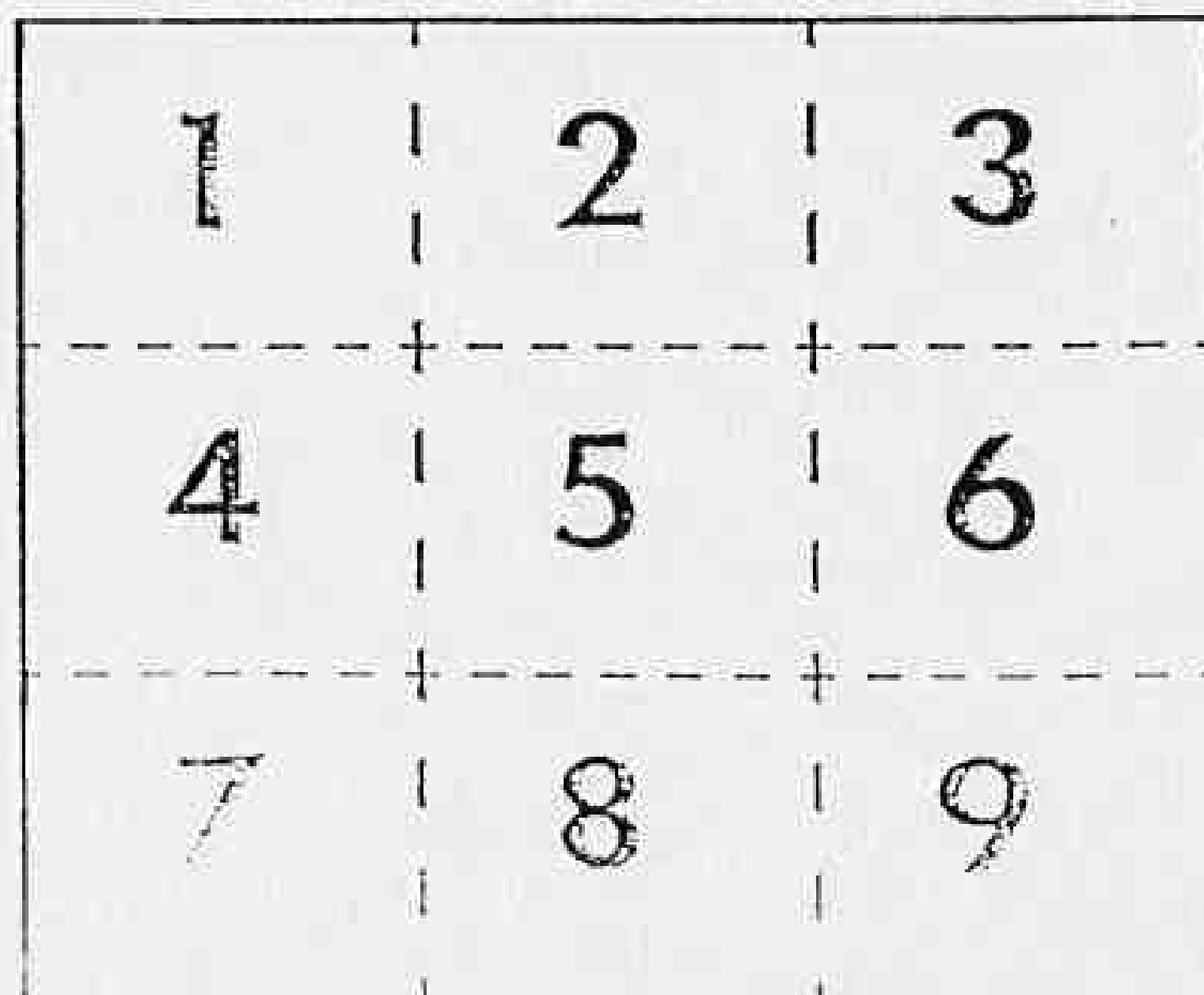
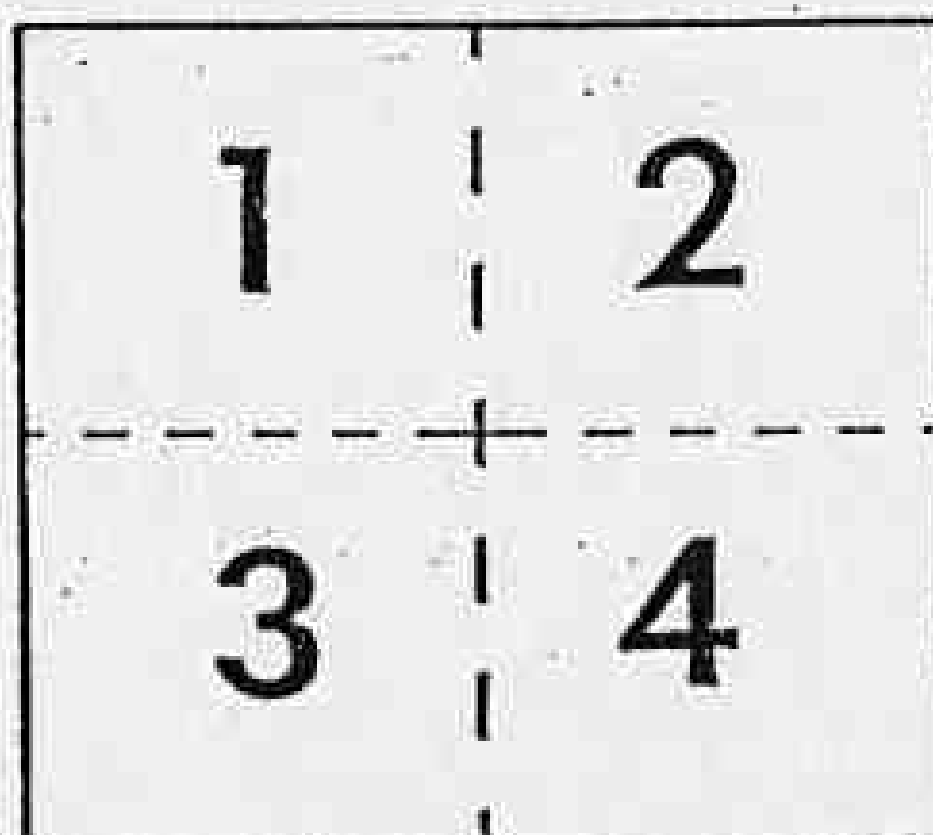
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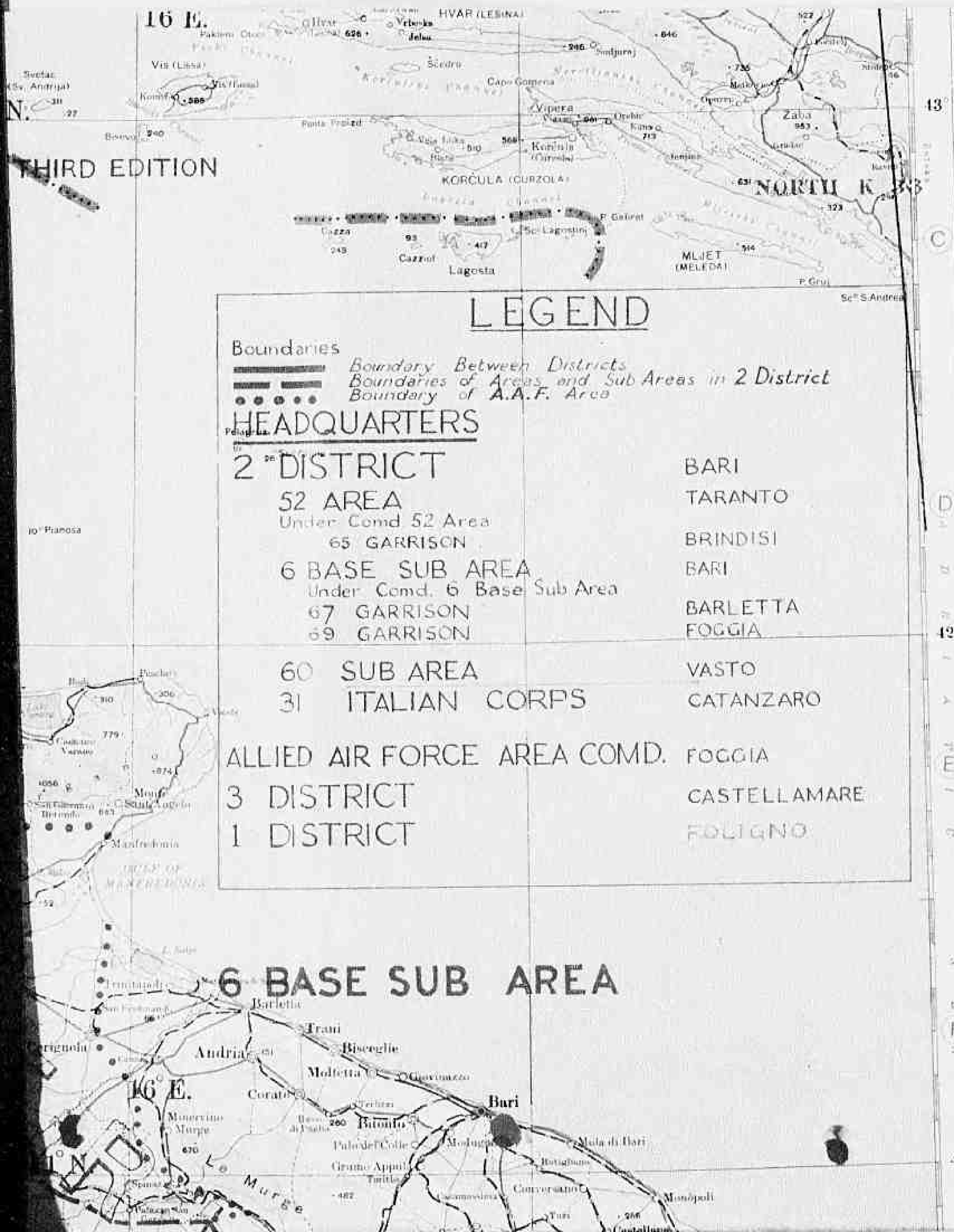

"4A. Veh spares for RN.

- (a) The Army is responsible for the supply of spares for WD type vehs held by the RN.
- (b) RN units holding such vehs are authorized to hold spares required for repairs within unit capacity. Holdings will be based on eight weeks expenditure of items normally held as a spare scaling by L&Ds.
- (c) RN units are responsible for submitting the necessary indents through the naval offr in charge of the port concerned to the DADOS of the sub area.
- (d) RN demands will be met on the same basis as army demands. Where RN demands are stated to be of op urgency they will be treated on the same basis as the demands of army units re-equipping within the Dist for ops."

EXPLANATION

- 1 The military command of the region of Calabria passed to 31 Italian Corps on 30 Oct 1943.
- 2 The towns of RS00010 and the portion of the region of Calabria beginning at the mouth of the river at D 448507, thence generally eastward upstream to the meeting point, thence south along the meeting point to river mouth, at D 44842, thence generally westward downstream to mouth of river at D 448420 was transferred to the control of No 1 District on 3 Feb 1944 and is therefore not covered by this instruction.

- 3 211

3 All Coastal Div, 212 Coastal Div and certain Corps troops are being withdrawn from Colombia and the MAFUCA Div is being reinforced.

4 The incursions and capture of the roads and the communication of bridges will shortly be taken over by the civil and organic civil working under the control of the ACC - Civil Works and Utilities Sub-Commission as directed by the District.

INTENTION

5 To define the responsibilities and tasks of 31 Indian Corps.

ACHIEVING GOALS OF MEXICAN ACTION

6 It is anticipated that enemy action in Colombia will be limited to sabotage, with the object of cutting communications and disrupting installations.

This sabotage may be attempted by enemy agents or affected persons at present in Italy, but it is probable that enemy sabotage parties may be dropped by parachute or landed from small craft.

5 In addition to the responsibilities within the air force area, the British Garrison Commander will be responsible to Commander 1st Sub Area for command and local administration in the remainder of FOCSEA Province.

6 Conventions responsibilities will be as follows:-

(a) Within the coastal air force area Commander will be responsible for all defence measures including passive air defence and firefighting, but not including anti-aircraft and coast defence units. He will be responsible for finding all necessary funds and reports. Until such time as sufficient US troops are available for these duties Commander 1st Sub Area may be requested through the British Garrison Commander to provide such assistance.

(b) All Defence of BANGKOK, and Fairfield is the responsibility of Commander 2nd Sub Area.

(c) Coast Defence Area of the Province is under command of Commander 203 Fixed Defences.

- (b) Rates of pay and conditions of employment will be as fixed by No. 2 District and will be adhered to by all employing services.
