(c) They will return to Regional HQ the same day except in the case of Perugia, Terni and Rieti. 106

(d) Perugia, Terni and Rieti will be visited by the same Courier on succeeding days. The Courier will proceed direct to Perugia, where he will remain for the night; the following day he will return to Regional HQ calling at Terni and Rieti en route.

(e) Immediately on return to Regional HQ they will report to the Message Centre, Secretariat.

(f) Rations for the midday meal will be collected from the cook-house before leaving. In the case of Perugia, the Courier will draw one day's ration from Cnd. Co. "D".

4. Provinces are requested not to delay the Courier by holding them back for letters etc. but to allow them to leave not later than 1400 hrs. so that they may get back to Regional HQ in good time.

To : Chief Commissioner, Allied Control Commission

1. The present system of allocating telephone service in Rome has led to complete and utter confusion coupled with bribery and corruption. Every telephone subscriber in Rome is trying to get his phone connected and is bombarding the offices of the Commission with requests for preferential treatment, offering everything from a dinner invitation to a thousand lire note. Gossip is that nothing happens to telephones ordered connected until someone drops around to the telephone company and leaves a thousand lire in the proper hand.

2. It is quite impossible for us to screen all of the telephone subscribers, and in consequence there are frequent instances of well known fascists having their telephones reconnected ahead of more deserving subscribers, with consequent screams from the press.

3. I understand that you are opposed in principal to meter service because it is in affect an increase in rates, but I suggest that, pending rate revision, it is the only prompt and effective way out of the present muddle. Restoration of the phone service on a meter basis is now being held up because of your objection. If you should see your way clear to withdraw it, the Wire Board is prepared to direct the telephone company to restore such service at once.

1. The Director of Communications Sub-Commission has brought to my notice your telegram No.1047 of June 15th from you to ACC Rear for Henderson, the text of which reads "Send 5 civilians as arranged Woodcock". This message has been classified as "Secret" and given the precedence as "Urgent".

2. It is considered that ^{without} full knowledge of the facts, the classification of "Secret" is probably not necessary. It is almost certain that the precedence of "Urgent" is wrong. Your attention is drawn to para.5, Daily Bulletin No.141 of the 15th June, and you are requested to draw the attention of all officers of your Headquarters to the vital necessity of strict compliance with this order.

3. Please explain why the precedence of "Urgent" was used in this particular instance.

1. I enclose an example of the most flagrant case of misuse of both classification and precedence in message traffic that has come to my notice.
2. The matter relates to the forwarding of five Italian civilians to Rome for the censorship of urban telephone traffic. It is neither "secret" nor even "confidential" though it might reasonably be classified as "restricted", nor can I believe that it is "urgent" or even "priority" in its nature.
3. Such misuse of defined terms, of course, makes any system of control of message traffic hopeless, and can only lead to serious hampering of military operations by the delay of traffic of real urgency and importance.

- 2 The trunk switchboard is at the moment being worked by Italian and Yugoslav civilians.
- 3 While it is appreciated that no telephone in Italy is secure, it is most inadvisable from a Security point of view to have an Italian or Yugoslav (who cannot ever be really thoroughly vetted) civilian, block of paper and pencil in hand sitting at a switchboard used by the Allied Army authorities. As more and more trunk switchboards pass to ACC, this danger to Security will increase.
- 4 It is appreciated that Allied Army personnel to work these boards are difficult to find; it is suggested however, that British civilians from Malta or Egypt might be recruited.
- 5 Your views in the matter will be appreciated at the earliest possible date.

1. There have been several instances of telephone calls being connected to the wrong numbers, with the result that busy senior staff officers have been needlessly interrupted. The causes are partly due to mistakes on the part of switchboard operators, but also largely due to subscribers themselves. The instances solely attributable to faulty operating are relatively small, and every effort is being made to reduce the number still further.

2. Subscribers can help the telephone service generally by ensuring they ask for the right numbers. If in doubt they should ask to be connected to "Information", who will give them the necessary particulars. Subscribers are also asked to listen carefully to the repeat back of a number by the exchange operator, and to correct it if necessary. A proper use of the phonetic numerals will assist materially in the prevention of wrong connections.

3. Subscribers are also reminded that there are two experienced Supervising Officers at the exchange (Extension 189), who are on duty during the busy periods. If they have difficulty or trouble in getting connections, the Supervising Officers are there to help.

4. There is still a number of instances of subscribers booking trunk calls and leaving their telephones before they are put through. If it is necessary to leave the telephone after booking a call, the call should be cancelled or, alternatively, arrangements made for another subscriber to accept it.

(ii) The use of "PERSONAL FOR" should be cut down to the minimum and only used for personal reasons or when it is desired to bring the cable to the attention of a particular officer for special reasons.

4. (i) The attached list of "Non-secret short title unit designations" will be used.

(ii) Application has been made to AFHQ for various branches of A.C.C. to be added to this list. When approval has been given and announced by AFHQ these short titles will be adopted and will clearly indicate which branch of A.C.C. is concerned.

5. (i) Cables addressed to a HQ are automatically transmitted to AFHQ, unless qualified "IGAN" or "ADV" etc.
