Her series weekly sitrep requested your letter 1 Aug begins :-

Political: Continued resistance to grain collection in SICILY has a background of political agitation and unrest but Separatism is subdued. Socialist-Communist influence in PUGLIA is noticeable.

Econ & Supplies: Distribution is the main problem and is likely to be with us continually due to shortages of transport. Chief difficulty at present is to be found in southern Italy (Region II). ROMS also not up to its ration scale because supplies have not reached the city in sufficient quantity. SICILY has been short of sugar for some time but arrangements have now been made for a three months supply.

Crime: Shows no unusual trend except in SICILY where violations of grain laws continues. Nearly 9000 persons have now been denounced and 15000 quintals of grain confiscated. The whole effort of the Carabinieri is focussed on grain collection. Evasion of grain laws is by no means non-existent elsewhere but it is only in SICILY that it approximates to organised resistance. The trouble has been recognised for some time and all possible measures to cope with the situation have been taken.

Health: The outbreaks of smallpox are abating but typhoid has appeared in BENEVENTO City and elsewhere. Water and milk supplies not incriminated and the outbreak is believed to be due to insanitary conditions and flies.

SUBJECT 2.

Reported to be under control as result of countermeasures but situation being watched. No exceptional increase of malaria is reported. FORTINE MARCHIO area being sprayed weekly from the air.

Refugees.

There has been considerable trouble recently due to a spontaneous movement of refugees in parts of Italian Government Territory. These are people who have attempted to return to their homes without authorization and communications are in no state to deal with them yet. A firm directive has been issued to the Regions concerned to ensure through the medium of Italian officials that this does not occur.

Personnel.

Brig. M. GARR has relieved Col. A. H. HANCOCK Region I. Col. J. V. WILLIAMS Region II returned USA and in view of impending reorganization of AOC control of Southern Italy no new appointment made. Col. J. A. C. Penryouick relieved Brig. M. GARR Region VI.

General Comments.

MACERATA Province passed to control Region V on 19 Aug. In Region V an average of 15 people are being killed or injured daily as a result of mine explosions. Two Italian Mine Clearing Coys are operating in the Region. Very successful conference with Regional Commissioners and Staffs held 22 and 23 Aug. Full report in preparation. Activities

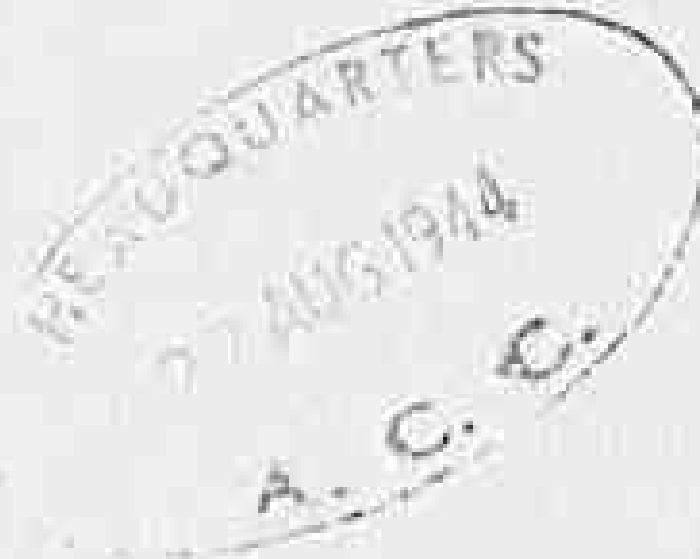

  - (a) The general trend of what are mainly routine affairs is better followed through the medium of the monthly report, personal contact, & other channels.
  - (b) A <sup>sitrops</sup> ~~Summary~~ on routine affairs is likely to cause misconstruction ~~if~~ unless written on the broadest lines, when it can become almost meaningless.
  - (c) Its preparation is a burden on over-worked regional staff who frequently omit to send one at all or else their signals, due to slow communications, arrive too late for inclusion. Our sitrops to AFHQ never includes reports from all regions.
  - (d) The sitrops may have had its value to AFHQ in the early days but it may well be that no importance attaches to it now.
