MEMORANDUM TO: Establishment Branch.

1. Attached is a printed copy of the original chart of the structure of this Headquarters prepared some time ago by Colonel Warren of Naples Province.

2. After trying in vain to have the chart duplicated by photographic methods, I asked our printing department to have a try. They have belatedly produced this fairly satisfactory result, of which I have a considerable number of copies.

3. The information on the chart as printed is inaccurate or incomplete in the respects indicated by the matters marked in red on the attached copy. There have been changes in Regional Commissioners in Regions 2 and 7. Rome Region, Region 8 and Region 9 have been added. I believe that General Lemnitzer has been promoted and perhaps there have been other promotions of which I have not been advised. I am no longer head of the Liaison Division and there are some further changes pending in the Economic Section and perhaps elsewhere.

4. In spite of these inaccuracies, which can be easily corrected in individual cases, it is my opinion that the chart can be of considerable use in demonstrating Headquarters channels of communication and control to officers in the field. I would favor distributing them rather liberally. There may, however, be sound reasons of policy for not doing so, and this is a matter which is of course now entirely "outside of my jurisdiction".

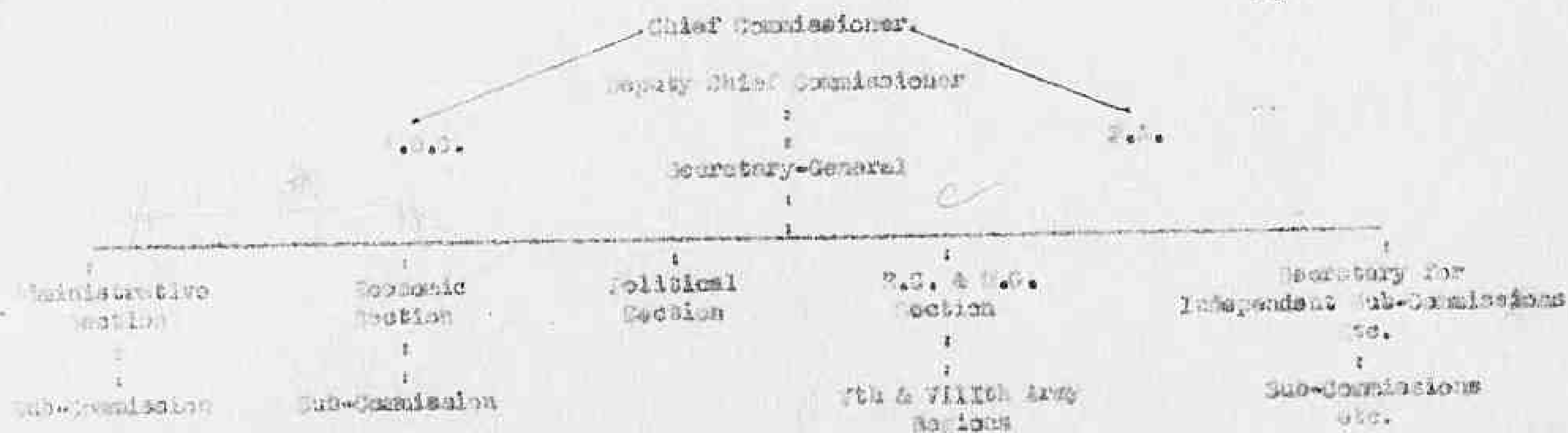

SUBJECT: Executive Memorandum No. 2

TO : Executive Commissioner, Main Headquarters ACC, Naples.

1. Paragraph 2(e) of Executive Memorandum No. 2 dated 7 February 1944 states that all contact with military formations will be made thru the office of the Executive Commissioner. It is important that the independent sub-commissions, at least, be permitted to maintain their present relations with outside military formations, since it would greatly hamper their work not to maintain their existing direct contacts.

2. Moreover, it is recommended that other sub-commissions be permitted to conduct direct correspondence with military formations on purely technical matters, as is permitted in paragraph 7(a), correspondence with officers of Regions and Army AMG.

3. In order to implement the above, it is desired the following two amendments be made:

"In paragraph 2(e), last sentence, after 'that' insert 'except for independent sub-commissions'."

"In paragraph 7(d) after 'Regions and AMG Armies' insert 'or with technical branches of military formations'."

Appendix "A" to ACC Directive No. 1 (Organization Chart) is cancelled together with so much of the Directive itself as is obviously superseded by the subsequent Orders and Memoranda listed in a. above, and by this Order.

c. A Directive dealing with revised Regional re-organization and personnel ceilings under ACC conditions will be issued shortly.

2. New Organization - HQ ACC.

Appendix "A" to this Order gives the new organization in outline, and Appendix "B" the detailed breakdown of the Regional Control and Military Government Section. The new organization will be put into operation forthwith to the extent possible - full implementation will have to await final completion of moves from Prindisi to Salerno and the absorption of Regimental Headquarters (see paragraph 3 below). The main changes are as follows:

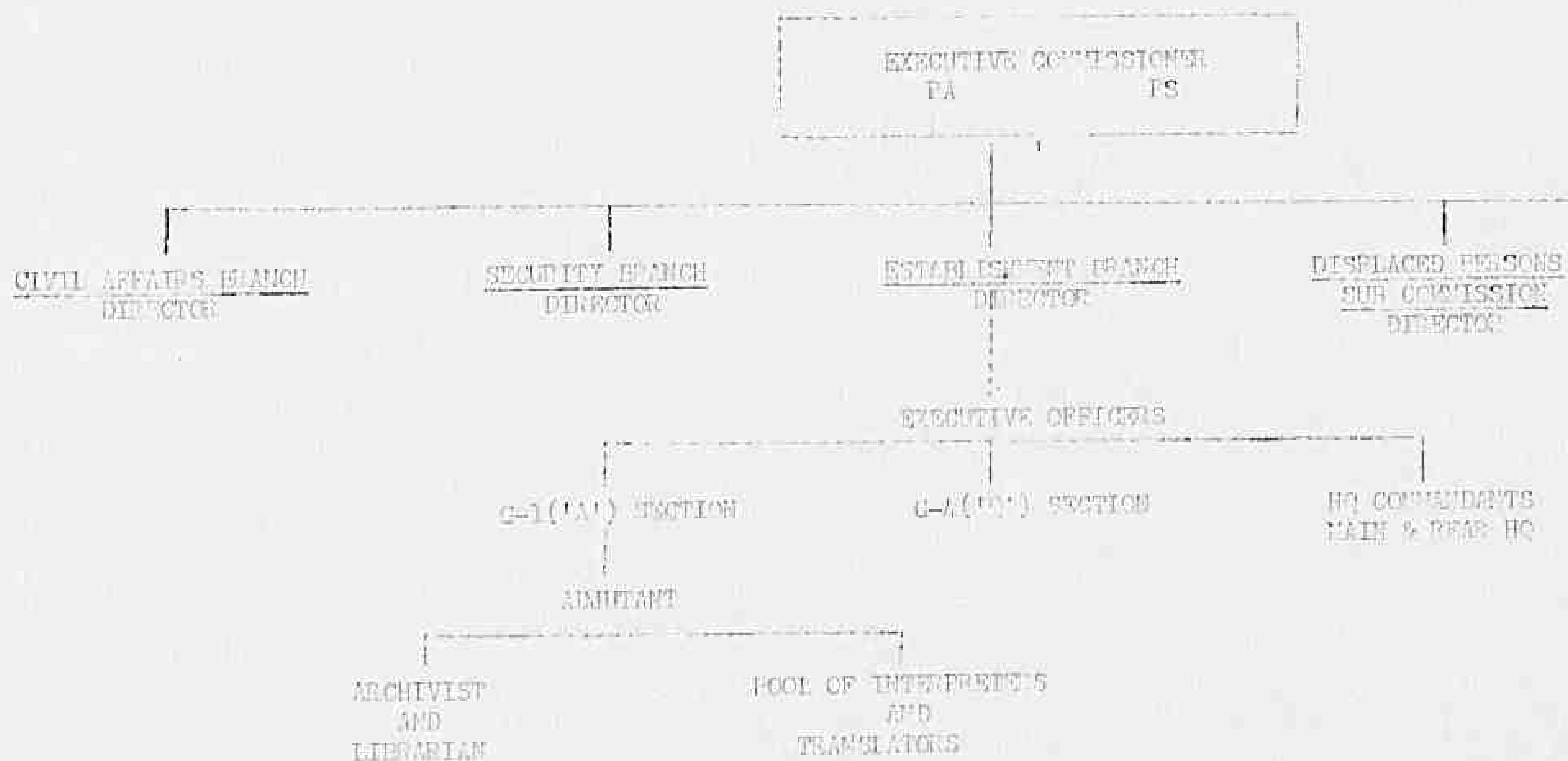

DETAILED ORGANIZATION



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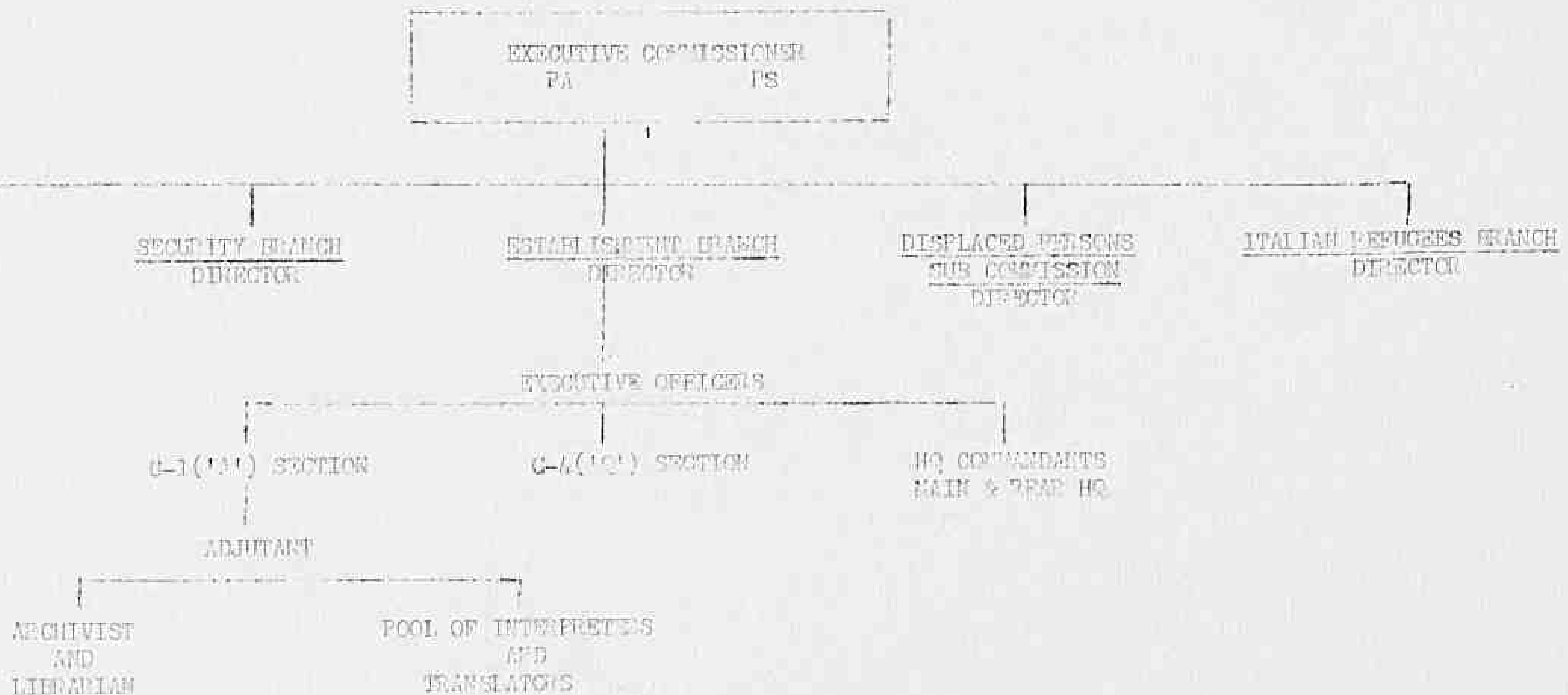

SUBJECT: A.C.S./A.S.A. REORGANISATION.

TO: HEADQUARTERS, A.C.S.F..

Reference attached memorandum, I wish to make the following points.

1. With the inevitably scattered lay-out of the organisations with which A.C.S. has to deal it is essential that the Deputy President should have a Vice-President as his personal deputy both to act in his absence and to be located near one of the main cooperating organisations where the situation necessitates this.
2. I am abolishing the post of Chief of Staff. This Officer and his office had far too much to do.
I am substituting a Secretary-General with adequate staff to deal with coordination at Main Headquarters and much of the work hitherto done by the Chief of Staff will devolve upon the Regional Control and Military Government Section now being formed.
3. It has become quite clear in practice that a combined Administrative and Economic Section was too big, too unwieldy and altogether too large to be effectively worked as one entity.
I have, therefore, divided it into an Administrative Section and an Economic Section each under a Vice-President.
I have added the Sub-Commissions for Internal Transportation and Shipping to the Economic Section and have abolished the previous Communications Section which did not warrant a continuation under a Vice-President.
4. I have set up a new Regional Control and Military Government Section. This will be the executive section for dealing with Allied Military Government and control "in the field". It will also be responsible for security and internal administration. It will do a great deal of the work hitherto done by the previous Chief of Staff.
The section will be of great importance and fully warrants its head being a Vice-President.
5. The Political Section is advisory only and it will function alongside under joint British and American Directors. This is what it has been doing for the past four months.

Its advice on the subject of questions connected with Displaced Persons will be most valuable and always sound but there are many disadvantages in placing the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission under the Political Section.

6. As regards the Independent Sub-Commissions, all these work very much on their own. They do not fit into any of the main sections and they are best left to work independently under the direction of the Deputy President working through the Secretary-General.

I am fusing the P.S. Sub-Commission and Displaced Persons Sub-Commission as under the existing organisation there has been a great waste of available resources. This Sub-Commission will have a P.S. Sub-Section and a Displaced Persons Sub-Section but the personnel at the disposal of the Chief of the Sub-Commission will be available for either Sub-Section and can be switched from one to the other in accordance with the pressure of prisoners or refugees at the month.

7. I have kept the balance of British and American appointments just about equal on the higher level. Admittedly both Vice-President and principal assistant in the Economic Section are American but the majority of the heads of Sub-Commissions in this Section are British.

8. I urgently request official sanction to the reorganisation which is the result of experience to date and has the complete approval of all my Vice-Presidents and Senior Officers.

There are many urgent problems with which to deal and I am already working to this organisation.

1. The present situation is that the American personnel of AMG 5 Army form a detachment of Company G of 2675 Regiment.

This results in an appreciable amount of duplication of work in that all equipment used by AMG 5 Army has to be accounted for by both the Company Commander and the Detachment Commander, and an additional step is introduced when items are requisitioned.

2. Company G includes American personnel in AMG 5 Army and at HQ, AMG, ACME as well as in AMG 5 Army. The personnel in the last named form however, the great majority, and it is therefore strongly recommended that AMG 5 Army (American portion) become G Company and that the Company Commander and his Headquarters come under the orders of SCAG, AMG 5 Army. It is requested that this be considered for inclusion in the present reorganization of AMG.
