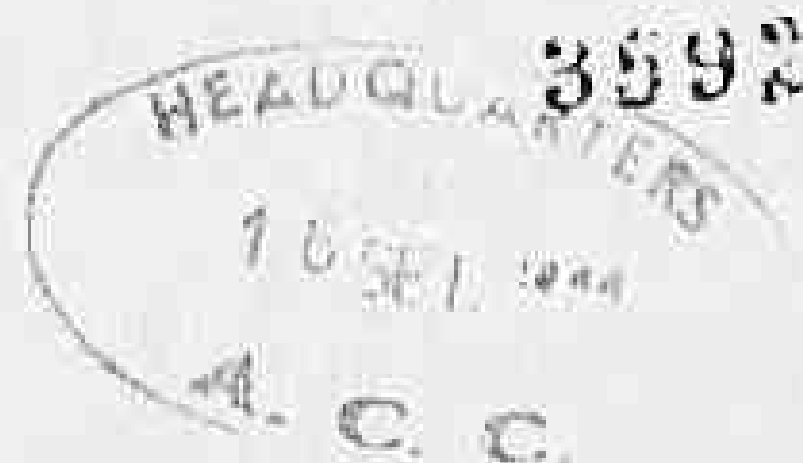

We have had our share in the sufferings of this war! Our little convent in Gruzgano was used as a dressing station for wounded soldiers of different nations and we were happy to help in this way. we have also in this Holy House given shelter to about 30 Patriots and Israelites and saved their lives.

But when we have asked the help of a little "Truck Camionina" to take our Sisters back to the Convent in Gruzgano from where they had been bombed out it has been refused. I therefore turn to you, Col. Fiske, feeling certain that you will help us. All our furniture was burnt or taken away so the Sisters would need a little Truck where they could bring with them some beds and other necessities.

TO : Region VIII.

1. On 31 July 44, there were forwarded to this HQ. two letters by Signorina Tolando of your HQ. for delivering to the Swiss Legation in Rome. At present there is no civilian mail service between Rome and the south and if these letters are posted in Rome they will be intercepted and held by the Post Office until such time as the service is open officially.
2. We regret we cannot pass on these letters but if you care to forward a message for onward transmission to Switzerland we shall see that it is delivered to the Swiss Legation here.
3. It is pointed out that communication between this Country and Switzerland is very slow and uncertain.
4. Please see that communications for civilians outside your Region are not forwarded through official channels. Negotiations are in progress for the further extension of the postal service and civilians must wait till these channels are open before writing letters.

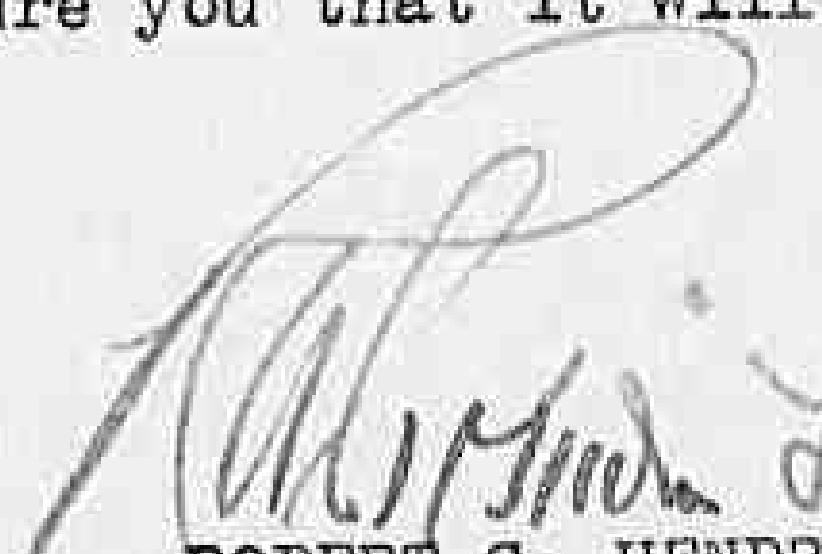

In the first place I wish to inform your Excellency that I have never belonged to Fascism, as I was pensioned off in Sept. 1923 by State Railways, where I had been employed as Chief Conductor with a pension of 7 tenths of my salary instead of ten, as according R. Decree-law N. 1431, which Decree had been approved by the Chamber of Deputies, the Senate and by Victor Emmanuel III King of Italy.

Fascism and his chief Mussolini savagely deprived me of 3 ~~thirds~~ tenths of my already small pension, after I had been honestly working for 23 years as an employee.

I am now 67 years old and am living in Campagnano di Roma on a daily pension of 25 lire included "caro-viveri" (indemnity for high-living), which is not enough to buy the necessities of life. Here in Campagnano di Roma we are living in a surrounding of anarchy and robbery, as between producers and traders there is an agreement to raise prices, so that I with my small pension cannot manage. This city of Campagnano di Roma is left without any authority: nobody governs it according to the new discipline of freedom.

It would be extremely useful if a serious Anglo-American official could come on the spot to verify the indecent prices of the most necessary food. And I should be glad if the Honourable Official would call on the undersigned and get from him exact information, without any exaggeration.

I take known that since June last month I have not been paid my pension, as the Railways' Paying Office has not forwarded by post the orders of payment.

Beginning to be forgiven for the liberty I am taking, I put myself at Your Excellency's disposal

Information has been received from the War Office, under message TROOPERS 28336 F4PW of 8 June, that OFFPAY (presumed Army Paymaster, Officers Accounts), Manchester, is arranging remittances of 25 pounds sterling every 3 months to the above named. It is stated that payments are to be made under authority of ACL 703 of 1944, and the above named is referred to as "NEERAMOVEN" which may be either a code name for next-of-kin, or due to some technical error in signal transmission, it is impossible to determine which.

A copy of the War Office message was repeated to Mideast.

2. It is not known whether authority for payments will yet have reached local Army Pay authorities in Italy, but production of this letter to the said authorities might enable payments to commence in advance of official notice through financial channels.

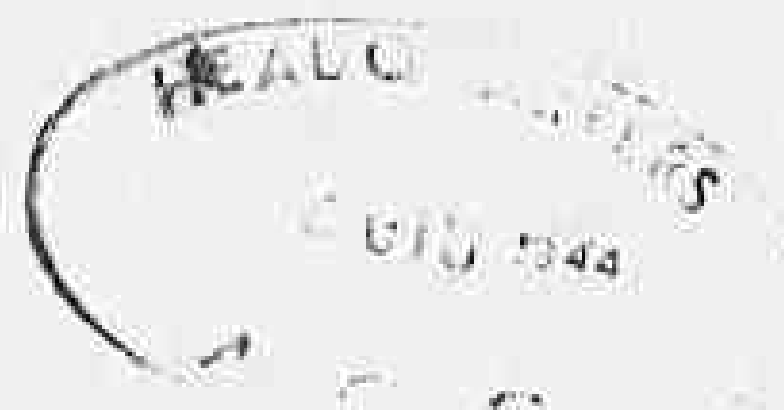

SUBJECT : Communications with Allied-controlled territories.

TO : Their Excellencies, the Ministers and the Undersecretaries of State.

The Allied Control Commission has noticed that some ministries continue to communicate directly with Italian officials and with surrounding offices which are still under the control of the Allied Military Authorities.

I think therefore, it is necessary to call again all the ministries to a vigorous observation of the directions contained in my previous circular, No. 129/ Pres. Cons. of 20 January.

It is necessary to repeat that in foregoing territories, the task of giving directions, of a general or particular nature, is reserved exclusively to the Allied Military authority to whom, those ministries, who wish to direct anyone in their official functions who are in such territories, should, from time to time, formulate requests to the Allied Control Commission if it is an order of general character, to the individual AMG, if it is an order of a particular nature. (as transfers, promotions, etc.).

The central administration should, therefore, avoid absolutely communicating directly, for official reasons, with the Italian administrations and authorities who are in the above-mentioned territories.
