SUBJECT: Move of AFHQ.

TO : Headquarters, Allied Control Commission, APO 394

1. According to the latest information available, AFHQ Algiers will officially close at Algiers at 0001 July 20 and will open at Caserta at 0001 July 20.

2. The forward echelon of G-5 will arrive on the 16th of July or thereabouts with only skeleton personnel and equipment and will not be in a position to deal with matters having reference to the general files until the arrival of the G-5 rear echelon on or about the 23rd, departing Algiers on the 20th. The Chief of Section will depart Algiers on the 20th and will arrive at the new Headquarters on the same day.

3. In order to avoid unnecessary delay in delivery due to this Headquarters being in transit it is suggested that letter correspondence be addressed to G-5 AFHQ Adv. as of the 16th, and cables as of the 19th.

SINCE I SPOKE TO YOU ON JUNE TWENTY FIRST ABOUT THE URGENT NEED FOR MOVING THE ITALIAN GOVERNMENT TO THE CAPITAL AS SOON AS POSSIBLE CMA PAREN TO AFHQ FOR SAC CMA BRITISH RESIDENT MINISTER CMA AMERICAL POLITICAL ADVISER AND G FIVE REPEATED AFHQ ADV CP RPTD ADV AAI FOR GENERAL ALEXANDER FROM ACC MAIN FROM STONE PERSONAL PAREN I HAVE BEEN TO ROME AND CONSIDER IT MY DUTY TO PRESS THIS ONCE AGAIN IF THE ALLIED CONTROL COMMISSION AND THE ITALIAN GOVERNMENT ARE TO CARRY OUT THEIR ADMINISTRATIVE TASKS PD PARA THE ALLIED CONTROL COMMISSION IS NOT STAFFED WITH SUFFICIENT PERSONNEL FOR SUCH THINGS AS THE REPAIR OF ROADS, CMA COMMUNICATION LINES CMA AND THE RE HYPHEN ESTABLISHMENT OF HYDRO HYPHEN ELECTRIC STATIONS PD FOR THESE AND OTHER PROJECTS OF VITAL CONCERN TO ALLIED FORCES IN ITALY WE HAVE FROM THE FIRST RELIED UPON EXISTING ITALIAN ORGANIZATIONS, CMA WHICH/WE HAVE CONTROLLED AND GUIDED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE WISHES OF THE ALLIED COMMAND PD THE MAINSPRING OF THESE ITALIAN ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATIONS IS IN THE ITALIAN MINISTRIES IN ROME PD AS THE GERMANS DID NOT SUCCEED IN DESTROYING THIS MACHINE ALTOGETHER IT IS IN THE ALLIED INTEREST TO GET IT WORKING AGAIN AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE PD BUT SO LONG AS THE ITALIAN GOVERNMENT CANNOT GO TO THE CAPITAL THE ITALIAN MINISTRIES WILL BE RESTRICTED TO SUCH INTERNAL HOUSEKEEPING PROBLEMS AS CAN BE DONE BY A SMALL CADRE OF PERMANENT OFFICIALS PD

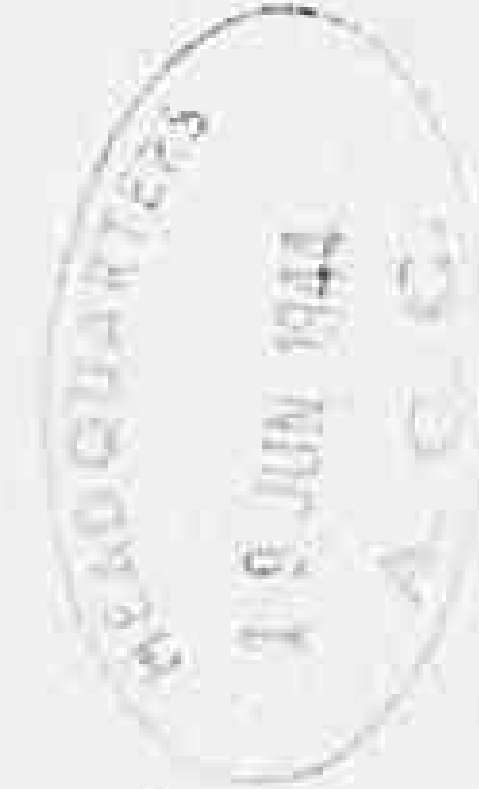

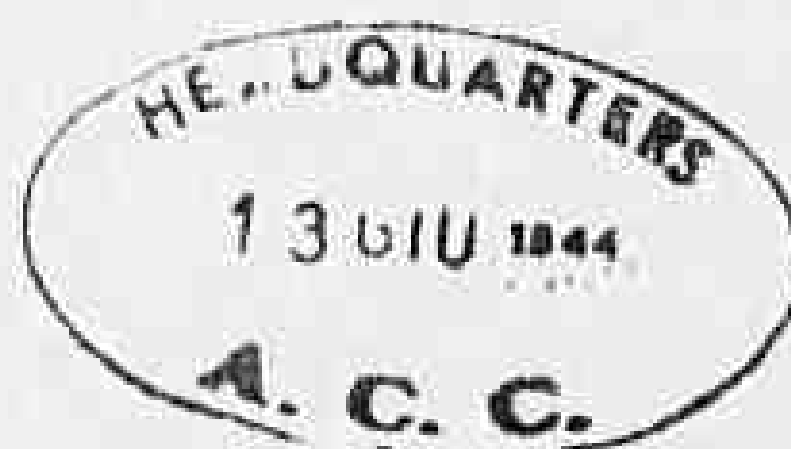

Subject: Use of Carabinieri to discipline Italian troops.

To : S.O.A.O., AMG, 5 Army.

1. The facts stated in para. 2 of your letter dated 19th February, 1946 are not quite correct.

2. Major Friend James who is AOC Liaison officer with H. A.O. P., states that although he knew of the trouble in the Italian troops, he did not demand the Carabinieri. He was asked to arrange transport for the Carabinieri which he understood had been detailed to go by Lieut. Col. Pollock with the concurrence of your Chief of Staff, who, in fact, sent two officers with the party.

3. Lieut. Col. Pollock has not been asked to report in person to the AOC. But the Chief Commissioner requires a report from you on the matter. An incident of this sort should be reported automatically to this Headquarters. The maintenance of discipline among Italian troops is not the direct concern of AMG but AMG should be prepared to assist in every way to do so. H. AOC are very much concerned with the state of discipline among Italian troops.

4. The confusion in the matter appears to have arisen largely owing to the separation of your own H.Q. from your Chief of Staff and indicates the desirability of your early removal from Naples - a move which, but for the organizing of the Rome party, is long overdue.

SUBJECT: Removal of Rebellious Italian Troops to
Concentration Area.

FROM: Major Friend James, Liaison Officer, A.C.C. *James*
TO : Brig. Gen. LEBB, Deputy Chief Civil Affairs Officer
AMG, A.C.C.

1. Acting on orders of my commanding officer, Col. Pollock, Chief of the Public Safety Division, I assisted Major Wilcox, AMG, Fifth Army, yesterday, in an operation which consisted in removing approximately 100 partially armed Italian anti-tank troops from their bivouac near the junction of highway No. 15 and Highway No. 6 north of CASERTA to a barbed wire enclosure in the same vicinity where 250 Carabinieri troops under the command of Captain Baker, P/S Division, AMG, placed them under guard and in the custody of General Cortese, commanding the 210th Italian Division.

2. My part in the operation was to get these troops to surrender themselves peacefully without the use of Carabinieri troops and thus avoid possible conflict.

3. Leaving General Cortese at the concentration area where he later stopped the trucks bringing the Carabinieri from Caserta, as per our agreement, I proceeded by car to the area where the anti-tank troops were bivouaced accompanied by Colonel Bonfilli, their commanding officer, and Major Rini, General Cortese's assistant. It required a good hour's talking and listening to arguments on both sides before I could convince the sullen men to climb into the waiting Italian army vehicles with their gear and depart under the command of their officers like soldiers.

4. When the caravan of five trucks reached the concentration area they were stopped and Captain Baker's Carabinieri ushered them into the concentration camp without incident.

5. These troops, who had flatly refused to obey all orders of their superior officers for a period of ten days, voluntarily surrendered themselves to their commanding officers and any discipline that may subsequently be meted out to them primarily, I think, because I made them a promise. I promised them that if they agreed to conduct themselves as Allied soldiers should and place themselves under the authority and discipline of their officers once more that I as an Allied officer would do all in my power to correct the bad conditions under which they had been serving.

3623

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6. The following conditions are the substance of the troops complaints, which I am reporting to you for whatever action you may deem advisable:

- (a) For a certain period of time the American unit to which they are attached had placed them under the command of French officers who subjected them to various indignities. In view of the fact that France and Italy were only recently at war it is obviously unsound to place Italian soldiers under the command of French officers.
- (b) These troops had been recruited in Sardinia, yet they were serving under Italian officers. In view of the present very uncertain political situation and when separatist movements exist in Sardinia as well as Sicily it would seem wisest to place Sardinian troops serving in Italy under the command of Sardinian officers. Sardinian soldiers are inclined not to believe or trust an Italian officer, therefore they are loath to obey them.
- (c) Island troops, such as the Sardinians, resent the appearance of Italian soldiers, either in or out of uniform, who have been just released from service or for some reason are not required to fight. Some effort should be made to segregate these.
- (d) The appearance of well paid Italian civilians angers the admittedly ill paid soldier from the islands. Perhaps steps could be taken which would prevent the unnecessary mingling of these two groups.

7. It is recommended that some action be taken which will correct or at least ameliorate the above mentioned conditions and not alone because I promised to interest myself on behalf of the Sardinian troops concerned. I have their own authority for saying that unless their condition is improved they will revolt again, and the next time they will be much more difficult to handle.

Subject. CC.RR used for disciplinary action against Italian troops.

To. Chief of Staff, AMG, Fifth Army.

1. At 1 am. 15th February 1944, Capt. Tompkins and Lieut. Atkinson, C.A.P.Os attached to Lt. Col. Pollock's staff, called at this Headquarters, stating that they had received a request to supply 250 CC.RR from the Rome contingent to deal with insubordination on the part of Italian troops.

2. Capt. Tompkins had obtained the following information from Capt. CICOGNA, Liaison Officer G.4 Fifth Army, under Col. BRISSACH:

The 2nd Mule Pack Company, a Labour unit of the Italian Army, had recently been engaged in the 2nd Corps area. After nearly two months they had been brought out of the line to rest, but within a few days had been ordered back to duty. At first the troops, who were encamped at CAIANELLO some 15 miles north of Capua in the Fifth Army area, refused to obey. Eventually some of the men complied with the order but 250 still refused.

General BASSO, Commander of the Italian Armed Forces, had given orders to General CORTESI of the 210th Division that if the 250 men refused to obey orders they were to be disarmed and interned by the CC.RR.

The 250 CC.RR were required for this purpose.

Arrangements had been made with the Provost Marshal, Fifth Army, to detain the troops in the P.O.W. cage at VAIRANO under CC.RR guards.

3. At 1-15 am. I telephoned Capt. CICOGNA (Lightning Rear 144)

3621

and asked him if the staff of the Fifth Army was aware of the situation. He replied that the matter had been discussed between the Chief of Staff (General GRUNTER) and Col. BRISSACH.

4. At 1-25 am. I* telephoned the Deputy Chief of Staff (Lightning Forward 55). The telephone was answered by Col. Porter who said that he knew the facts and that the CC.RR should be sent as requested by Col. BRISSACH.

5. I then telephoned Capt. CIOGNA and told him that 250 CC.RR would be collected from Naples and held in reserve at Caserta. I informed him that no steps should be taken until I had seen Major MINI between 7+30 am and 8 am.

6. Accordingly I arranged for Capt. Tompkins to collect 250 CC.RR under their own officers with one day's rations and to hold them on reserve in Caserta until they received instructions from me.

7. Lieut. Col. Pollock was informed of the arrangement.

8. At 7-40 am. a meeting was held between Col. Ashley, D.S.C.A.O Fifth Army, General CORTESI, Major MINI, Lieut. Atkinson and myself. It was decided that an effort should be made to persuade the recalcitrant troops to return to duty before using the CC.RR against them.

9. At 9 am. I saw Lieut. Col. Littlefield, of the Provost Marshal's office and confirmed the arrangements for making use of the P.O.W. cage at VAIRANO.

10. At 11 am. the 250 CC.RR under their own officers arrived at Caserta in 10 trucks in the charge of Lieut. Walters, 56th Quartermaster Truck Bn., Capua. Lieut. A.E. Baker, C.A.P.O., was placed in charge of this contingent of CC.RR.

11. At about 12.30 pm. General CORTESI, Major MINI and Lieut. Atkinson reached VAIRANO, where they met Col. BONFIGLI, the commander of the 67th Regiment (Italian). Leaving General CORTESI at VAIRANO, Col. BONFIGLI, Major MINI and Lieut. Atkinson went to CAINELLO where the Italian troops were encamped. There they found 108 men under Capt. AVIGLIANO and two lieutenants. It appears that most of the remainder of the 250 men who had refused to obey orders had decided to return to their unit the previous evening.

12. Col. BONFIGLI and Lieut. Atkinson spoke to the men, advising them to return to duty at the Company Headquarters at TRIFLISCO. After half an hour or so all the men, except 10, agreed to return. When the 10 men saw the remainder packing their equipment into trucks, they too decided to return.

13. At 1-15 pm. the 250 CC.RR, accompanied by 62 CC.RR from the Naples Legion who were sent by General BASSO to act as guards at the P.O.W. cage, arrived at VAIRANO.

14. At 1-20 pm., accompanied by Capt. CICOGLIA, I visited CAINELLO and it was decided to drive the 108 Italian soldiers to the P.O.W. cage at VAIRANO. On arrival at the cage the troops were paraded. Capt. AVIGLIANO then picked out 38 men who had been troublesome. The 38 men were interned in the P.O.W. cage under CC.RR guard. The remaining 70 men were taken to the Company HQ at TRIFLISCO to join their unit.

15. Capt. AVIGLIANO stated that the total strength of his troops was 350 men. They were accounted for as follows:

25 CC.RR from the Naples Legion were left at VAIRANO to round up the 32 men who were probably hiding in the district. 15 CC.RR from the Naples Legion were left to guard the 38 men in the P.O.W. cage. These arrangements were made by Capt. Ferrara of the Naples Legion of CC.RR. Capt. Egan, G.M.F., the officer in charge of the P.O.W. cage, was in agreement with the action taken.

16. At 4 pm. the 250 CC.RR of the Rome contingent were sent back to Naples under their own officers. At the same time the surplus 22 CC.RR of the Naples Legion returned to their Headquarters on instructions from Capt. Ferrara.

17. With Capt. CICOGLA I then went to the Advanced HQ of the Fifth Army and reported the situation to Lt. Col. Porter of the Chief of Staff's office. He expressed himself as satisfied with the result and asked Capt. CICOGLA to notify Col. BRISSACH, of the Italian Army Staff. Accordingly, Capt. CICOGLA left a note at Col. BRISSACH's Headquarters.

18. I then saw Major Blum, G.2, Fifth Army, and acquainted him with the facts. Major Blum is arranging ~~xxxx~~ for the C.I.C. in conjunction with S.I.M. to interrogate the prisoners to discover whether there is any subversive element among them.

19. With Capt. CICOGLA I returned to this HQs at 6-30 pm.

20. It is understood that General BASSO, Commander of the Italian Armed Forces, will hold an enquiry.

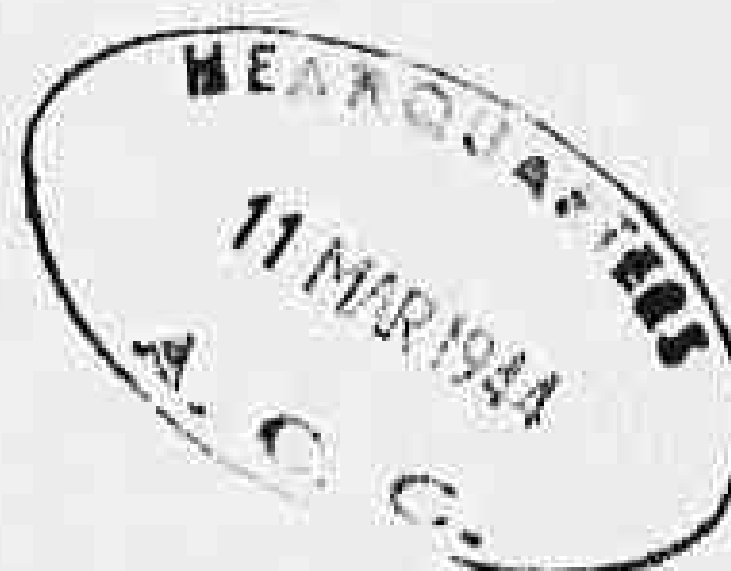

To: HQ AMG/ACC, Naples

The Comando Supremo have informed the Commission today that they have decided to move in the near future, and have asked that we facilitate their move as far as possible at the other end.

Their strength is approximately

30 officers 180 Other Ranks 30 Vehicles

They are sending a reconnaissance party (under Major A. Adam) on the 2nd or 3rd February with orders to obtain 23 office rooms. As it is believed that Salerno is full, he is going to try Cava or Nocera. The former is obviously preferable from our point of view as it is nearer Salerno.

For your information, S.I.M. is sending a similar reconnaissance party (Lt. Col. P. du Cros) to fix their 50 officers, 200 other ranks, and 20 vehicles at Naples.

I am giving a copy of this letter to Major Adam (Italian Army).

1. The First Echelon of Headquarters, APC, Rear Party, departed Salerno 21 January at 0700 hours by Motor Convoy No. 011345 with thirty one motor vehicles, including two motorcycles, and personnel consisting of six (6) officers and fifty eight (58) enlisted men or other ranks. The vehicles in this convoy consist of the following:

- 10 - Trucks, 1 1/2 ton
- 3 - Staff Cars
- 2 - Trucks, 3 ton
- 12 - Trucks, 15 cwt.
- 2 - Motorcycles

2. This convoy should arrive Salerno on 3 or 4 February and the Convoy Commander will report to your officer for further instructions.

3. All officers, enlisted men and other ranks, of the above personnel in this convoy will proceed on to Naples, with the exception of Private E. G. Jones, British, who is assigned to the Public Safety Sub-Commission and who should be retained in Salerno.

4. All motor vehicles, office furniture, office equipment and other equipment in the convoy will be dispatched to Naples, where the proper distribution will be made. In this connection, the ratio of distribution of available motor vehicles between Salerno and Naples Headquarters is now being calculated and the actual distribution of additional vehicles to Salerno will be made immediately after the arrival of the Salerno convoy in Naples.

5. The Second Echelon of Headquarters, APC, Rear Party, consisting of eight (8) officers, eighty nine (89) enlisted men or other ranks, motor vehicles, equipment and freight will move from Salerno by sea. The date of departure of this party is not yet known, due to the uncertain shipping accommodations. You will be advised of the dates of departure and arrival upon receipt of information in this office.

6. The date of the movement of the Third and last Vehicle of Headquarters, AGC, Rear Party, consisting of three (3) officers, four (4) enlisted men or other ranks and three vehicles, remaining in Salerno to clear records, will be announced at a later date upon receipt of information.

7. You will prepare to house the personnel and equipment of this convey overnight in case the time of arrival at Salerno will not permit proceeding on to Naples. You will advise this office by telephone upon arrival of this convey and instructions will be issued as to when convey should depart Salerno.

8. Reference paragraphs 1 and 3 above. A separate communication is being issued giving details as to personnel.
