- (a) With effect from 2 June 1944 the qualifying date for eligibility to return to U.K. will be that on which five years unbroken service overseas is completed. The 1st January 1944 will no longer be the qualifying date for the purposes of such calculation.
- (b) The same principles will apply in calculating overseas service as is laid down in para (b) of the above quoted Routine Order.
- (c) Particulars of Officers and C.Rs. whose names were not submitted under A.G.C. R.B. 15 and those who have since qualified for return to U.K. by reason of long service abroad, will be forwarded to C-1 (British) at an early date, in order that G.H.Q. and Echelon can be notified accordingly.
- (d) Particulars should, in future, be notified as and when personnel become eligible.

G.R.O. 256 of 4 June 1943

1. W.D. Transport may be used for recreational purposes subject to the provisions of this Order.

2. Formation Commanders may authorize Officers commanding units within their formations to sanction the use of W.D. transport for recreational purposes subject to the following limitations:-

- (a) W.D. vehicles will not be used where rail transport is available.
- (b) No officer or soldier will be allowed more than one journey per week.
- (c) C.O.s. will be responsible that the type of vehicle employed does not exceed the capacity required, and they will not authorize the use of motor cars by other ranks unless they are satisfied that it is uneconomical to use a larger vehicle.
- (d) Motor Cycles will not be used.

ESTABLISHMENT'S TRAVEL

16. Use of W.D. Transport for Recreational Purposes

Regional Commissioners and HQ Commandants (Main and Rear) are authorized to sanction the use of W.D. Transport for recreational purposes subject to the limitations imposed by G.R.O. 256 of 4 Jun 43, which is republished below.

(G-4/100/12).

G.R.O. 256 of 4 June 1943

1. W.D. Transport may be used for recreational purposes subject to the provisions of this Order.
2. Formation Commanders may authorize Officers commanding units within their formations to sanction the use of W.D. Transport for recreational purposes subject to the following limitations:-
 - (a) W.D. vehicles will not be used where rail transport is available.
 - (b) No officer or soldier will be allowed more than one journey per week.
 - (c) C.O.s. will be responsible that the type of vehicle employed does not exceed the capacity required, and they will not authorize the use of motor cars by other ranks unless they are satisfied that it is uneconomical to use a larger vehicle.
 - (d) Motor Cycles will not be used.
 - (e) Journeys over 20 miles from quarters will not be permitted except on the authority of the Pde. or equivalent commanders.
 - (f) Where in the opinion of the formation commander it is desirable to exercise greater supervision, O.N. in the case of small units formation commanders may direct that such units obtain the prior sanction of formation HQ before using the unit transport for recreational purposes.

3. This concession does not relieve formation and unit commanders of the responsibility for the conservation of petrol and rubber.

5. Collection of Charges.

(a) Personnel conveyed in own Unit V.D. Transport.

O.C. will be responsible for collection of the amounts due to the public and will take on such amounts its receipts in their Imprest Account.

The entry in the Imprest Account will be supported by a Statement or voucher showing (i) the total number of miles travelled (ii) the number of officers and/or other ranks conveyed (iii) the amount due to the public.

Statements or vouchers will be serially numbered and bear a Reference as follows - (Unit) / V.D.T. / (Serial No.) - and will be certified correct by the O.C.

(1) Personnel conveyed in V.D. Transport of another Unit.

The O.C. supplying the V.D. Transport will prepare a certified Statement (or voucher) in quadruplicate as in (a) above, immediately the service has been completed. The Statement (or voucher) will also be endorsed to show the unit to which the transport was supplied. One copy of the Statement will be sent to the Command Paymaster, No. 2 Command Pay Office and two copies to the O.C. unit to which the V.D. transport was supplied. The fourth copy will be retained until notification is received from Command Paymaster that payment has been made and brought to account.

The O.C. unit to which the V.D. Transport was supplied will pay in the amount due to the nearest Field Cashier, supported by the two copies of the Statement or voucher, one copy of which will be returned to him receipted by the Cashier.

The O.C. unit to which the W.D. transport was supplied will pay in the amount due to the nearest Field Cashier, supported by the two copies of the Statement or voucher, one copy of which will be returned to him receipted by the Cashier.

- In order to improve the method of reporting "V" Vehicle casualties requiring their recovery assistance, drivers of all "V" Vehicles will carry copies of the program, as shown at Appendix "A" to this Order, L.A. 11.12.
- When a casualty occurs, the driver will complete the program and hand to the driver of a passing vehicle for delivery to the next recovery post.
- This system will become effective from the date of this Order.

15. Return to U.K. of Long Service Personnel

- (a) The qualifying period for posting of British Personnel to U.K. on grounds of long service overseas, as laid down in HQ 138/44, is five years unbroken Army Service abroad. The present ruling data is the 1st January 1944.
- (b) Periods of leave or duty, not exceeding 6 months, spent in U.K. during the five years are not taken to constitute a break for the purpose of eligibility.
- (c) In order to provide a forecast of future commitments, the following action will be taken by HQ of ARS Units, Regions and Sub-Commissions:
- (i) Headquarters of ARS Units and Regions will prepare nominal rolls of British personnel who, on 25 February 1944, and who reported to that HQ at any subsequent date, embarked for service overseas before 30th June 1942, and submit them direct to G-1 (R), HQ ARS.
- (ii) Heads of Sub-Commissions will prepare similar nominal rolls and forward them to CC, British Detachment of Main and Rear Headquarters who will consolidate them, including any such personnel who are not accounted for by Sub-Commission, and forward the completed nominal rolls to G-1 (B), HQ ARS.
- (d) The nominal rolls will state clearly the name, rank, personal number, regiment or corps and date of embarkation of all eligible personnel.
- (e) NIL returns will be submitted.
