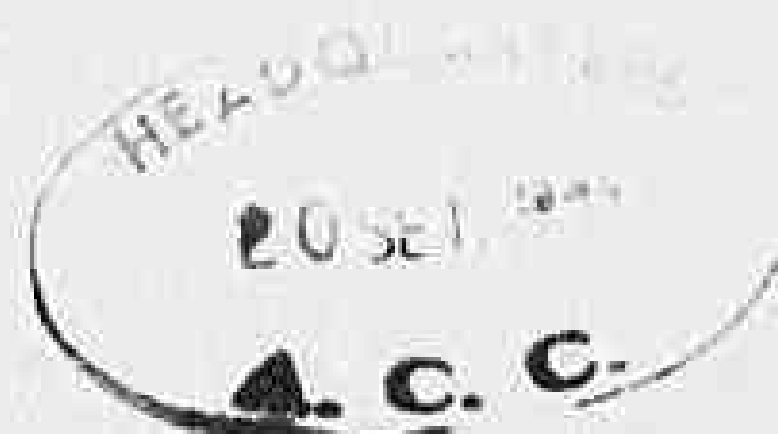

In NAPLES Unione Femminile Italiana has been formed with the purpose of furthering the welfare and political rights of women. This is the first organization of its kind in Italy.

Food and Supplies:

In SICILY the sugar supply has now been distributed. Food and supplies generally in ROME are still causing anxiety. Coal is urgently required for paper mills and caustic soda for soap factory in FOGGIA. A shortage of naptha exists in GROSSETO Province and limits the threshing of wheat.

1. Reference letter this Hq RVIII/6/44 sent to you by special DR on 29 Aug. 1944 and your "ZERRA" Sitrep in reply thereof.

2. The Sitrep submitted did not comply with the instructions contained in par. 3c, 3d and 3e of the cited letter from this Hq., dated 18th August, 1944. Due to the time limits it was necessary to forward your Sitrep as received, although it was known to be unsatisfactory to Hq. ACC. The instructions received from Hq. ACC were repeated in the cited reference and said that "in order to enable a more complete and 'interesting' summary to be submitted by A.F.H.O. to LONDON, WASHINGTON and SHAFF, something more than the bald comment "satisfactory" or "causing anxiety" is needed". It is desired that you include items likely to be of interest in Allied countries together with information on anything which might possibly be the subject of political questions.

3. The report in question did not comply with these instructions. It is desired that you give your personal attention to the material included in the Sitreps to the end that the instructions of Hq. ACC may be complied with.

Food & Supplies:

There is no change in the situation which is generally satisfactory except for ROME. Everything possible is being done to increase ROME's supplies and it is hoped that the situation will shortly be materially improved; pasta ration to be considered pending arrival of potatoes.

Crime:

No important change. Approximately 10,000 persons now denounced for violations of grain laws in Sicily and 22,000 quintals grain have been confiscated. 11 road blocks are being operated in the Province of AQUILA to check black market in potatoes.

Health:

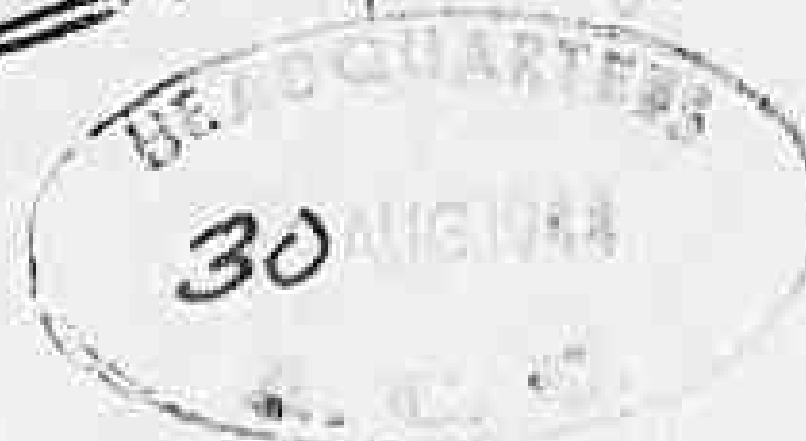
