SUBJECT: Transfer of Experienced Officers.

TO: Colonel Moxe L,
Acting Chief,
Military Government Section,
A. F. H. Q.

Your memorandum MGS 210.3 of 4th. February refers.

1. Your Para 1.. By no means all the 1500 officers you refer to can be accurately described as experienced Military Government officers.
As regards economies in personnel and ultimate needs, I very much doubt if it will be possible to make any very definite forecasts for some time to come. Ultimate needs depend largely on how, and how fast, we absorb the rest of Italy and upon the way in which the Italians cope with the administration of territory as transferred to them.
2. Your Para 2. Noted.
3. Your Para 3. I will be glad to discuss the position with Colonel Garry. I cannot in present circumstances accept nomination by you of officers for key positions elsewhere without reference to me. I have already been asked to give up officers with qualifications rendering them of great value in Italy and little elsewhere, while I have officers with no special Italian qualifications and possessing qualities useful in other countries still in my organisation.
4. Your Paras 4, 5, and 6. I will discuss these with Colonel Garry and Colonel Parkman when they reach me. I am trying to contact Colonel Parkman here but have not yet ascertained whether or not he has left for Algiers.
5. Your Para 7. I am quite accustomed to facing up to grave administrative

problems
