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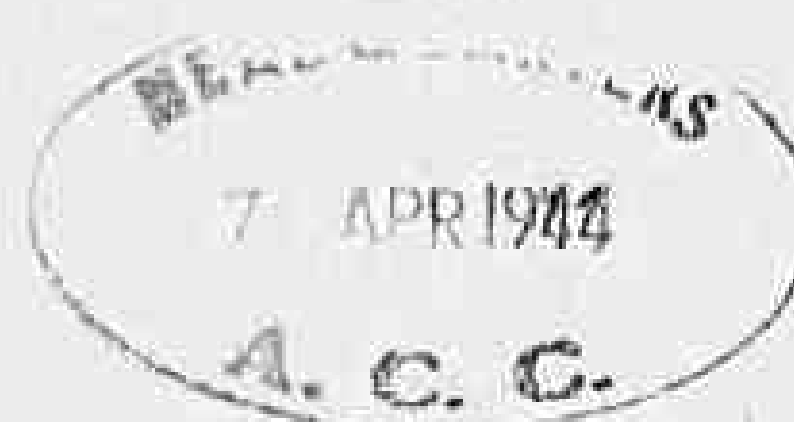

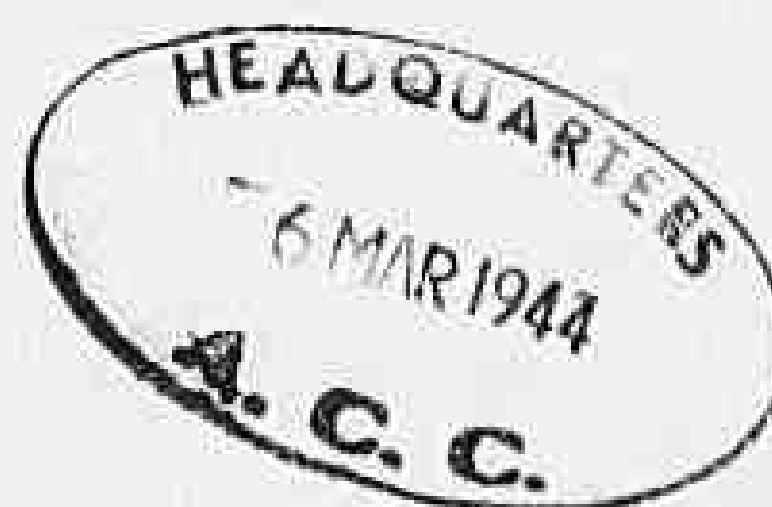

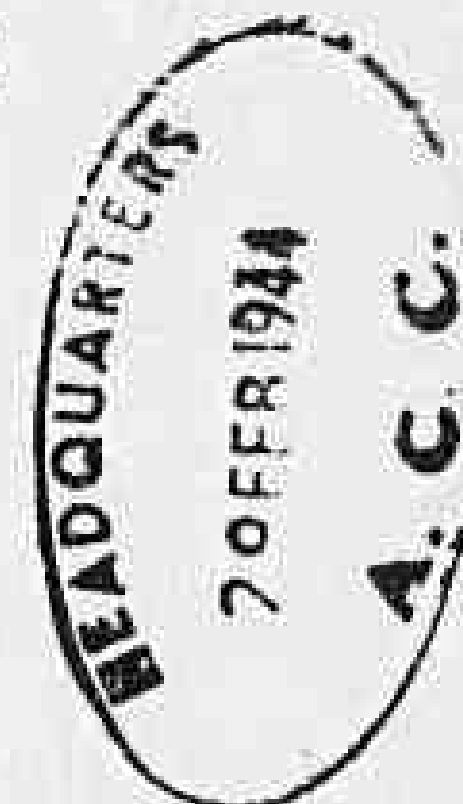

3. Local adjustments have been made in the Bari and Foggia areas, in favour of the Italian Air Force, against requisitioning by the Allies of buildings and material necessary to keep the ~~the~~ air units in the air.
4. A decision on the definition of functions of the Air Sub Commission is awaited from higher authority.
